TITANS TOP ANTEATERS 1-0 IN OVERTIME

IRVINE, Calif. – The UC Irvine women's soccer team lost 1-0 in overtime to the Cal State Fullerton Titans Sunday in a Big West Conference match at Anteater Stadium. The Anteaters conclude their season with a record of 4-14-2 overall and 1-8 in the Big West.

The teams played for 90 scoreless minutes to get the match into overtime. Sophomore Britney Webster (Capistrano Valley HS) had a shot that ricocheted off the post with 10 minutes remaining for the Anteaters in the best chance for either team to score in regulation. In overtime, Lauren Cram took a throw in for the Titans which was headed by Marlene Sandoval to Vanessa Valentine who knocked in the game-winner 3:25 into the first overtime period.

Sophomore goalkeeper Marissa Welliver (Aliso Niguel HS) had seven saves as she shut out the Titans in regulation. Keeper Karen Bardsley had two saves for the Titans and picked up the shutout.

ANTEATERS FALL 3-1 TO UC RIVERSIDE

IRVINE, Calif. – The UC Irvine women's soccer team (4-13-2, 1-7-0) lost 3-1 to the UC Riverside Highlanders (13-2-3, 3-2-3) in a Big West Conference match at Anteater Stadium Friday night.

The Highlanders were on the board first as an Anteater defender misplayed a ball that crossed the goal line for an own goal 6:23 into the match. Kacie McElrath took the ball after her own shot in the box and put it past the keeper to put the Highlanders up 2-0 at the 38:07 mark. The Highlanders went up 3-0 as Amber Plumlee took the rebound off a Kristi Tanaka shot and knocked it past the keeper in the 62nd minute. The Anteaters got on the board in the 81st minute as sophomore Britney Webster (Capistrano Valley HS) took a corner kick and placed it in the box where senior Gina Scachetti (Torrance/Bishop Montgomery HS) put it in to cut the lead to 3-1. The comeback would end there as UCR won 3-1.

Highlander goalkeeper Tawny Poggio had eight saves in 85 and a half minutes of action. Sophomore goalkeeper Marissa Welliver (Aliso Niguel HS) had a pair of saves in one half of action. Freshman keeper Jackie Vazquez (Santa Barbara HS) had two saves in 45 minutes.

Sita Kuteira took a pass from Lindsey Raymond on a breakaway down the field and took a shot that hit the cross-bar and the ball went straight down just crossing the goal line to put the Aggies up 1-0 at 17:38. Lindsey Raymond would score for the Aggies on a cross from Annie McAllister in the 33rd minute to give UC Davis a 2-0 lead. The Anteaters out shot the Aggies 9-3 in the second half, but were unable to get on the board. Aggie goalkeeper Krystyn Lizak had four saves on the

day as she picked up the shut out. Sophomore Marissa Welliver had three saves on the afternoon for the 'Eaters.

ANTEATERS LOSE TO 49ERS 3-1

LONG BEACH, Calif. – The UC Irvine women's soccer team (4-10-2, 1-6) lost 3-1 to the Long Beach State 49ers Friday afternoon in a Big West Conference match in Long Beach.

Allison Wiegand headed in a corner kick by Shanna Wender at the 4:31 mark to give the 49ers an early 1-0 lead. Katelyn Quaresma made it 2-0 LBSU in the 10th minute with assists from Wiegand and Kristin Travis. Freshman Lauren Wiley (Highland/Redlands East Valley HS) cut the lead in half as she headed in her first career goal at the 12:47 mark on a corner kick by sophomore Britney Webster (Capistrano Valley HS). Elizabeth Romo collected the rebound off her own shot as she scored in the 61st minute to give Long Beach State a 3-1 lead.

AGGIES DEFEAT ANTEATERS 3-1

LOGAN, Utah – The UC Irvine women's soccer team (4-9-2, 1-4) lost 3-1 to the Utah State Aggies Sunday afternoon in a Big West Conference match in Logan.

The Aggies took a 1-0 lead at the 27:38 mark when Dana Peart scored off of a rebound. The Aggies took a 1-0 lead into the half. Chanel Blaquiere put Utah State up 2-0 on a header off assists from Peart and Sierra Smith in the 62nd minute. Nicole Gooch made it 3-0 Aggies at the 71:31 mark with an assist to Tiffany Jones. Senior Gina Scachetti (Torrance/Bishop Montgomery HS) scored her first career goal on a rebound shot off an assist from sophomore Britney Webster (Capistrano Valley HS) at the 22:47 mark. Webster would score a goal of her own in the 74th minute on a through ball from freshman Frankee Kelly (Foothill HS). Sarah April put Idaho on the board with a header off a direct kick from Eija Hodgins at 77:46. Idaho was awarded a penalty kick after a foul in the box at the 80:25 mark. Melissa Martinazzi took the kick for the Vandals and converted to tie the game at 2-2. The Anteaters stormed right back down the field 15 seconds later with Britney Webster crossing the

ball to freshman Makenzie Beahm (San Clemente HS) as Beahm headed the ball home for the eventual game-winner at 80:40.
