

UCI INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS EMERGENCY PLAN: Baseball Stadium 917 West Peltason Dr., Irvine, CA 92697

Sports Medicine Personnel: Certified athletic trainer on site for competition. Practice coverage dependent on availability of certified athletic trainer and/or associated staff. Additional sports medicine staff accessible from Carlos A. Prietto M.D. Sports Medicine Center (949-824-2876).

Emergency Communication: Preferred method of emergency communication is portable “Cell” phone. A fixed telephone line in press box (949-824-9905).

Emergency Equipment: Supplies (first aid kit/practice; first aid kit, splint kit, OSHA kit/competition). Additional emergency equipment accessible from Carlos A. Prietto M.D. Sports Medicine Center (949-824-2876).

Roles of First Responders

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Emergency equipment retrieval
3. Activation of emergency medical system (EMS)
 - a) Notify campus police at (949-824-5222) (provide name, address, telephone number, number of individuals injured, condition of injured, first aid treatment, specific directions, other information as requested
 - b) Or call 911 and provide same information as above and request that UCI campus police be notified
4. Direction of EMS to scene
 - a) Open appropriate gates/doors
 - b) Designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to scene
 - c) Scene control: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area

Venue directions: Anteater Field is located directly behind (NW) of the Mesa Parking Structure on Mesa Road. Two gates provide access to the stadium:

1. Preferred: Gate at the Northwest side of Parking Lot 6 allows access to a paved walkway and access to both spectator entry gate on the right field (1st base) line and field level gates on the left field (3rd base) line.
