The UNLV men's basketball team (20-12) advanced to the Mountain West Tournament's quarterfinal round with Wednesday's 97-90 overtime win over Air Force in the first round. The eighth-seeded Runnin' Rebels will now face No. 22 and top-seeded UNR (26-6) on Thursday, March 8 at 12 p.m. at the Thomas & Mack Center.

Tickets may be purchased at UNLVtickets.com, by calling 702-739-FANS (3267) or by visiting the Thomas & Mack Center Box Office.

This will mark UNLV's third meeting with the Wolf Pack this season. UNLV defeated then-No. 23 UNR in Reno, 86-78, on Feb. 7, while the Wolf Pack defeated the Runnin' Rebels in Las Vegas, 101-75, on Feb. 28. The winner of Thursday's game will also receive three points in the Governor's Series, which is presented by NV Energy and Barrick Gold.

Mountain West Freshman of the Year Brandon McCoy leads UNLV in scoring (17.1 ppg), rebounding (10.2 rpg) and blocks (1.8), while senior Jordan Johnson is the team's and conference's assist leader (6.1 apg).

UNLV's win over UNR in February marked its first against a ranked team since 2015 and snapped the Wolf Pack's 16-game home win streak.

Thursday's game will be televised by CBS Sports Network with Rich Waltz, Bob Wenzel and Evan Washburn (sideline) calling the action. Jon Sandler and former Runnin' Rebel Robert Smith will handle the UNLV radio call, which may be heard live on ESPN Radio 1100 AM/100.9 FM and online via the UNLV Gameday App and TuneIn (link at UNLVRebels.com).

THE UNLV RUNNIN' REBELS (20-12, 8-10 MOUNTAIN WEST, NO. 8 SEED)

- The 2017-18 season marks the second at UNLV for head coach Marvin Menzies. Prior to coming to UNLV, he spent the previous nine years as head coach at New Mexico State where he compiled a 198-111 (.641) record. His current career record is 229-144 (.614). He earned career win No. 200 last season on Nov. 19, 2016 against Cal State Fullerton at the Thomas & Mack Center.
Coming to UNLV was actually a return to Las Vegas for Coach Menzies. He spent a year with the Runnin' Rebels on Lon Kruger's staff in 2004-05 as an assistant coach.
Mountain West Freshman of the Year Brandon McCoy is leads the Runnin' Rebels in scoring (17.1 ppg), rebounding (10.2 rpg) and blocks (1.8 bpg). He has a MW-leading 17 double-doubles this season, which ranks third in the country among freshmen. He is on pace to set the league's freshman record for scoring and rebounding. He is also 55.3 percent, which is third in the MW.
Three other Runnin' Rebels are averaging in double figures in scoring: junior forward Shakur Juiston (14.6 ppg), senior guard Jordan Johnson (13.8 ppg) and senior guard Jovan Mooring (13.8 ppg).
Juiston has recorded 14 double-doubles this year and almost averages a double-double with 9.9 rpg. His shooting percentage of 64.0 percent ranks No. 1 in the Mountain West and is in the top 10 nationally.
UNLV was picked to finish sixth in this year's Mountain West race by the media in October, while freshman forward Brandon McCoy was named the Preseason MW Freshman of the Year. UNLV tied for seventh in the standings this season.
McCoy was also named to the All-Mountain West Second Team along with Juiston.
Johnson leads the Mountain West in assists with 6.1 apg and was named honorable mention All-MW by the media.
UNLV lost five straight games to end the regular season but snapped its streak with the win over Air Force on Wednesday. Prior to the losing streak, UNLV had won three straight Mountain West games for the first time since 2016 and five of six in conference play for the first time since 2014.
The Runnin' Rebels have eight newcomers on this year's roster, not counting transfers that must sit out.

THE NO. 22 UNR WOLF PACK (26-6, 15-3 MOUNTAIN WEST, NO. 1 SEED)

- UNR has won back-to-back regular-season Mountain West championships.
Since losing to UNLV on Feb. 7 in Reno, UNR had won six straight before dropping its regular-season finale on Saturday at San Diego State (79-74).
UNR is 11-3 on the road this season.
Head coach Eric Musselman is in his third year as a Division I head coach (all at UNR) and has a career mark of 78-27 (.743).
Caleb Martin was named Mountain West Player of the Year, Cody Martin was the league's Defensive Player of the Year, Caleb was also Newcomer of the Year and Musselman was the Coach of the Year. Jordan Caroline and Caleb were both named First Team All-Mountain West.
Martin leads four Wolf Pack players averaging double figures in scoring with 19.5 ppg. Caroline is the team's leading rebounder with 8.7 rpg.
In the loss at San Diego State, Caroline scored 29 to lead UNR. Caleb Martin scored 22 and Cody Martin had 13.

