### UMASS FACES #11/9 RICHMOND IN A-10 SEMIFINALS

• After winning two impressive games against Duquesne and George Washington in the final weekend of the regular season, the UMass women's lacrosse team (7-10, 4-3 A-10) will face the No. 1 seed Richmond Spiders (14-3, 6-1 A-10) on Friday afternoon at 1 p.m. in Washington, D.C. The Spiders closed out their season with a clinching the A-10 Regular Season title. UMass has qualified for its seventh A-10 tournament in its eight seasons of affiliation with the conference.

• This will be the second time UMass and Richmond have faced each other this season. Richmond won the earlier meeting on April 9 by a score of 15-5 in UMass' second A-10 game of the season. Since that game, UMass is 4-1 falling by just one goal to Temple.

• UMass last qualified for the A-10 Tournament in 2004 losing to Temple in the semifinal round. The Minutewomen last reached the Championship game in 2003 beating Richmond in the semifinal round, 12-11, in overtime. Seniors **Lindsay Cassell** (Weston, Mass.), **Kerri Connerty** (Nashua, N.H.) and **Jackie Nesbitt** (Springfield, Pa.) were each freshmen in that game.

• UMass last won the A-10 Championship title in 2000 when the Minutewomen beat Temple 3-2 in overtime. Current assistant coach **Jen Nardi** was the goalkeeper for UMass in the most defensive-minded championship game in A-10 history.

### LEADING THE MINUTEWOMEN

• UMass is led by sophomore **Kathleen Typadis** (Medfield, Mass.) and freshman **Kaytlin McCormick** (Saratoga Springs, N.Y.). Typadis leads the team with 42 points on 41 goals, while McCormick has been outstanding in her rookie season posting 31 goals, four assists, 38 groundballs, 26 draw controls and 13 caused turnovers - all of which are among the top-three on the team.

• Senior **Kerri Connerty** (Nashua, N.H.) is third with 34 points on 17 goals and a team-high 17 assists.

• Redshirt junior **Lauren McCarthy** (Derry, N.H.) has started for the most part this season in cage, but sophomore **Krissy Anderson** (Baldwin, N.Y.) has played well in a mostly reserve role. Anderson picked up her first career win earlier this season at Albany. Ander-

son is 3-3 this season, while McCarthy is 4-7.

• Defensively, senior **Jackie Nesbitt** (Springfield, Pa.) anchors the defensive back with 46 groundballs, 38 caused turnovers and 33 draw controls.

• As a team, UMass ranks ninth nationally in groundballs among 50 ranked teams. The Minutewomen collect on average 26.76 groundballs per game.

• Individually, senior **Jackie Nesbitt** (Springfield, Pa.) ranks eighth in the NCAA with 2.24 caused turnovers per game.

## SERIES WITH RICHMOND

• UMass and Richmond meet for just the seventh-time in the all-time series. The all-time series is tied at 3-3 each.

• UMass won the first three meetings in the series, while Richmond has taken the last three - including the earlier meeting this season, 15-5 in Richmond.

• The two programs met once in the Atlantic 10 Tournament with the UMass taking a 12-11 overtime win in the 2003 semifinal round.

• Richmond head coach Sue Murphy (1987-90) had a standout career ranking second all-time in career goals (125), fourth in career assists (57), and third in career points (182). Current sophomore Kathleen Typadis (Medfield, Mass.) passed Murphy on the single-season goals list with 41 this season. Typadis is projected to finish ahead of Murphy in career goals over the course of her career.

## CONNERTY CLIMBS THE CHARTS

• Senior **Kerri Connerty** (Nashua, N.H.) continues to move up the all-time charts in UMass scoring history. She scored twice and posted an assist against George Washington (4/30) to move into eighth all-time in career points and take sole possession of fifth-place all-time in career assists.

• Cari Nickerson is the all-time career leader in assists with 106. Connerty now has 84 goals, 47 assists, and 131 career points. She needs just four goals to move into the all-time top-10 for that category.

• Connerty's 17-game scoring streak came to an end at Dartmouth (3/8). In her career she has tallied 24 multi-point games and seven hat tricks.

## NESBITT ANCHORS DEFENSE

• Senior **Jackie Nesbitt** (Springfield, Pa.) has been a mainstay over her career in the defensive back row. Friday afternoon will mark her 49th consecutive start for UMass in 68 career games. In that span she has collected 146 groundballs, 75 draw controls and caused 87 turnovers. She has also tallied 12 goals and four assists for 16 points.

• Nesbitt currently ranks eighth nationally among 50 players ranked in caused turnovers with 2.24 per game.

• Nesbitt ranks among the all-time top UMass defenders in groundballs, caused turnovers, and draw controls (those became official NCAA statistics in 2001). She ranks second in all three categories.

