### TAR HEELS LOOK TO CONTINUE WINNING WAYS AT WAKE FOREST

North Carolina will seek its fourth consecutive win Sunday when the Tar Heels hit the road to face in-state rival Wake Forest at Joel Coliseum at 2 p.m. Carolina enters the contest 15-5 on the year and 5-2 in the Atlantic Coast Conference after a 77-46 win over Boston College on Wednesday. Wake Forest is 12-8 on the season and 2-5 in league play after a 64-39 loss at Miami on Thursday. UNC is ranked No. 25 in both the Associated Press poll and the coaches' poll. Wake Forest is unranked.

### WAKE FOREST SERIES NOTES

- North Carolina is 57-12 all-time against Wake Forest, including a 21-8 mark in Winston-Salem.
- After meeting at least twice in every season since 1983-84, the Tar Heels and Demon Deacons have met just once in each of the last six seasons.
- UNC won the lone meeting in 2011, a 71-56 triumph in Chapel Hill.
- The Tar Heels also won the last matchup in Winston-Salem, a 65-59 overtime victory in 2010.
- Carolina has won eight straight in the series and 11 of the last 12. Wake has defeated UNC just four times since 1991-92, with all four victories coming at home.

### REBOUNDS EQUAL WINS FOR TAR HEELS

Carolina has always stressed the importance of rebounding and that statistic has been a good indicator of success for the Tar Heels over the last five seasons. Since the beginning of the 2006-07 season, Carolina has won the rebounding battle in 143 of 190 games. In those 143 games, UNC sports an overall record of 133-10. The Tar Heels have outrebounded their opponents in 15 of 20 games this season and have a 14-1 record in those games.

### LAST TIME OUT: No. 25 UNC 77, Boston College 46

CHAPEL HILL — Chay Shegog scored 16 points to lead No. 25 North Carolina to a 77-46 victory over Boston College on Wednesday night. Krista Gross and She'la White added 11 points apiece for the Tar Heels (15-5, 5-2 Atlantic Coast Conference). After North Carolina jumped to a 14-0 lead, Boston College cut the margin to nine points on four separate occasions, but White's 3-pointer stretched the Tar Heels lead to 23-11.

### TAR HEELS IN CARMICHAEL ARENA

• Carolina is 406-91 all-time in Carmichael, including a 33-8 record since the building re-opened after being closed for renovations from March 2008 to December 2009.  
• The Tar Heels have won at least 14 home games in each of the last 10 seasons, including a school-record 18 during an undefeated 2007-08 home campaign.  
• UNC has lost just 17 home games since the start of the 2001-02 season. The Tar Heels have been even more stingy against non-conference opponents, losing at home just twice outside of league play in the last decade.

### HATCHELL REACHES 600 WINS AT CAROLINA

Women's Basketball Hall of Famer and three-time national coach of the year Sylvia Hatchell joined yet another exclusive coaching club Jan. 19. With Carolina's 56-37 victory over Virginia Tech, Hatchell reached 600 wins since taking over in Chapel Hill in 1986. One of just five coaches in Division I history with 800 career victories, Hatchell is just the third coach in ACC history to earn 600 wins at a league school, joining NC State's Kay Yow and Virginia's Debbie Ryan.

### CAROLINA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICS

Despite losing almost 50 percent of its scoring from a year ago due to the departures of seniors Italee Lucas, Jessica Breland and Cetera DeGraffenreid, UNC continues to dot the national statistical rankings. In the most recent NCAA statistics release, the Tar Heels are among the top 40 in the country in eight statistical categories:

- Blocks Per Game - 6.8 (3rd)
- Field-goal % Defense - 33.7% (13th)
- Fouls Per Game - 13.5 (16th)
- Scoring Margin - +16.1 (19th)
- Steals Per Game - 12.0 (21st)
- Scoring - 72.8 ppg (31st)
- Rebound Margin - +6.3 (33rd)
- Field-goal Percentage - 42.7 (37th)

### SHEGOG THRIVING AS A SENIOR

Center Chay Shegog is having a stellar final season in Chapel Hill. The senior from Stafford, Va., is second in the league in scoring with 16.5 points per game and also has tallied seven double-doubles. After averaging 8.9 ppg as a junior, Shegog has had the second-highest scoring improvement (+7.6) in the ACC this season.

