#17 ANTEATERS UPSET 9TH RANKED SAN JOSE STATE 7-3; CLAIM 9TH PLACE AT MPSF CHAMPIONSHIP

Stanford, Calif. - The #17 UC Irvine Anteaters (20-21) upset the #9 San Jose State Spartans 7-3 to claim 9th place at the MPSF Championship held in Stanford. The ninth ranked Spartans are the highest ranked opponent the Anteaters have defeated, the previous best were three wins over 11th ranked opponents. The Anteaters opened the match with three goals in the first quarter to take a 3-1 lead after one. Junior Erica Horman (Carlsbad HS) lead the Anteaters with two goals in the game. Senior goalkeeper Jen Moon had five saves for UCI. Senior Meghan O'Donnell (Laguna Hills/Golden West College), junior Michelle Carey (Chino HS), sophomore Karly Tivenan (Yorba Linda/EI Dorado HS), junior Tiffany Frish (Riverside/Jurupa Valley HS) and junior Melissa Fernandez (Redlands HS) each scored for UCI in the win. The Anteaters finished in 9th place at the 2002 MPSF Championship with wins over Pacific and UC Santa Barbara. The 20 wins this season by the Anteaters is a new school record for wins in a season.

UC IRVINE EDGES CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE 4-3 IN OVERTIME

IRVINE, Calif. --- Junior Erica Horman scored with 23 seconds remaining in overtime to lift No. 17 UC Irvine past Cal State Northridge, 4-3, in non-conference women's water polo action at the Anteater Aquatics Complex Friday night. It was the second game of the day for UCI, which lost 11-3 to No. 2 Stanford earlier Friday.

Northridge's Erica Bonetti had tied the game on a goal with 23 seconds left in regulation. Both teams went scoreless in the first three-minute overtime session before Horman notched the game-winner. Horman led the Anteaters (15-16) with two goals. UCI's Lauren Volcan opened the scoring on a goal with 4:27 left in the second quarter. The Matadors' Ashley Hunhoff then countered on a goal with 4:00 remaining in the first half before Horman scored her first goal of the game to give UCI a 2-1 halftime lead. Meghan O'Donnell gave the Anteaters a 3-1 lead on a goal with 2:41 left in the third quarter, but Pam Barba drew Northridge within 3-2 on a goal with 1:26 remaining in the third before Bonetti scored the game-tying goal late in regulation.

Jennifer Moon had 10 saves in goal for UCI while Jessica Moody recorded 11 for Northridge (17-5). The Anteaters return to action with a game against USC in Los Angeles Wednesday at 5:00 p.m.
