



## UNLV CAREER

Stanback begins his fourth season as a Runnin' Rebel in 2011-12 ... Selected to this year's Preseason All-Mountain West Team ... Has appeared in all 67 of UNLV's games over the last two years, making 66 starts ... Has averages of 11.8 points, 5.9 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.3 steals per game ... Has five double-doubles and has scored in double figures in 42 games ... Transferred to UNLV from UCLA after the 2007-08 season ... Sat out the 2008-09 season as a redshirt because of NCAA transfer rules.

## JUNIOR (2010-11)

Was named third team All-Mountain West for the second straight year ... Earned his first career MW Co-Player of the Week award after leading the Runnin' Rebels to a perfect 3-0 record and the title at the 76 Classic in Anaheim, Calif. ... Started all 33 of UNLV's games ... Led the team in points scored with 428 and was second in points per game with 13.0 ... Also led the team in rebounding with 5.9 per contest ... Also averaged 1.5 assists and 1.1 steals per game ... Shot 47.8 percent from the field, 36.2 percent from 3-point range and 80.3 percent from the free-throw line ... Was third in the MW in field goal percentage, eighth in rebounding and 10th in scoring ... Led the team in field goals made, was second in 3-pointers made and minutes played, third in free-throw percentage and blocked shots, and fourth in steals ... Had four double-doubles and scored in double figures 22 times ... Scored 20 or more points five times, including a career-high 25 (8-14 FG, 4-7 3FG, 5-6 FT) in a win over Wisconsin ... Led the team in scoring 15 times and in rebounding 14 times ... Made at least one 3-pointer in a game 22 times ... Made a career-high 6 (eight attempts) 3-pointers against Air Force.

## SOPHOMORE (2009-10)

Was named third team All-MW ... Also was a member of the league's all-defensive team ... Named to the All-MW Tournament squad ... Also was a first team All-MW pick by Sporting News and a second team NABC All-District 17 selection ... Played in all of UNLV's 34 games, making 33 starts ... Averaged 10.7 points, 5.8 rebounds, 1.6 steals and 1.4 assists per game ... Was second on the team in scoring and tops in rebounding ... Also led the team in steals and blocks (28) ... Was seventh in the MW in rebounding, second in steals per game and ninth in blocked shots ... Shot 43.6 percent from the field, 30.9 percent from 3-point range and 80.3 percent from the free-throw line ... Scored in double figures in 20 games and grabbed 10 or more rebounds twice ... Led the Runnin' Rebels in scoring in three games and in rebounding 16 times ... Had his first double-figure scoring game of the year with 14 points against Kansas St. ... Had his first career double-double against Utah with 14 points and 10 rebounds ... Pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds against BYU ... Scored a then-career-high 21 points on 8-of-13 shooting at Air Force ... Scored 11 points and grabbed a team-high six rebounds in UNLV's NCAA Tournament game against Northern Iowa ... Scored at least 10 points in his last eight games and 15 of his last 19.

## SOPHOMORE - REDSHIRT (2008-09)

Used the 2008-09 season as a redshirt year after transferring to UNLV from UCLA.

## FRESHMAN - UCLA (2007-08)

Played as a true freshman in 2007-08 at UCLA ... Appeared in 25 games for the Final Four squad ... Averaged 5.8 minutes per game, shot 40.4 percent from the field and averaged 1.8 points per game.

## HIGH SCHOOL

A 2007 graduate of Fairfax High School in Los Angeles ... The team won two state championships (2004 and 2007) ... Averaged 25.8 points and 11.9 rebounds as a senior, leading the Lions to the Division I state title and a 28-5 record ... Was named the Los Angeles Times' Boy's Basketball Player of the Year ... Was named an All-American by EA Sports and MaxPreps ... Also earned California Division I Player of the Year and John Wooden Player of the Year honors in 2007 ... Was all-league, all-city and all-state as well as being named Fairfax MVP ... Ranked No. 65 in the nation by Rivals.com and as the No. 18 small forward in the country and the No. 10 small forward in California ... Ranked No. 59 in the nation by Rob Harrington of USA Today and No. 52 on the ESPN 150 ... Was rated the No. 1 small forward by Scout.com in the West Coast 2007 Pre-Summer Rankings ... Fairfax was ranked No. 5 in the West Regional boy's basketball final rankings by USA Today ... As a junior, led the Lions to a 24-3 overall record while averaging 18.7 points, 9.9 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game ... Named all-city, all-league and all-state as a junior ... As a sophomore averaged 13.4 points, 8.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists ... Was all-league, all-city and all-state ... Was a four-year varsity letterman for coach Harvey Kitani ... Was a high school teammate of former Runnin' Rebel Matt Shaw.
