**October 28, 2005**

### **ANTEATERS LOSE 2-0 TO NO. 18 CAL STATE FULLERTON**

**FULLERTON, Calif.** – The UC Irvine women's soccer team lost 2-0 to No. 18 Cal State Fullerton in their season finale Friday at Titan Stadium in Big West Conference action.

The Titans took a 1-0 lead in the 39th minute as Erica Peschken took a short pass from Erica Janke and put it inside the right post. Rebekah Patrick gave Fullerton a 2-0 lead in the 49th minute on a one-timer in the box.

Fullerton keeper Karen Bardsley had no saves while earning the shutout for the Titans. Freshman keepers Erin Henry (Mater Dei HS) and Rosie Aguilera (Piedmont HS) each played 45 minutes and had one and two saves respectively for the Anteaters.

The Anteaters conclude the season with a 5-12-2 record overall and a 1-5-1 record in the Big West Conference.

### **UC IRVINE STUNS NO. 25 LONG BEACH STATE 2-0**

**IRVINE, CALIF.** – Junior Britney Webster and freshman Megan Ortiz scored goals as UC Irvine stunned No. 25 Long Beach State, 2-0, in Big West Conference action before 619 at Anteater Stadium Sunday afternoon.

Webster scored at 21:47 into an open net after the ball was misplayed in front of the goal. Ortiz scored her team-leading sixth goal of the season in the 64th minute from 20 yards out on the right side with assists credited to Lauren Baer and Makenzie Beahm.

Goalkeeper Liz Ramos had two saves for the 49ers, who fell to 12-4-1 overall and 3-2 in the Big West. Erin Henry and Rosie Aguilera split halves for UCI, with Henry recording one save and Aguilera four.

UCI, playing its final home match of the season, improved to 5-11-2 overall and 1-4-1 in the Big West. The Anteaters end the season facing Cal State Fullerton Friday night at Titan Stadium at 7:00.

The Anteaters' victory cut the 49ers' lead to 3-2 in the inaugural year of the "Black and Blue Series" between the schools.

### **ANTEATERS AND HIGHLANDERS PLAY TO 1-1 DRAW**

**IRVINE, Calif.** – The UC Irvine women's soccer team (4-11-2, 0-4-1) tied UC Riverside 1-1 in double overtime Friday night in Big West Conference play at Anteater Stadium.

Freshman Megan Ortiz (Corona HS) scored her fifth goal of the season off a throw in by senior Lauren Baer (Thousand Oaks/Westlake HS) in the 29th minute to give the Anteaters a 1-0 lead.

The Highlanders came back to tie the game at 1-1 with 2:11 remaining in the second half as Amber Plumlee squeezed the ball past the keeper with an assist from Jenna Leonti.

The two teams played a pair of scoreless overtime periods to end in a 1-1 draw. Freshman keeper Rosie Aguilera (Piedmont HS) had five saves for the Anteaters in 65 minutes of play while freshman keeper Erin Henry had three saves in 45 minutes of action. Highlander keeper Tawny Poggio had five saves in the match for UCR.

The Anteaters play their final home game of the season Sunday as they host Long Beach State at 1:00 p.m. at Anteater Stadium. It will be the final home game for seniors Lauren Baer and Joy Grey.

The Tigers took a 1-0 lead in the 5th minute as Jennifer Smiley fed the ball through the middle to Bunny Dickson who scored her fourth goal of the season. Pacific scored again in the 71st minute as Dickson headed the ball from the left where it was headed in by Mandi Van Dorn at the near post.

Freshman keeper Erin Henry (Mater Dei HS) had one save in the first half for UCI while freshman keeper Rosie Aguilera (Piedmont HS) had two saves in the second half. Keeper Jamie Souza had zero saves in the shutout for the Tigers.

**IRVINE, Calif.** – The UC Irvine women's soccer team (3-8-1, 0-1) defeated North Dakota State 2-1 Sunday afternoon in a non-conference match at Anteater Stadium.

The Anteaters went up 1-0 at the 9:45 mark of the first half as freshman Megan Ortiz (Corona HS) drew the keeper out and passed the ball to senior Joy Grey (Diamond Bar/Long Beach CC) who knocked it past the keeper. The Bison answered back as Becky Iwanicki took a pass from Jessica Rodgers and sent it into the lower right corner to tie the match at 1-1. The Anteaters were awarded a corner kick in the 31st minute. The kick was taken by junior Britney Webster who sent it into the box where it was headed past the keeper by sophomore Kim Conlan (Atascadero HS).

The Matadors were awarded a penalty kick in the 19th minute and it was taken by Brianna Monka. Monka converted the kick sending the ball to the lower right corner to give CSUN a 1-0 lead. Monka would score again with a minute left in the first half as she converted a free kick by Mary Ortega into her second goal of the match for a 2-0 Matador lead. Kristy Krohn put the Matadors up 3-0 after Devon Nizich drew the keeper out of the net and knocked the ball in the open net after Nizich crossed it to her. The Anteaters were awarded a corner kick with the clock winding down and it was taken by junior Britney Webster (Capistrano Valley HS). Webster knocked the ball into a crowd in the middle of the box where freshman Alex Fries (Los Angeles/Chaminade Prep) volleyed the ball into the upper left corner of the net with one second remaining in the game.

Keeper April Cline had three saves for the Matadors. Freshman keeper Rosie Aguilera (Piedmont HS) had five saves on the night for the Anteaters.
