## NOTES

TO RECAP: UC Davis captured its third straight MPSF championship, scoring a winning 193.675 at the March 24 conference meet – more than two full points better than runner-up Seattle Pacific... Katie Yamamura (vault, bars), Madeline Kennedy (beam) and Tiana Montell (all-around) each claimed individual titles... The Aggies opened with a 48.650 on floor, added scores of 48.300 and 48.050 on vault and bars, then closed out the meet with a 48.675 on beam.

ALL-MPSF: UC Davis swept the conference's major awards, as announced immediately after the MPSF meet... Yamamura won Gymnast of the Year honors, John Lavallee nabbed his fourth Coach of the Year award (in six years) while Tamara Ross was selected as Assistant Coach of the Year... Ross guided the balance beam squad to three of the four best scores in school history, including a season-high 48.775 on March 16... The Aggies even flirted with the school record of 48.900 during the conference meet: Kennedy scored 9.875 in the leadoff spot while Anna Shumaker and Montell hit back-to-back 9.850s in the next two routines.

Yamamura led seven total all-conference honorees, earning nods in all four events plus the all-around... Shumaker (vault, beam), Kennedy (vault, floor) and Michelle Ho (bars, floor) were also multiple winners... Montell (all-around), Leah Housman (beam) and Taryn West (floor) made one All-MPSF squad each.

UP NEXT: Yamamura and Montell will represent UC Davis at the NCAA Seattle Regional, hosted by the University of Washington on Saturday... Meet time is 4 p.m... The top two teams and the top two all-arounders not on an advancing team will receive automatic berths to the NCAA Championships, held on April 20-22 in Duluth, Ga... The event winner from each regional site also advances to the national meet if they are not already qualifying as part of a team or as an all-arounder.

This is Yamamura's second trip to the NCAA postseason after becoming the first Aggie freshman all-arounder to qualify... She ranked 10th overall in the West and second among the at-large qualifiers with a 38.940 RQS... Yamamura broke the 39-point barrier on four occasions in 2012, including a school-record 39.225 at Sacramento State (3/11)... She also competed on all four events in each of the team's 12 meets this season... The regional will lift her season to 52 routines, the most since Ericka Ruelas did 53 (in 15 meets) in 2000... Yamamura will rotate through the meet with LSU, opening with a bye before competing on floor in Rotation 2.

Montell becomes the second Aggie freshman all-arounder to make a regional (after Yamamura)... She finished 15th in the West with a 38.210 RQS, helped greatly by a strong finish: a 38.450 at Sac State (3/11), a 38.625 at San Jose State (3/16) and a career-high 38.725 at the MPSF meet (3/24)... An odd piece of trivia: a native of Hilo, Hawaii, Montell is just the second out-of-state Aggie gymnast to reach the NCAA Div. I postseason... Former assistant coach Ashley Lindow (now Ashley Weinschilbom) was part of the first-ever UC Davis contingent at a Div. I regional... Lindow, a four-time USGF All-American, hails from Houston, Texas... Montell will rotate with host Washington, beginning the meet on vault.

SCOUTING THE ALL-AROUND FIELD: Based on seedings/rankings, No. 4 Alabama and No. 9 LSU are the most likely to advance as teams... Tide senior Geralen Stack-Eaton ranks 11th nationally with a 39.420 RQS, while LSU boast three all-arounders in the national top 25: Rheagan Courville (39.450), Liomincia Hall (39.355) and Jessie Jordan (39.305)... No. 16 Arizona's top four-event performer is junior Aubree Cristello (39.375), who scored a 39.025 in the Aggies' quad meet on Mar. 2... From Washington, McKenzie Fechter enters with a 39.155 RQS while Ruby Engreitz has a 38.895... Iowa's top all-around is Jessa Hansen at 39.050... She scored a 39.425 against LSU on Mar. 9... CMU has two all-arounders with RQS of 39 or better: Kristen Tuebner (39.185) and Brittany Petzold (39.070).

Among the other at-large qualifiers, Sacramento State freshman Kalliah McCartney led the pack with a 39.160 RQS, scoring 39.375 in the Mar. 16 triangular with San Jose State and UC Davis plus a 38.350 at the WAC Championships eight days later... Cal's Mariesah Pierce and Madisyn O'Brien enter at 38.545 and 38.200, respectively... Pierce scored 39.150 at home on Jan. 15; however, she has been sidelined by injury since late February... O'Brien appeared in the first three and final three meets as a four-event competitor, scoring a 39.025 at the Pac-12 meet on Mar. 24.

## HEAD COACH JOHN LAVALLEE:

On Katie Yamamura: "Yami needs to come in and be strong and mentally fresh so she can be on top of what she's doing and perform everything maxed-out. She'll go after that type of performance. She's good enough that if she hits a good score, she could potentially qualify to the nationals."

"I always tell my athletes, if you can get yourself to a big meet, anything can happen. She has done very well to position herself. There are a couple of other kids in this region who will be very good in the all-around, but Yami has certainly positioned herself to perform with them. So we'll see where the chips fall."

On Tiana Montell: "Tiana has been a tremendous surprise, I don't know how else to put it. She really has the ability to perform with a high level of consistency. She isn't always perfectly on but she is always able to just get through it, which helps you a lot in the long run. She has the ability to make adjustments and make changes to get through and stay on her feet. She is very heads-up, very smart and she uses her talents to the maximum."

On a freshman's regional experience: "The biggest thing is that they get to get on the floor with teams that are ranked very high in the country, and they realize that they can run with them. They feel they should be on the floor competing with them. That's really something they bring back to the gym and to their teammates. We have a very young group this year. Those thoughts and ideas will play into the program, and help raise the overall level and the individual goals of the program. It's what we need to do to take the next step forward."