SERIES HISTORY

- This will mark the 87th meeting in men's basketball between UNLV and UNR.
UNLV leads the all-time series 60-26.
UNLV is 33-10 all-time in games vs. UNR in Las Vegas.
The two teams split the regular-season series with each winning on the other team's home floor. UNLV won Feb. 7 in Reno, 86-78, while UNR won in Las Vegas on Feb. 28, 101-75.
UNR swept the season series last year, and prior to this season had won two straight and three of four meetings overall.
Prior the win in Reno on Feb. 7, UNLV's last win in the series was at home in 2016 (102-91 in OT).
Both teams are 2-2 in their last four meetings at the Thomas & Mack Center.
UNLV is 1-0 all-time in the MW Tournament vs. UNR with the only meeting occurring on March 11, 2015 - a 67-46 Runnin' Rebel win.

UNLV'S MOUNTAIN WEST TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- UNLV has won the Mountain West Tournament three times (2000, 2007, 2008).
The Runnin' Rebels have appeared in the championship game on eight occasions.
UNLV is 27-14 all-time in the Mountain West Tournament.
UNLV lost in overtime in the first round of the Mountain West Tournament last year to SDSU (62-52).
Prior to Wednesday, UNLV's last tournament win was in 2016 when it defeated Air Force in triple overtime, 108-102. The Runnin' Rebels then lost to Fresno State that year.

UP NEXT

The winner of Thursday's game will face the winner of No. 4 Fresno State/No. 5 San Diego State in the tournament's semifinals on Friday, March 9 at 6 p.m. The game will be televised by CBS Sports Network.

GOING FOR 21 WINS

UNLV has won 20 games for the first time in four years. The last time UNLV won at least 21 games in a season was in 2012-13 (25-10).

NOTES:

- Four Runnin' Rebels scored in double figures, led by freshman forward Brandon McCoy's double-double of 23 points and 12 rebounds, as the No. 8 seed UNLV men's basketball team (20-12) defeated No. 9 seed Air Force (12-19), 97-90, in the first round of the Mountain West Tournament March 7 at the Thomas & Mack Center.
- McCoy's double-double was his league-leading 17th of the season. Junior forward Shakur Juiston added 21 points, while senior guard Jovan Mooring chipped in 17 and senior guard Jordan Johnson recorded his third double-double of the year with 10 points and 12 assists.
- It was UNLV's 20th win of the season, marking the first time the program has won 20 games in four years. The Runnin' Rebels were 20-13 in 2013-14.
- The Falcons also had four players score in double figures, led by Lavelle Scottie's 23 points and Jacob Van's 20.
- THE TURNING POINT: UNLV used a 12-0 run in overtime to take a 10-point lead at 91-81 with a minute left in the extra period. Juiston scored six points during the run, while McCoy had four.
- STAT OF THE GAME: UNLV made 14 of 17 free throws in the extra period.
- RUNNIN' REBEL OF THE GAME: In addition to McCoy's game highs in points and rebounds, he also blocked a game-high three shots. He was 9 of 18 from the field.
- QUOTABLE: "These games are always tough to coach when you go against really disciplined teams that have a very strong signature of how they play, and that's what this team does. They just fight, they never quit. They made 16 3s in their last game and 13 against us tonight. We were very prepared to play this type of game, especially after the two previous games where they were both close games. We were happy to come out on the winning side. It's nice to advance. That's where we're at and looking forward to getting our preparation in for the next one." - UNLV head coach Marvin Menzies.
- Three of the past four games between Air Force and UNLV in the Thomas & Mack Center have gone to overtime.
- This is the second time in three years that Air Force and UNLV have gone to overtime in the MW Tournament's first round.
- It was the third straight season that UNLV went to overtime in its opening game of the conference tournament.
- The Runnin' Rebels swept the season series (3-0) vs. Air Force.
- UNLV trailed for just 58 seconds in the entire game.
- UNLV improved to 4-0 all-time against Air Force in tournament play.
- The win snapped a five-game losing streak for UNLV.
- It was UNLV's first MW Tournament win since 2016.
- UNLV shot 51.7 percent from the field in the second half (15 of 29).
- UNLV out-rebounded Air Force, 41-31.
- UNLV led in second-chance points, 19-7.
- Air Force's bench outscored UNLV's 53-17.
- UNLV led by as many as 13 early in the second half.
- The Runnin' Rebels led 37-33 at halftime.
- There were nine ties and two lead changes.
- UNLV has made at least one 3-pointer in 1,038 straight games.