### CAROLINA DEALING WITH INJURY BUG

North Carolina has had a number of players miss game time so far this due to a variety of conditions. Here is the current status:

- Tierra Ruffin-Pratt suffered a sprained her left thumb in the win at Virginia Tech on Jan. 19 but did not miss any time. Ruffin-Pratt (offseason shoulder surgery) returned to the lineup against Virginia on Jan. 5 and got her first start of the season against Clemson. She missed the first 13 games of the season after offseason shoulder surgery.
- Waltiea Rolle gave birth to her first child - a daughter - on November 8 and was not enrolled at UNC during the fall semester. She returned to Chapel Hill after Christmas and rejoined the team prior to the Savannah State game.
- Megan Buckland (knee) underwent successful surgery on Jan. 10 to repair a torn ACL. She will miss the rest of the season.
- Latifah Coleman (knee) underwent successful surgery on Dec. 27 to repair a torn ACL. She will miss the rest of the season.

In addition to the challenges listed above, other missed games include:

- She'la White (ankle) - two games (Virginia, Maryland)
- Shannon Smith (hamstring) - two games (Kennesaw State, Lipscomb)
- Whitney Adams (shoulder) - three games (Gardner-Webb, USC Upstate, UNC Greensboro)
- Laura Broomfield (foot) - five games (Kennesaw State, Lipscomb, ETSU, South Carolina, East Carolina); also missed final 12 minutes at Penn State (leg cramps) and most of second half vs. Maryland (eye)

## CAROLINA AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

- Carolina is 124-196 all-time against opponents ranked in the Associated Press Top 25, including a 1-3 mark in 2011-12.
- Since the start of the 2004-05 season, Carolina is 45-29 against ranked opponents. The Tar Heels have 13 wins over teams in the top five of the AP poll during that stretch, including a 71-65 win over No. 4 Connecticut in 2004.
- UNC's most recent top-5 win came against Duke last season. The Tar Heels defeated the No. 5 Blue Devils, 62-60, in Chapel Hill. Carolina's last road win over a top-5 team was an 80-79 victory over No. 2 Oklahoma in the final of the 2008 Preseason WNIT.

## CAROLINA HOLDS SAVANNAH STATE TO RECORD LOW

The Tar Heel defense established a new school record in the Dec. 29 win over Savannah State. In holding the Lady Tigers to just 21 points in the 74-21 victory, Carolina allowed the fewest points by an opponent in the history of the program. The record-setting performance came almost seven years after the previous milestone, a 79-29 victory over Winthrop on Jan. 6, 2005.

## ROUNTREE EARNS SECOND WEEKLY ACC HONOR

Freshman guard Brittany Rountree picked up her second ACC Rookie of the Week nod of the season following play Dec. 26-Jan. 1. Rountree contributed 13.0 points, 3.5 steals, 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists in a pair of wins for the Tar Heels. The rookie from Jacksonville, Fla., scored a game-high 15 points against Savannah State, and helped the Tar Heels hold Savannah State to 21 points - the lowest total ever for a Carolina opponent. Rountree then tallied 11 points, four steals, three assists, three rebounds and just one turnover against NC Central. Rountree was also honored on Dec. 5 after scoring a season-high 27 points at Penn State.

## SHEGOG REACHES 1,000-POINT MILESTONE

Center Chay Shogog became the newest member of Carolina's 1,000-point club on Dec. 20 when the senior standout scored 19 points against East Carolina. With her 19-point effort against the Lady Pirates, Shogog moved to 1,003 career points, making her the 33rd player in program history to reach 1,000 career points. Shogog also earned ACC Player of the Week honors for her performance against ECU, adding seven rebounds and a career-high seven blocks to her 19 points.

## ROUNTREE NAMED TO NEWCOMER LIST

North Carolina freshman guard Brittany Rountree was named to the Atlantic Coast Conference Newcomer Watch List, the league announced Oct. 18 at the annual ACC Media Day at the Greensboro Coliseum. The Tar Heels were picked to finish sixth in the conference by a vote of the Blue Ribbon Panel, consisting of national and local media, as well as school representatives.

