The University of Nevada women's basketball team (2-7, 0-0 WAC) completed a three-game road trip with two stops in Southern California last week. The Pack dropped a tough contest against Long Beach State in overtime last Thursday with a score of 61-58. Junior Chanelle Brennan recorded her first career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds. Nevada closed out the road trip with another close game, falling to Cal State Fullerton 76-74. Kate Kevorken led the team with 21 points and nine rebounds.

Nevada will look to bounce back from its five-game losing streak when it hosts Oregon Wednesday night at Lawlor Events Center. The Pac-12 Ducks are currently 7-2 on the year and are coming off an 89-65 loss to Denver on Sunday. The team is lead by senior forward Amanda Johnson who is averaging 20 points and 10 rebounds. Oregon leads the series 4-0, with the last game taking place in the 2005-06 season where the Ducks won 61-50.

LAST TIME OUT

The University of Nevada women's basketball team ended a three-game road trip with a 76-74 loss to Cal State Fullerton Saturday evening.

Nevada and Cal State Fullerton began the game close as the two teams exchanged leads in the first six minutes of play. Senior Kate Kevorken got off to a great start, connecting on 3-5 of her attempts from downtown. The Titans took charge and got out to a nine point lead, powered by Megan Richardson's 17 first half points. The Titans shot a perfect 11-11 from the free throw in the half and took an 11 point lead into the intermission.

The Wolf Pack went on a run mid way through the second half, chopping the Titans 12 point lead to two with five minutes left in the game. Nevada found its way to the free throw line often and built up a six point lead at the three minute mark. Cal State Fullerton answered back by forcing Nevada into making turnovers to get within one point with 20 seconds left. The Titans scored on an inbounds play to go ahead leaving Nevada with an opportunity to score in the final seconds. The Pack moved the ball around looking to get someone open before they were forced into a turnover. The Titans knocked down a free throw to go up by two and then blocked Danika Sharp's three point attempt from half court to claim the win.

CLOSE GAMES FOR THE PACK

Although Nevada is 2-7 on the year, seven of the games have been decided by 10 points or less. The Pack is 1-6 in those games, defeating Butler 71-69 (2) in the Nugget Classic. Nevada is 1-3 in games decided by 5 points or less, losing to Cal State Fullerton 76-74 (2).

SPEAKING OF CLOSE GAMES

Nevada has battled teams late in games this season. Twice this year the game has gone into overtime. Nevada is 0-2 in its overtime games this year, falling to Pacific 75-70 and Long Beach State 61-58. As a program Nevada has played in 25 overtime games, going 8-17 (.32). Nevada's last overtime win occurred in the WAC tournament on March 12, 2009 against LA Tech 91-88. The most overtime games the Pack has had in a season is two (1997-1998)

PACK ON TOP OF THE WAC STATS

Nevada has players leading two WAC individual statistical categories. Forward Kayla Williams is in first for blocks with 16 and guard Danika Sharp has the best free throw percentage at .958.

SHARP FROM THE LINE

Sophomore guard Danika Sharp has been impressive at the free throw line, converting on 23-24 of her attempts this season. Her sharp shooting from the stripe puts her in first place in the WAC free throw percentage category at .958. Sharp made 24 straight free throws dating back to Nevada's WNIT second round loss to USC on March 20, 2011.

BLOCK PARTY FOR THE PACK

Nevada's 36 rejections on the year puts them in first place in that team WAC category.

BRENNAN STEPS UP

Guard Chanelle Brennan had a record night in the overtime loss against Long Beach State. Brennan collected her first career double-double 14 points and 10 rebounds. The two totals eclipsed her previous career best of seven points and five rebounds. The junior transfer has appeared in all nine games for the Pack, starting in two.

THE YOUNG BUNCH

After losing six seniors, Nevada is a young team in 2011-12. The Wolf Pack's 13-player roster features five newcomers, and just two seniors with more than one year of competition experience. Nevada has five newcomers joining the squad this year, all of whom will be true freshmen. The class adds two guards, two forwards and a center to the roster. Nevada added guards Faith Lois (5-11, Westosha, Wisc.) and Kelsey Kaelin (5-8, Tigard, Ore.) and forwards Emily Burns (6-0, Reno, Nev.) and Aja Johnson (6-1, Danville, Calif.). The final player of the incoming class adds significant size to the team. Standing at 6-7, Mimi Mungedi found her way to Nevada from Africa, hailing from Libreville, Gabon.

HEAD COACH JANE ALBRIGHT

- Head Coach Jane Albright will be in her fourth year leading the Wolf Pack, her 28th overall. She currently sits at a career record of 59-48 (.551) at Nevada, 456-360 (.559) overall and stands at 36th among active NCAA Division IA head coaches in total number of victories.

- Albright's 59 victories at the helm of Nevada puts her third all-time in the Wolf Pack record books. She stands as the winningest first-year head coach in school history when the 2008-09 team tallied 18 wins.

- After the 2009 season, Albright was honored at the Final Four by the WBCA with the Kay Yow "Heart of a Coach" award which is presented annually by the Fellowship of Christian Athletes to a basketball coach who has exemplified biblical practices over the course of his or her career.

- 2001-02 Naismith Coach of the Year finalist.

- Winningest coach in school history at two programs (Wisconsin and Northern Illinois).

