## UNLV CAREER

Marshall enters his third season in the Runnin' Rebel program in 2011-12 ... Has appeared in all 67 games for UNLV over the last two years, making 38 starts ... Has averages of 7.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.3 steals per game ... Has shot 46.0 percent from the field ... Has scored in double figures in 23 games ... Has three career double-doubles.

## SOPHOMORE (2010-11)

Appeared in all 33 of UNLV's games, making 27 starts ... Averaged 9.7 points, 4.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.3 steals per game ... Shot 47.1 percent from the field and 70.3 percent from the free-throw line ... Was sixth in the Mountain West in assist/turnover ratio, ninth in free-throw percentage and 10th in steals ... Was second on the team in steals and free throws made, third in assists and minutes played, fourth in scoring, rebounding, blocked shots, field goals made and 3-pointers made, and fifth in three-throw percentage ... Had one double-double (16 points, career-high-tying 12 rebounds at BYU) ... Had double-figure rebounding totals in two other games and scored in double figures in 17 games ... Scored a career-high 26 points against BYU (9-12 FG, 2-3 3FG, 6-8 FT) ... Led the team in scoring six times and in rebounding four times ... Made at least one 3-pointer in 11 games.

## FRESHMAN (2009-10)

Played in all of UNLV's 34 games, making 11 starts (including each of the last 10 games) ... Averaged 5.3 points, 3.1 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.3 steals per game ... He was second on the team in steals ... Shot 44.4 percent from the field ... Scored in double figures in six games and pulled down double figures in rebounds twice - recorded double-doubles both times ... Scored a then-career-high 14 points vs. Holy Cross ... In his first career start he scored 11 points against Kansas State ... Had a career-high five steals against USC Upstate ... Scored 12 points on 6-of-9 shooting in a win over SMU in Hawaii and had 12 points and three steals in his second career start at San Diego State ... His first career double-double came against Colorado State (12 points, 10 rebounds) ... He did it again vs. Utah in the MW Tournament with 13 points and 12 rebounds.
