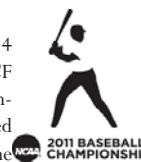

- UCF played every team in the Tallahassee Regional this year in the regular season and posted a 4-2 record in those games.
- The Knights went 12-10 vs. programs that reached the 2011 NCAA Tournament.
- This year marks UCF's 10th trip to the NCAA D-I Tournament.

On Deck for the Knights

-Following a 16-5 victory over No. 4 Bethune-Cookman June 4, No. 2 UCF gets together with No. 3 Alabama Sunday at noon. The Crimson Tide defeated the Knights in the opening game of the 2011 NCAA Baseball Championship Tallahassee Regional June 3, 5-3. The Black and Gold has not determined its starting pitcher as of Saturday evening.



first two games. However right fielder Andrew Miller is 0-for-7 in the Tallahassee Regional.
-Alabama will start its closer, senior lefty Jonathan Smart, who owns a 4-3 record with 11 saves and a 2.53 ERA. Smart pitched the final 2.0 innings vs. UCF Friday, giving up one run on three hits.

-The winner of the UCF-Alabama tilt will battle No. 1 Florida State Sunday at 6 p.m.
-If game seven is needed, it will be Monday at 6 p.m.
-Every game this weekend is scheduled to air on 740-AM in Orlando with Marc Daniels on the call. Links and live stats will be available at UCFAthletics.com.
-As of Saturday night, there will not be live video available for the UCF-Alabama game.
-Sunday night's contest involving FSU will air on Fox Sports Florida, while Monday's possible game seven will be televised by Sun Sports..
-The Knights are 6-1 this year when appearing on TV.

The Series

-UCF had a four-game winning streak over Alabama before the Crimson Tide topped the Knights Friday.
-Alabama's Nathan Kilcrease went 7.0 innings for the win, while the Tide outhit the Knights, 14-7.
-The Knights lead in the all-time series, 6-5.

Notes from UCF's 16-5 Win Over B-CU

-It was UCF's first NCAA Tournament victory since defeating Florida State, 7-5, June 6, 2004.
-Jonathan Griffin moved into a tie for seventh in the NCAA this year with his 19th homer.
-When Ryan Breen walked to start the fifth, UCF ended a span of 17-straight innings where it did not put the leadoff man aboard (streak started May 27 vs. Rice).
-UCF had not committed more than one error in a game since two miscues vs. Houston May 1 (a span of 16 games). But the Knights had two errors Saturday.
-The eight-run seventh inning was the biggest inning in an NCAA Tournament game in school history. It also matched an overall postseason record as UCF scored eight runs in an Atlantic Sun Tournament game vs. Centenary in 1996.

-UCF set a school record for most runs in an NCAA Tournament contest, and tied the school mark with 20 hits (also had 20 vs. Princeton May 25, 2001). The Knights posted at least 20 hits in a game for the second time this year (20 at UAB May 15).

-Griffin tied a school record for RBI in an NCAA Tournament game with five.

What a Difference 24 Hours Make

-In their first NCAA Tournament game June 3 vs. Alabama, the No. 2-5 hitters of Beau Taylor, D.J. Hicks, Jonathan Griffin and Derek Luciano combined for just one hit, no RBI and no runs.

-A day later vs. Bethune-Cookman, the quartet was 13-for-21 with 11 RBI, 11 runs and five extra-base hits.

-Hicks and Griffin each produced four of those hits.

Useless Stat of the Day

-UCF has a 39-0 record when it outscores its opponent.

More on UCF's 3-4 Hitters

-When you put D.J. Hicks and Jonathan Griffin together, you get a 12-foot-11, 490-pound beast. And individually, they each have been hitting like that kind of monster too. -Batting third and a lefty at the plate, Hicks leads UCF with a .348 average, posting a .429 OBP with 64 RBI as the designated hitter.

-Hitting cleanup and a righty at the dish, Griffin (.341) has banged out 19 homers and 19 doubles while driving in 58 and scoring 52 runs.

-In all, the duo has combined for 32 home runs (56 per-

Winning the Last Three Innings

-UCF has not been outscored in the last three innings of a game since May 17 vs. Stetson (Knights still defeated the Hatters, 7-6).

-In the NCAA Tournament, the Black and Gold has outscored opponents from innings seven to nine, 15-2 (2-1 vs. Alabama and 13-1 vs. Bethune-Cookman).

