# NOTEBOOK

- The Runnin' Rebels have a brand new coaching staff, with each member having ties to the Mountain West or UNLV's legendary history. Head coach **Dave Rice** was most recently the associate head coach at BYU and also played in two Final Fours at UNLV, including 1990 when the team won the national championship. Associate Head Coach **Justin Hutson** was most recently an assistant at San Diego State, Assistant Coach **Heath Schroyer** was the head coach at Wyoming, and Assistant Coach **Stacey Augmon** also played on those legendary UNLV teams.
- The Runnin' Rebels are coming off their fourth NCAA Tournament appearance in the last five years. Overall, UNLV has appeared in 18 NCAA Tournaments.
- The Runnin' Rebels return seven players (four starters) from last season that averaged 11 minutes or more per game. In order of minutes played per game: **Oscar Bellfield**, **Chace Stanback**, **Anthony Marshall**, **Justin Hawkins**, **Quintrell Thomas**, **Brice Massamba** and **Carlos Lopez**.
- Last year's team won 24 games and was ranked in the top 25 for multiple weeks.
- UNLV was in the top 25 in the nation in home attendance last season for the third straight year, finishing 23rd in the country and No. 1 on the West Coast again (California, Nevada, Oregon & Washington)
- The Runnin' Rebels return 76.5 percent of their scoring from last season and 70.9 percent of their rebounding
- Bellfield and Stanback are UNLV's returning All-Mountain West players. Both Bellfield and Stanback were both named to the third team in 2010-11. In 2009-10, Stanback was a third-team selection, while Bellfield was honorable mention.
- With 24 wins last year, UNLV has reached the 20-plus win mark in each of the last five years. UNLV won 30 games in 2006-07, 27 in 2007-08, 21 in 2008-09 and 25 in 2009-10. It is the first time since 1988-93 that UNLV has won 20-plus games five consecutive seasons. Over the past five years, UNLV has averaged 25.4 wins per year.
- The Runnin' Rebels are entering their 29th season in the 18,500-seat Thomas & Mack Center. UNLV has posted an all-time record of 386-80 (.828) in the arena since it opened in 1983. Since the start of the 2006-07 season, UNLV is 78-15 (.839) in the TMC. The Runnin' Rebels have the best all-time home-court win percentage in the MW.
- UNLV holds the NCAA Division I record for most consecutive games scoring a 3-point goal. Since the 3-point field goal was adopted by the NCAA in 1986-87, UNLV has converted at least one 3-pointer in all 805 games played.
- The 2011-12 year will mark the 54th season of Runnin' Rebel basketball at UNLV. Since the program's inception in 1958-59, the Runnin' Rebels have posted an all-time record of 1,133-457 (.713). In 1969-70, UNLV made the move to Division I and has since posted a record of 946-353 (.728) while competing at that level. In addition, UNLV has an all-time mark of 1,093-434 (.716) against Division I competition.
- With an all-time record of 1,107-447 (.712) against four-year American institutions, UNLV ranks as the fourth-winningest program by percentage in NCAA Division I history (min. 25 years in Div. I).
- The Runnin' Rebels have appeared in the postseason 32 times in its history, including 13 times in the past 15 seasons. UNLV has an all-time record of 33-17 (.660) in 18 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.
- UNLV has had 47 players taken overall in the NBA Draft, including 13 in the first round since 1975. Of those 13 first-round selections, eight have been lottery picks.