• To take the UMass lead in groundballs, however, she has some work to do as former UMass defensive standout Kristin St. Hilaire holds that mark with 166. St. Hilaire was the only Minutewoman ever to collect over 100 groundballs and cause over 100 turnovers.

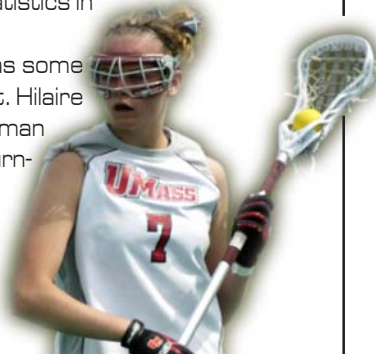

**NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP FOR TYPADIS**

• Sophomore **Kathleen Typadis** (Medfield, Mass.) is once again playing well to lead UMass with 42 points on 41 goals. For her career, she has 77 goals in just 34 games - including 13 hat tricks.

• Her 41 goals this season now ranks as the sixth-best single scoring mark in UMass history. She needs just two more goals to take over the fifth spot (Lydia Robinson) and five to take over fifth-place (Hope Zelinger).

UMass assistant coach Tracey Drown and Marjorie Anderson hold the second-best single season scoring mark with 47 goals, while Pam Moryl holds the No. 1 spot with 51 goals in 1984.

• Going back to the 2005 season, Typadis has the longest active scoring streak on the team at 23 games.

• Against La Salle (4/13) she tied her career-high of five goals - the sixth time in her career she has scored four-or-more goals in a game. It was the second time in her career high she scored five goals against the Explorers.

• In her two years at UMass, Typadis has now outscored assistant coach Tracey Drown who had 61 in her three-year career.

Drown is the most recent All-American selection for the Minutewomen as she earned that honor in the 2004 season.

• Typadis needs one point to equal her freshman season scoring output. She scored five more goals this season (41) than last (36) and now has 85 career points.

• On her current scoring pace, Typadis could end her career as the second-highest goal scorer in UMass history at a 151 projected goals. Pam Moryl - who helped UMass to the first-ever women's lacrosse NCAA Championship in 1982 and two NCAA fourth-place finishes - holds the UMass record for career goals with 170. Richmond head coach Sue Murphy (1987-90) ranks second with 125 career goals.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT**

• UMass and Saint Joseph's are tied for the youngest teams in the A-10 this season. UMass has eight freshmen and nine sophomores for a total of 17 underclassmen. The Hawks have six sophomores and 11 freshmen.

• UMass' underclassmen account for 77.8 percent of its goals scored this season.

• St. Bonaventure and Duquesne will lose the most next season as they each have six seniors on their squads.

• The Bonnies, Richmond, and Temple have the most veteran squads with 11 upperclassmen for SBU and the Spiders and 10 for the Owls.

**IT'S NOT HOW YOU START, IT'S HOW YOU FINISH**

• While it seems a cliché, the saying fits for the Minutewomen who started the season with a 3-7 record entering the conference schedule. After starting 0-2 in the league with losses to St. Bonaventure and Richmond, UMass has won four of its last five games.

• The Minutewomen were in a must win situation entering the last weekend of the regular season having to defeat Duquesne at home and then travel to Washington, D.C. to beat George Washington 40 hours later to qualify for the four-team league tournament.



**TYPADIS EARNS WEEKLY HONORS AFTER LEADING UMASS TO A-10 TOURNAMENT BERTH (5/1)**

• **Kathleen Typadis** (Medfield, Mass.) was named the A-10 Co-Player of the Week and the UMass Athletics/Dinn Bros. Athlete of the Week after guiding the women's lacrosse team to a pair of conference wins and qualifying UMass for the A-10 Conference Tournament.

• Typadis scored two goals, including the overtime game-winner against Duquesne, and three at George Washington.

• It is also her first time honored as the UMass Athlete of the Week. As a freshman, she was honored as a two-time A-10 Rookie of the Week.

**TYPADIS NAMED A-10 PERFORMER OF THE WEEK (4/17)**

• Typadis was also named the A-10 Performer of the Week after scoring a combined nine goals in wins over St. Joe's (4/13) and La Salle (4/15) helping UMass move from eighth-place (last) in the league rankings to a conference tournament contending fourth-place. She also had five groundballs and two draw controls.

• This was her second conference honor as she was also named the league's Rookie of the Week once during the 2005 season.

## **KEYS TO VICTORY**

- Several trends become apparent when looking at UMass' victories this season.
- Defensively, UMass holds its opponents to just 9.15 goals per game on 34.4 percent shooting.
- Offensively, the Minutewomen hand 3.8 assists per game compared to just 2.1 assists per game in losses.
- Possession is one of the largest factors as UMass has a 91-to-62 advantage in draw controls.