UCF Against the Tallahassee Regional

-The Knights posted a 4-2 regular-season record vs. FSU, Alabama and Bethune-Cookman this year, going 1-2 vs. the Seminoles, 1-0 vs. the Crimson Tide and 2-0 against the Wildcats.

-In those six games, UCF hit a combined .290 with Beau Taylor going .417 vs. the three programs. UCF also committed just three errors and had a team ERA of 4.85.

 -Among the top-eight national seeds, UCF had a 5-4 record, going 2-0 vs. No. 2 Florida, 1-2 vs. No. 5 FSU and 2-2 against No. 8 Rice.

NCAA History

-UCF's first season of NCAA baseball was in 1973, and it advanced to the D-II South Regional in 1979.
 -The Knights made the move to Division I in 1985 and has since made 10 trips to the NCAA Tournament.
 -With a 14-19 all-time postseason record at the D-I level, UCF posted at least one victory in nine of those 10 appearances, but has never reached the Super Regionals.
 -This weekend is the seventh time the Knights visit Tallahassee for NCAA Regionals.
 -In 1989 (Gainesville), 2000 (Tallahassee) and 2001 (Columbia), UCF won its first two games only to drop its next two.
 -In 2004 at FSU, the Knights needed to defeat the Seminoles twice to advance. They topped the home team in game one 7-5 but lost in the deciding game, 19-3.
 -UCF has a 0-1 record vs. Alabama in the NCAA Tournament, and a 2-6 record vs. FSU.

A Memorable Night in Tallahassee

-Arguably the greatest game in UCF history took place at Dick Howser Stadium in the 2004 NCAA Tournament.
 -In an elimination game between No. 20 UCF and No. 24 Oklahoma State, the Knights held a 9-6 lead with two outs and two strikes in the ninth before OSU's Rusty Ryal sent it to extras with a three-run double.
 -Reliever Darren Newlin recovered in heart-pounding fashion by leaving the bases loaded in the top of the 10th.
 -The Knights then strode to the plate in the bottom half where Travis Ingle walked Drake Wade and Dee Brown

with one out, giving way to Ryan Bono, who sent a 2-2 offering over the right-field wall for the 12-9 win.

Regional Comparisons

(All RPI notes are based on Boyd's World from Monday)
 -The Tallahassee Regional is one of just four which feature three teams with an RPI of No. 35 or higher (No. 4 FSU, No. 18 UCF, No. 35 Alabama).
 -It also is one of just five regionals with two teams with an RPI of No. 20 or higher.
 -By taking an average of all four teams' RPI, the Tallahassee Regional has an average RPI of 44.25, which ranks in a tie for the fifth-highest of the 16 sites. The most difficult regional based on average RPI is Columbia at 35.25, while the easiest is in Charlottesville (68.00).
 -UCF has the fourth-highest RPI of all 16 teams that have a No. 2 seed.
 -The Knights also have a higher RPI than three No. 1 seeds (No. 19 TCU, No. 31 Oregon State, No. 34 UCLA).

C-USA Championship Recap

-UCF went 2-1 in the C-USA Championship in Pearl, Miss. As the No. 4 seed, the highest seed for the Knights in four appearances in the event, it topped No. 5 Memphis, 16-9, and No. 8 UAB, 6-4, before dropping a 4-2 decision to No. 1 Rice to conclude pool play.
 -First baseman Jonathan Griffin and designated hitter D.J. Hicks were named to the All-Tournament Team.
 -It was the first time since the 2005 Atlantic Sun Tournament that UCF posted at least two wins in a conference tournament.
 -Derek Luciano, Ronnie Richardson and Hicks all hit .417 in the three games, while Griffin crushed a pair of three-run homers.
 -Reliever Johnny Sedlock tossed 8.0 innings from the pen, giving up just one run on six hits and striking out five in two appearances.

Griffin's Flight

-Senior Jonathan Griffin homered in his first at-bat this season. And since then, he has totaled 19 dingers to rank second on the UCF single-season chart (Chris Duffy

owns the record with 21 in 2010).
 -Griffin has at least one hit in 48 of 61 games this year.
 -In the last 32 contests, Griffin has at least one hit in 28 of them.
 -Earlier this year, Griffin had a four-bagger in four-straight games April 8-12.

The Knights vs. Top Teams

-UCF is 10-12 against teams in the top 51 of the RPI.
 -The Knights are 8-8 against nationally-ranked programs.