## TAR HEELS IN PRESEASON TOP 25 ONCE AGAIN

North Carolina is ranked in the top 25 in both major polls to open the season for the 10th consecutive year. The Tar Heels are ranked No. 20 in the Associated Press poll, while the ESPN/USA Today coaches' poll has Carolina at No. 19. UNC was ranked No. 2 in both polls to open 2006-07, its highest-ever preseason rankings.

## CAROLINA CHOSEN TO HOST 2012 FIRST AND SECOND ROUNDS

North Carolina will serve as a first- and second-round host for the 2012 NCAA Women's Basketball Championship, the NCAA announced last October. The NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee has selected the first- and second-round and regional sites for the 2012 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship and those sites have been approved by the Administrative Committee of the NCAA Division I Championships/Sports Management Cabinet.

Cities chosen to host first- and second-round games in 2012 include Ames, Iowa; Baton Rouge, Louisiana; Bowling Green, Ohio; Bridgeport, Connecticut; Chapel Hill, North Carolina; Chicago, Illinois; College Park, Maryland; College Station, Texas; Little Rock, Arkansas; Nashville, Tennessee; Norfolk, Virginia; Norman, Oklahoma; Notre Dame, Indiana; Spokane, Washington; Tallahassee, Florida; and West Lafayette, Indiana. The four selected regional sites are Des Moines, Iowa; Fresno, California; Kingston, Rhode Island; and Raleigh, North Carolina.

## TAR HEELS WELCOME FIVE FROM CLASS OF 2016

The University of North Carolina women's basketball program signed five high school seniors to National Letters of Intent, head coach Sylvia Hatchell announced Wednesday. The five members of the class of 2016 are Antoinette Bannister of Jacksonville, Fla., N'Dea Bryant of Goose Creek, S.C., Hillary Fuller of Jacksonville, Fla., Xylina McDaniel of Columbia, S.C., and Hillary Summers of Fayetteville, N.C.

Bannister, who attends The Potter's House Christian Academy, is a 5-10 guard. A second-team USA Today All-America selection, Bannister averaged 27.2 points, 7.5 steals, 7.1 rebounds and 5.2 assists as junior.

Bannister is a two-time National Christian Schools Athletic Association Large School Division 1 Player of the Year and has earned first-team National Association of Christian Athletes All-America honors each of the last three seasons. She is rated the No. 26 player overall by the All-Star Girls Report. Bannister is the daughter of Tony and Lurise Bannister.

Bryant, who attends Goose Creek High School, is a 6-0 wing. A two-time High School Sports Report All-State selection, Bryant has led her team to a combined record of 81-6 over the last three seasons, including the school's first state championship in 2010.

A three-time all-region and all-county selection, Bryant is rated the No. 9 overall wing player by ESPN HoopGurlz. She averaged 12.5 points and 7.5 rebounds as a junior and led her team to a second straight state championship game appearance. Bryant is the daughter of Keith and Kessa Bryant.

Fuller, who also attends The Potter's House Christian Academy, is a 6-1 forward. A 2011 first-team NACA All-America selection, Fuller averaged 13.5 rebounds and 4.1 blocked shots to go with 7.5 points per game as a junior.

McDaniel, who attends Spring Valley High School, is a 6-2 forward. The 2010-11 South Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year, McDaniel is a three-time 4A all-state selection who has averaged over 18 points and eight rebounds per game.

Rated the No. 6 forward and the No. 25 player overall by ESPN HoopGurlz, McDaniel helped lead Spring Valley to 4A state championships in 2009 and 2011. In addition to being one of South Carolina's top five players each of the last three seasons on the hardwood, McDaniel also broke the state record in the shot put as a track and field athlete. McDaniel is the daughter of former NBA All-Star Xavier McDaniel and Michele Day Anderson.

Summers, who attends Village Christian Academy, is a 6-3 post player. An Associated Press All-State selection as a junior, Summers owns a plethora of school records at VCA, including career points, career rebounds and career blocked shots.

Summers is a two-time Cape Fear Independent Conference Player of the Year, leading the CFIC in scoring, blocks and steals after averaging 22.2 points per game as a junior. She helped lead VCA to three straight NCISAA state championship tournament appearances and earned NCISAA All-State honors as both a sophomore and a junior.