## JOHN LAVALLEE

Head Coach  
6th Year  
Springfield '86

John Lavallee has wasted no time in establishing his mark on the Aggie women's gymnastics program.

In 2008, Lavallee mentored his program to its first MPSF team title, which the Aggies won with a school-record 194.700. The Aggies captured three straight conference championships from 2010 and 2012. Furthermore, he has guided nine student-athletes to 12 total individual at-large berths in the NCAA West Regional.

For his part, Lavallee has claimed four MPSF Coach of the Year awards: three straight from 2007 to 2009, plus another in 2012. He added NACGC/W West Region Coach of the Year acclaim in 2010.

On a larger stage, Lavallee has brought the program a step closer to his goal of transforming UC Davis into an NCAA regional qualifier. The Aggies finished 39th in the national RQS rankings with a school-record 193.885 in 2010, then ended up 43rd (193.150) on the leaderboard in 2011. No UC Davis team had compiled an RQS higher than 192.680 prior to those two years.

Before arriving at UC Davis, Lavallee enjoyed a successful three-year stint as the top assistant for longtime Yale mentor Barbara Tonry. In the past two seasons, he and Tonry guided six Bulldogs to at-large appearances at the NCAA Northeast Regional. Furthermore, Yale captured an Ivy League title in 2005.

Prior to his stop in New Haven, Lavallee spent 11 years as director and head coach of the Sterling Academy of Gymnastics in Sterling, Mass. In addition to his work with club's recreational programs, which grew to more than 1,000 students, Lavallee coached champions at the state, regional and national level, plus a member of the 2002 Junior Olympic National Team. He served as meet director at many levels including the 1999 USAG Eastern Championships. Also during his time at Sterling, Lavallee taught gymnastics as a physical education course at Atlantic Union College in Lancaster, Mass.

While at the Sterling Academy of Gymnastics, Lavallee earned three USAG Service Awards for his contributions to his sport and served as a member of the USAG State Administrative Committee as Massachusetts' Junior Olympic representative.

Lavallee was a collegiate gymnast at Springfield College in Springfield, Mass. In 1986, he earned U.S. Gymnastics Federation All-America honors on floor exercise and served as team captain. Lavallee earned his bachelor's degree in general studies in 1987, then returned for his master of education in 1992. While completing his master's work, he served as a graduate assistant for the Chiefs (now the Pride) and taught gymnastics classes in the physical education department.

Lavallee's wife Teri served on the Aggie gymnastics coaching staff as an assistant coach from 2007-10.

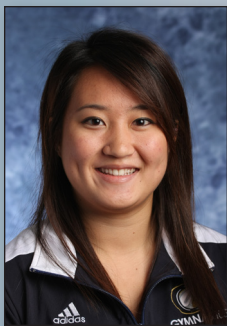

**2012:** MPSF GYMNAST OF THE YEAR... ALL-MPSF on all four events plus all-around... MPSF CHAMPION on vault (9.800) and bars (9.725)... Led conference in RQS on vault (9.810), bars (9.80) and all-around (38.925), while ranking 4th on beam (9.705) and 3rd on floor (9.785)... Earned MPSF Gymnast of the Week six times, the last of which came after setting school all-around record of 39.225 at Sacramento State... Also tied her own vault mark of 9.900 and scored season-best 9.825 on floor in that meet... Broke Flora Bare's previous record of 39.200, set in 2003... Scored 39-plus on three other occasions: 39.125 in home meets on 1/27 and 2/10, plus 39.050 at Seattle Pacific... Remains only Aggie to break 39-point barrier more than once... Competed as all-arounder in all 12 meets for maximum 48 routines... Hit 11 of 12 for year on vault and bars, 10 of 12 on floor... Scored 9.800 or better on bars four times, peaking at 9.850 in road dual at SPU... Opened season with career-high 9.800 on beam at Arizona State.

**2011:** MPSF CHAMPION on vault, tying Jill Henrie's school record of 9.900 at conference meet... Sidelined by injury for more than a month... Appeared as an all-arounder at Cal State Fullerton, scoring 37.875... Returned to action on March 4, posting season-high 9.750 on bars... Followed that with 9.850 on vault, 9.725 on beam at Sacramento State... Earned All-Academic honors from both MPSF and NACGC/W.

**2010:** ALL-MPSF on vault (9.760), beam (9.710), floor (9.760) and all-around (38.505)... NCAA REGIONAL QUALIFIER in all-around, ranking 14th in West (38.615)... Only second UC Davis freshman gymnast to qualify for regionals, after Tanya Ho... Won MPSF Gymnast of the Week four times (1/12, 2/9, 3/16, 3/23)... Claimed one of team's four Outstanding Contributions awards... Became fifth Aggie and first freshman to crack 39-point barrier in all-around, scoring 39.100 in home triangular with Cal and Texas Woman's... Followed with 39.075 vs. Stanford... Only gymnast in school history to score 39-plus more than once... Scored 9.825 or better on vault on four occasions, including 9.850 in Cal/TWU meet and at West Regional (t8th)... Scored 9.825-plus four times on floor, all in the final six meets... Posted season-best 9.850 in Cal/TWU meet then delivered consecutive 9.825s vs. Stanford and at conference (T3rd)... Scored season-best bars of 9.700 in home dual vs. Seattle Pacific... Twice scored 9.775 on beam: at Air Force and at home vs. Stanford... Earned NACGC/W Academic award.