UCF Loved the Month of May

-After starting May with a 2-3 record, including a 1-2 mark vs. No. 6 Florida State, UCF began playing its best ball en route to a berth in the NCAA Tournament.
 -The Knights are 10-3 in their last 13 decisions.

A Huge Beginning

-Leaving only five runners on base, UCF led 9-3 before breaking a 9-9 tie en route to a 16-9 victory over Memphis in the first game of the C-USA tournament.
 -The 16 runs were the most in a postseason game since May 16, 2001, when the Knights topped Troy, 18-1, in the Atlantic Sun Tournament.
 -UCF's previous record for runs in a C-USA Championship game was six.

Sedlock Locks In

-Senior lefty Johnny Sedlock continues to impress as a reliever this year, holding a 2.00 ERA with a 3-0 record and two saves.
 -He has at least one strike out in all 16 appearances, walking only five total in 36.0 innings, and has not allowed more than two runs to score in a game all year.
 -Sedlock entered in a high-scoring game vs. Memphis in the C-USA Championship May 25 and proceeded to toss the final 4.2 innings with just one run against for the 16-9 victory. Two days later, he shut Rice down by pitching 3.1 scoreless innings, giving up only one hit.

Terry Rooney

Head Coach - Third Season

Postseason experience can mean everything in college baseball. Helping guide a program to Omaha takes a special coach and an emotional voice. As soon as he stepped on campus in the summer of 2008, head coach Terry Rooney's mission was to return UCF to the postseason. And that goal became reality this year. In his career, he has helped lead five different universities to the NCAA Regionals, while bringing in nationally-ranked recruiting classes to six different schools.

Speaking of the recruiting trail, Rooney and his staffed have hauled in consecutive top-20 classes since their arrival to Orlando in the summer of 2008. His first class was No. 4 in the nation by *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* and No. 10 by *Baseball America*, both of which were the highest rankings by those publications in UCF history.

The Knights also have set numerous records under Rooney, including academic and attendance marks. In 2011, UCF won its most Conference USA games since joining the league in 2006, while in 2010 it broke the school and league records with a .343 team batting average and a .435 on-base percentage. That was accomplished even though the Knights were the only team in the country to have five freshmen make at least 35 starts.



Cliff Godwin

Associate Head Coach - Third Season

A veteran when it comes to success at the highest level of college baseball, associate head coach Cliff Godwin is in charge of the UCF offense as well as the catchers. A native of Snow Hill, N.C., he also serves as the recruiting coordinator for the Knights' program after spending two years at LSU.

And already Godwin has brought in two recruiting classes ranked in the top 20, including this year's class which was No. 20 in the country by *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper*.

In his second year in 2010, Godwin directed a UCF offense that put up dizzying numbers, as he would go on to earn C-USA Assistant Coach of the Year honors from SEBaseball.com. The Knights' .343 team batting average not only set a school record, but was the best by a Conference USA program in league history. They smashed the program's single-season home run mark by sending 78 over the wall, and also broke the UCF record with a .538 slugging percentage.



Jeff Palumbo

Assistant Coach - Third Season

One of the top young coaches on the East Coast, Jeff Palumbo is in his third season with the UCF baseball program. He provides his skills primarily with the UCF defense, but also assists with the hitters and the program's recruiting efforts.

Palumbo's recruiting efforts played a major factor in guiding UCF to a 33-22 record in 2010. The Knights were the only team in the country to have five freshmen make at least 35 starts in the batting order, and Palumbo faced the challenge of

having three of them on the infield. But under his tutelage, the Black and Gold put together a .963 fielding percentage, the second-highest by a UCF defense in the last five years. It also turned a school-record 61 double plays in the regular season, which placed UCF among the top-10 clubs in the country for turning two.



Brandon Romans

Volunteer Assistant Coach - Second Season

After a stellar playing career at UCF, Brandon Romans joined the staff as the volunteer assistant coach in the spring of 2010. A native of Cocoa, Fla., Romans played three seasons with the Black and Gold, hitting .314 for his career with 17 home runs and 77 RBI.

In year one with Romans assisting the outfield and the catchers, the Knights' offense ranked as one of the best in the country in 2010. Outfielders Chris Duffy (.447) and Shane Brown

(.428) would become the first duo in C-USA history to hit .400 in the same season as they went on to earn spots on the All-C-USA First Team. And freshman center fielder Ronnie Richardson shined as well, leading all C-USA freshmen with a .448 on-base percentage.