- Coached Nevada's first-ever WNBA draftee in Tahnee Robinson (2011).

- Led Nevada to a school record 22 wins in 2011.

- Albright earned her 400th career win on Nov. 28, 2008, with a win over Northern Iowa.

- Albright has led her teams to nine NCAA Tournament appearances and three WNIT Tournament appearances including a second-place finish with Wisconsin during the 1998-99 season and a WNIT Championship with Wisconsin in 2000.

- Concerned with her student-athletes' development off the court as well as on it, Albright has led her team to complete more than 530 hours of community service over the last year.

- She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons including a 26-win season in 1989-90 with Northern Illinois.

- Head coach of the 1996 gold medal-winning USA Basketball Jones Cup Team.

- Four-time conference coach of the year (Big Ten-1995, Mid-Continent-1993 and North Star -1989 & 1990).

- Two-time Women's Basketball Coaches Association District IV Coach of the Year (1990 & 1995).

- As the team steadily has improved over the last few seasons, Nevada's attendance has as well. The Wolf Pack has averaged over 1,000 fans per game the last two seasons and its WNIT second-round game against USC in 2011 set a school record in attendance with 3,361 fans packing Lawlor Events Center. Four of the top 10 crowds ever to attend a Nevada home game have occurred since 2009. In the five years before Albright's arrival, Nevada averaged 730 fans per game at home.

TOUGH AT HOME

Nevada has pulled together and impressive run of success in the friendly confines of Lawlor Events Center going 33-18 at home in the last four seasons. In her first season leading the Wolf Pack, Jane Albright coached the team to its first win over a ranked opponent in program history when the Pack stunned then No. 7 Louisville by beating the Cardinals 85-82 at the 2008 John Ascuaga's Nugget Classic. Last year, Nevada went 11-5 at home after going a perfect 7-0 at Lawlor in the non-conference season. Nevada set a new record for home attendance in the WNIT second-round game, with 3,361 fans watching the Pack take on USC.

LEADING THE WAY

Nevada will be led by seniors Amanda Johnson from the point guard spot and forward Kayla Williams, the team's leading shot blocker from last year. Johnson led the WAC throughout last year in both assists per game and assist/turnover ratio while Williams collected eight double-doubles for the season including a career-high 20 rebounds against Pepperdine.

LESS EXPERIENCE, BUT STILL A SENIOR LEADER

Fellow senior Kate Kevorken has taken on an important role with the team after starting in place of the injured Shavon Moore at the end of last season. Kevorken currently leads the team in scoring at 15.8 points per game. Kevorken was a big piece of Nevada's offense in the loss to Cal State Fullerton, finishing with 21 points and nine rebounds.

ASSISTS MACHINE

Senior Amanda Johnson is quickly climbing Nevada's career assists list. The guard currently sits at sixth place on the program's career assists list at 293. Johnson spread the ball around effectively in Nevada's last game against Cal State Fullerton, dishing out three.

REBOUNDING EXPERTISE

Dating back to the beginning of the 2008-09 season, Nevada has out-rebounded or tied its opponents in rebounding in 58 games. This year, the Pack has out-rebounded 7 of its 9 opponents by a total margin of 4.1 boards per game. The Pack sits in first in the WAC in defensive rebounding percentage, defensive rebounds, offensive rebounding percentage, rebounding margin and offensive rebounds, and second in offensive rebounds.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE'S FOR #34

Senior forward Kayla Williams collected her 16th career double-double in the loss against Portland State with 20 points and 11 rebounds. Williams recorded a total of eight double-doubles in the 2010-11 season.

NUGGET CLASSIC HONORS FOR NEVADA

Seniors Kayla Williams and Kate Kevorken were both named to the John Ascuaga's Nugget Classic All-Tournament team this past weekend. Kevorken was a major factor in the team's Nugget Classic 71-69 win over Butler, leading all scorers with a career high 23 points. Kevorken followed that performance with 14 points and four assists in the Nugget Classic Championship loss to No. 16 Penn State.

Williams barely missed a 15th career double-double against the Bulldogs, finishing with 16 points and nine rebounds. The forward battled in the paint with the Lady Lions in the championship game, adding 14 points, five rebounds and three blocks.

KAELIN OUT

Freshman guard Kelsey Kaelin is out for the season after suffering a torn ACL. The guard suffered the injury during a pre-season scrimmage against Utah and will use a medical red shirt this year.

ALBRIGHT NAMES CAPTAINS

Head Coach Jane Albright has named Seniors Kayla Williams, Amanda Johnson, and Kate Kevorken Captains for the 2011-12 season.

NEVADA PICKED FOURTH IN WAC PRESEASON POLLS

The University of Nevada women's basketball team was selected fourth in both the preseason coaches and media polls released by the Western Athletic Conference this season. Nevada finished fourth last season with a 9-7 mark in WAC play. Louisiana Tech topped both polls with 144 points (13 first-place votes) in the media poll and 47 (five first-place votes) in the coaches poll. The coaches tabbed Utah State second and Fresno State third, while the media selected Fresno State second and Utah State third. Nevada had 33 points in the coaches poll and 80 from the media.

WILLIAMS AND JOHNSON HONORED BY WAC

Senior Kayla Williams was selected to the Preseason All-WAC first-team by the coaches and second-team All-WAC by the media. Fellow senior Amanda Johnson was named second-team All-WAC by the media.
