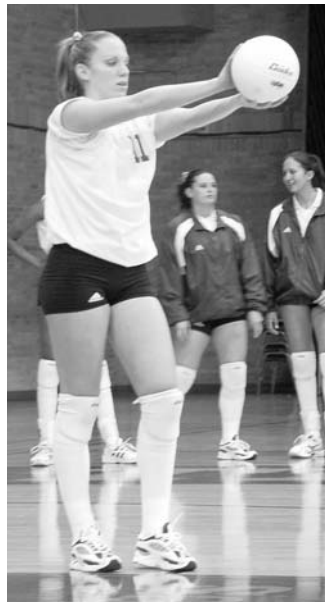
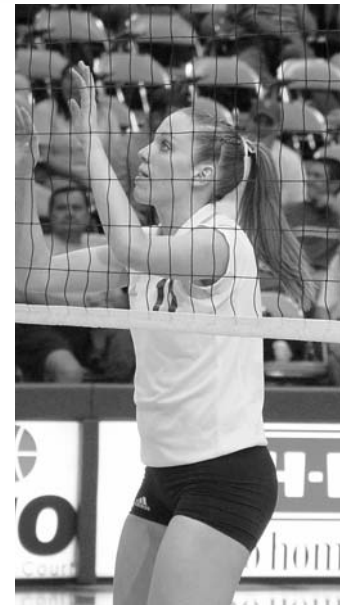

THIS IS UTPA VOLLEYBALL

- **JACLYN MUSZYNSKI** became the first player in NCAA Division I Independent history to earn first team All-Independent honors in each of her four seasons.
- The Lady Broncs captured their first-ever Independent Tournament Championship after defeating Belmont University in five sets. **LORENA LOPEZ** earned Most Valuable Player honors.
- **CAROL MARCENGO** finished in the top-10 among all NCAA Division I players in digs per game during her freshman and sophomore season. She was ranked eighth in her freshman season and 10th during her sophomore campaign.
- The Lady Broncs captured 19 wins during the 1996 season and advanced to their first-ever Sun Belt Conference Tournament. UTPA has recorded 19 wins on three occasions (1996, 2000, 2003).



- The Lady Broncs won their second Independent Tournament Championship defeating Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in three sets in 2001. **JACLYN MUSZYNSKI** named Most Valuable Player honors.
- **JACLYN MUSZYNSKI** broke the Lady Broncs' all-time marks in games played, kills, total attacks and digs.
- **STEPHANIE REDD** became the first player in program history to record 2,500 total attacks, 1,000 kills, 300 total blocks and 90 service aces.
- **CHRISTINE ALVAREZ** ranked fifth among all NCAA Division I players in service aces per game and led the Sun Belt Conference during the 1995 season.
- **KATIE BURKE** broke the single-season mark for assists in a season, accumulating 1,335 total assists during the 2002 season.
- **TANJA THOMAS** posted a record-high 35 kills against McNeese State during the 1990 season.

- **MUSZYNSKI** and **WINKER CRUZ** won back-to-back Independent Offensive Player of the Year laurels in 2001 and 2002.
- **LISA YANEZ** broke the program record for most blocks in a career with 323 from 1993-96. She captured the top marks in both block solos and block assists.
- **KAREN LYONS** broke the program record with 79 assists against the University of Texas-Arlington during the 2005 season.
- **CHRISTINE PHILLIPS** notched a program record of 10 service aces against Northwestern State during the 1996 season.
- The Lady Broncs posted their first-ever winning season during the 1995 campaign when they recorded an 18-14 overall record.
