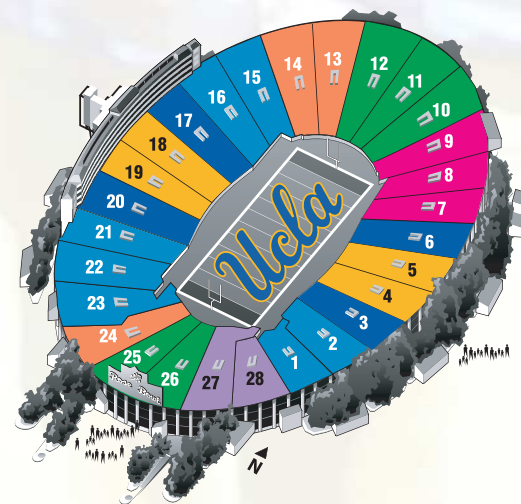

The UCLA women's volleyball team returns a veteran unit of six seniors and 11 letterwinners from last year's squad which posted its ninth-consecutive 20-win season and reached the NCAA Regional Final for the fourth time in the last five years. The Bruins have been one of the top teams in the nation since 2003, recording the second-best NCAA finish on average over the last five seasons.

The senior-laden squad, led by two-time first-team All-American Nellie Spicer, will have 10 matches at Pauley Pavilion in 2008. The schedule features a tough Pac-10 slate, which includes contests against cross town rival USC as well as Stanford and California, with all three teams having made the NCAA Final Four in 2007.

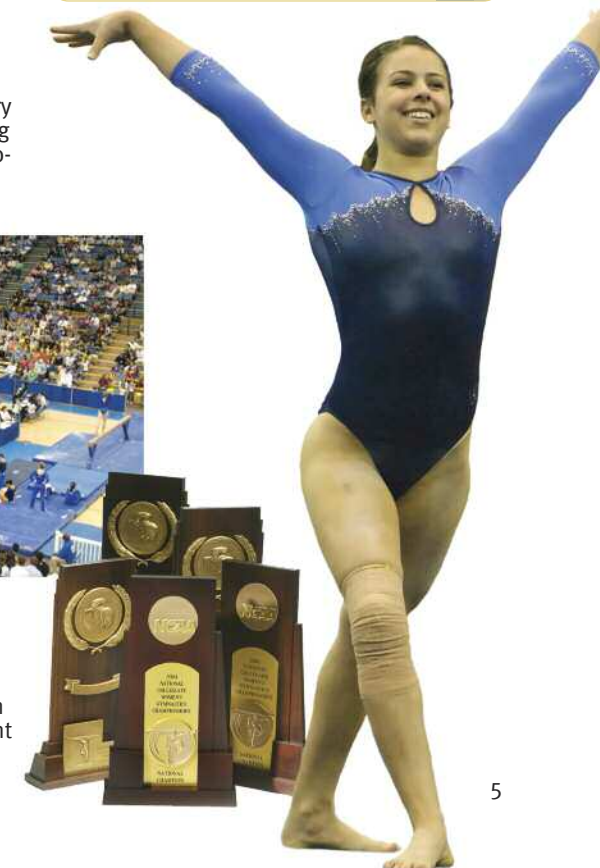