## **UMASS AMONG THE ATLANTIC 10**

- UMass boasts the second best all-time record in league play among conference members. Temple holds the best record among league rivals at 46-5, while UMass is 32-19.
- UMass finished third in the conference in 2004 and fourth in 2006 with a 4-3 record each year.
- In this the eighth year affiliated with the league, UMass has one regular season title and one tournament title to its name (both in 2000) and has qualified every season but one (2005) for the A-10 Tournament.

## **UMASS PICKED SIXTH IN A-10 PRESEASON COACHES POLL**

- The women's lacrosse team was picked to finish sixth in the Atlantic 10 Conference entering the 2006 season as voted on by the league's coaches in a preseason poll.



*Jeannette Villapiano has 25 points this season on 20 goals and five assists.*

The Minutewomen tied for seventh in the A-10 in 2005 with a 1-6 conference mark.

- Temple was the top pick in the league, followed by the Richmond, George Washington and Duquesne/St. Bonaventure. La Salle and Saint Joseph's were picked to finish seventh and eighth, respectively.
- With the exception of 2005, UMass has finished no lower than third since 1999 in the conference highlighted by a tournament crown in 2000.

## **VILLAPIANO STEPPING UP**

- Sophomore **Jeannette Villapiano** (Ocean Township, N.J.) surpassed her freshman point total with 25 points entering the Richmond game with 20 goals and five assists from her midfield position.
- Villapiano registered her first career hat trick against Boston College (4/1). She had her second career hat trick at La Salle (4/15) and her third against Temple (4/23).
- This season, she has been one of the top point scorers on the team with seven multi-point games in her 13 played.
- Villapiano - who wears head coach Carrie Bolduc's No. 30 from her Syracuse days - had eight goals and two assists in her rookie campaign.

## **ANDERSON MAKING AN IMPRESSION IN CAGE**

- Sophomore **Krissy Anderson** (Baldwin, N.Y.) did not play one minute last season as a freshman. In the loss earlier this season to Boston University, she played in her first-ever game as a Minutewoman playing nearly the final six minutes. In those few minutes, however, fans received a glimpse of what was to come. Despite giving up a goal, Anderson made two strong saves to finish the game.
- Ten days later, Anderson picked up her first win as she relieved incumbent starter Lauren McCarthy. In just over 33 minutes of work, Anderson made six saves while allowing just three goals.
- The next game out at Syracuse, Anderson earned her first career start. Despite taking the loss, Anderson did make a career-high 16 saves. Impressive considering she had quite a bit of nervousness before the game ... "I was shaking when they called out the starting line-up

... it took a couple of shots before I got settled in."

## **TWICHELL SETTLING IN**

- Sophomore **Kristina Twichell** (Fayetteville, N.Y.) has found her niche on offense this season with 13 goals and six assists which ranks fifth overall on the team.
- She has scored in eight of her last nine games including three-consecutive games of three points. She posted her first career hat trick in that span with three goals against St. Bonaventure (4/7).
- Twichell has now started the last 11 straight games. In her freshman season, she played in 11 games, starting five times, and recorded three points on one goal and two assists.

## **FANTASTIC FRESHMEN**

- **Holly Drown (Nashua, N.H.), Kaytlin McCormick (Saratoga Springs, N.Y.), Jackie Rosenzweig (South Massapequa, N.Y.)** and **Meghan Reddy (Salem, N.H.)** have already made big impacts to start their careers at UMass having found regular starting rolls.
- McCormick is the team's second-leading scorer with 35 points on 31 goals, while Reddy has 15 points and 27 groundballs.
- In Atlantic 10 action, McCormick is second behind Typadis with 17 points on 16 goals and an assist through seven conference games.
- Drown is a strong addition to the midfield both defensively and offensively. She has eight goals this season and started the first six games of the season before missing two games prior to the Vermont game with an inflamed ribcage. Coming off that injury, however, she tallied a career high three goals for her first career hat trick against Vermont (3/29) and has started every game since.
- Rosenzweig has started every game in the defensive back and has 19 caused turnovers which ranks second on the team.

## **MCCORMICK NAMED A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK (2/27)**

- Freshman **Kaytlin McCormick** (Saratoga Springs, N.Y.) was named the Atlantic 10 Lacrosse Rookie of the Week (2/27) following her performance at Holy Cross. McCormick tallied

four goals, three in the second half, on five shots to lead the Minutewomen in her collegiate debut. Despite playing the game in nearly two inches of snow, she also collected four groundballs and caused three turnovers.

- McCormick was a 2005 graduate of Saratoga Springs where she was a two-time U.S. Lacrosse All-American. She also earned the honor for field hockey (2005) and was a First-Team Section 2 honoree in both field hockey and lacrosse (2004, 2005). She became the first female student-athlete at Saratoga Springs to be named a two-time All-American as well as Section 2 MVP.

