NOTES

- Aiming for its first preseason ranking in school history, UCF returns seven starters on offense including Conference USA Freshman of the Year QB Jeff Godfrey.
- The Knights enter the spring after claiming the 2010 C-USA championship and defeating Georgia in the AutoZone Liberty Bowl.
- UCF finished 2010 ranked No. 21 in the AP Poll and No. 20 in the Coaches Poll.
- In February, UCF hauled in a recruiting class ranked No. 39 in the nation by Rivals.com, which was the highest by a school which is not a member of an automatic-qualifying BCS conference.
- UCF returns all three players who rushed for at least 10 touchdowns last season (Weaver, Murray and Godfrey), and also brings back Brynn Harvey (1,109 yds, 14 TDs in 2009) who earned a medical redshirt in 2010.
- The returning offensive linemen have combined for 87-career starts.
- An All-American last year, Quincy McDuffie ranked second in the nation by averaging 32.19 yards per kickoff return.