### **A NEW YORK STATE OF MIND**

- Despite being the flagship school of Massachusetts, the Minutewomen have several team members who hail from the Empire State. New York is the most represented state on this season's roster as seven team members call the state home.
- Head coach **Carrie Bolduc** is an Albany native, while assistant coach **Jen Nardi** is from Valley Cottage, N.Y.
- Kristina Twichell, Julie Papaleo, Jackie Rosenzweig, Alana Jakas, Samantha Sepulveda, Krissy Anderson, and Katylin McCormick are all from New York.

### **HAPPY 25TH ANNIVERSARY!**

- It was 25 years ago that UMass won the first ever NCAA Championship in women's lacrosse. The Minutewomen posted a 10-0 record during the 1982 season and defeated Trenton State for the title.
- During their title run, UMass defeated Boston University (18-0), Harvard (5-3), Dartmouth (13-3), New Hampshire (5-4), and Boston College (10-2).
- The Minutewomen followed their NCAA title with a pair of fourth-place finishes in 1983 and 1984.

### **NO EASY SCHEDULE**

- Six of this season's 17 scheduled opponents are ranked on receiving votes in the IWLCGA Top-20 Poll: #3 Dartmouth, #9 Boston University, #13 Syracuse, #16 Hofstra, and #20 Temple. Richmond is just three votes shy of being ranked, but the Spiders are receiving votes.

### **THE LAST TIME AGAINST RICHMOND**

- No. 9 Richmond used a 37-to-22 shot advantage to defeat the UMass women's lacrosse team 15-5 on Sunday afternoon at First Market Stadium. **Kaytlin McCormick** (Saratoga Springs, N.Y.) scored three goals to lead the Minutewomen. UMass returns to action on Thursday at Saint Joseph's.
- Caroline McGuire scored four goals as did Sara Allen to lead Richmond (11-2, 3-0 A-10). Eight Spiders tallied goals on the day.
- Along with McCormick's hat trick, **Kathleen Typadis** (Medfield, Mass.) and **Jeannette Villapiano** (Ocean Township, N.J.) each recorded goals in the game to round out UMass' (3-9, 0-2 A-10) scoring.
- Richmond used a controlling offensive attack going up 6-2 in the first half using a 20-to-10 shot advantage. The Spiders fired 17 shots in the second half connecting for nine goals. Richmond was also able to control the draw today holding a 13-to-6 advantage. Fouls were an issue for UMass as it tried to handle Richmond's offensive attack. The Minutewomen were whistled for 24 fouls on the day compared to just nine for the Spiders.
- Sophomore **Krissy Anderson** (Baldwin, N.Y.) started in cage for UMass making 10 saves on the day.

### **2003 SEMIFINAL MEETING**

- PHILADELPHIA, Pa. — Sophomore Maura McGarrity (Chester Springs, Pa.) scored a goal with :48 remaining in overtime to push the University of Massachusetts women's lacrosse team (11-6) over Richmond (10-7), 12-11, in the semifinals of the Atlantic 10 Tournament. This marks the first time UMass has advanced to the A-10 Championship game since 2000, when the Minutewomen captured the conference title with a 3-2 win over Temple in overtime.
- After trailing 6-3 at the end of the first half, UMass forced a comeback late in the second half. Trailing 11-4 with 13:05 remaining in regulation, the Minutewomen constructed a seven goal run to tie the game and force an overtime session. Senior Jada Emery (Princeton, N.J.) started the run when she was able to find the back of the net at the 8:17 mark. McGarrity followed up Emery's goal when scored her second goal of the game with 6:32 remaining, cutting the deficit to 11-6.
- The Minutewomen continued to pour on the offense when both junior Hope Zelinger (Ellicott City, Md.) and senior Kelli Kurtz (Schwenksville, Pa.) tallied back-to-back goals late in the second half. Zelinger scored a pair of goals at the 4:27 and 3:44 marks and Kurtz followed up with goals at 1:39 and 1:31, bringing UMass to within one goal, 11-10.
- Emery tallied her fourth goal of the game with just :28 left in regulation to force the game into overtime. The game remained tied until McGarrity scored the game-winning goal with just :48 left on the clock.
- Emery led all scorers with four goals, while McGarrity added three goals for UMass. Kurtz and Zelinger each tallied two goals apiece and freshman **Kerri Connerty** (Nashua, N.H.) scored a single goal on a free possession shot.
- In goal, senior Cyndi Doyle (Bridgewater, Vt.) recorded 10 saves for UMass.
- The win over Richmond improves UMass' record to 11-6 on the season, marking the first time the Minutewomen have recorded more than 10 wins in a single season since the 1983 squad posted a 12-3-1 record under Head Coach Pam Hixon.
