The University of Nevada women's basketball team (7-22, 3-11 WAC) will look to ride the momentum of two straight home wins into the Western Athletic Conference tournament's quarterfinal game against Utah State (20-8, 11-3 WAC) Wednesday 2:30 p.m. at the Orleans Arena.

This will mark the second time the schools have met in a conference tournament game. Nevada defeated Utah State 61-60 in the 2007 WAC tournament in Las Cruces, N.M. Utah State leads the overall series 9-8. The Aggies defeated the Wolf Pack in both meetings this season, handing Nevada a 91-69 loss in Logan and an 84-72 decision in Reno.

Nevada is just 7-11 all-time at the WAC Tournament. The Pack was eliminated in the first round of its first four trips to the tournament from 2000-04. The Wolf Pack recorded its first WAC Tournament win March 8, 2005 under then-head coach Kim Gervasoni when it defeated the Hawai'i Rainbow Wahine 65-61. The win was followed by a 64-54 loss to Rice to eliminate Nevada from the tournament. Since then, Nevada is 6-6. The most points the Wolf Pack has ever scored in a tournament game was 91 when it defeated LA Tech 91-88 March 12, 2009. The fewest points Nevada has ever scored was in a 45-41 loss to Hawai'i March 5, 2002. The Pack's greatest margin of victory came in a 76-61 (15 points) win over San Jose State March 7, 2006, while its greatest margin of defeat came in an 82-56 (26 points) decision against LA Tech March 12, 2008. Four times Nevada has been eliminated from tournament play by LA Tech. Nevada defeated Idaho in the first round of last year's tournament 75-61 before falling to Louisiana Tech 66-59.

LAST TIME OUT

The University of Nevada women's basketball team ended the regular season with a 76-72 Senior Day win over Louisiana Tech last Saturday afternoon at Lawlor Events Center.

Nevada rode the emotions of their four starting seniors early on, jumping out to a 13-4 lead. Louisiana Tech closed the gap on a layup by Jasmine Bendolph at the 12:22 mark to bring the score to 16-10. Nevada responded by hitting several shots from downtown to extend their lead to 12. The Wolf Pack knocked down 4-9 of its shots from beyond the arc in the first half while the Lady Techsters went 2-5. Louisiana Tech cut Nevada's lead to six on a layup by Tavasha Anderson. Chanelle Brennan's 10 points led Nevada to a 40-31 lead over Louisiana Tech at halftime.

Louisiana Tech looked determined to get back in the game out of the break. The Lady Techsters got within three points of the Pack on a basket by Shantale Brambale-Donaldson at the 18:06 mark. Nevada exchanged baskets with Louisiana Tech over the next several minutes to maintain a small lead. The Lady Techsters tied the game at 61-61 on two free throws from Bramble-Donaldson. Nevada reclaimed the lead on a free throw and jump shot by Kayla Williams. A made three point shot by Louisisana Tech's Whitney Jones tied the game at 66-66 with 4:09 left to go. Senior Amanda Johnson's steal and eighth assist on a Kevorken layup put Nevada up 69-66.

With eight assists in the game Johnson passed Dellena Criner (2005-2009) for third best on the program's career list. A layup by Jelena Vucinic at the 1:25 mark put Louisiana Tech up 70-69. Senior Amanda Johnson came up big late, hitting a jump shot with 57 seconds to go. The Pack made a strong defensive stand on the Lady Techsters next possession that led to a rebound, putting Kate Kevorken on the line where she made the first and missed the second. Nevada's missed free throws down the stretch allowed Louisiana Tech to have a chance to tie the game as they were down 75-72 with seven seconds left. The Lady Techsters inbounded a full court pass that was picked off by Kate Kevorken to seal a 76-72 win.

MARCH GLADNESS

After some early season struggles, Nevada has found its stride in the month of March by winning two consecutive games. The Pack opened up the month defeating New Mexico State 68-56 and followed that performance with a win against Louisiana Tech. The two consecutive wins is the first time the team has won back to back games this season. The two wins also secured the seventh seed for Nevada in the WAC tournament where they will face the second seed Utah State. The wins combined with two late New Mexico State losses gave Nevada the tie-breaker over the Aggies.

SENIOR DAY LEADERSHIP

The Louisiana Tech regular season finale marked the last game at Lawlor for seniors Kayla Williams, Kate Kevorken, Amanda Johnson and Christina Gough. The senior class came up big for Nevada in the 76-72 win. Kayla Williams led all scorers with 20 points, adding five rebounds, three steals and two blocks. Kate Kevorken just missed her fifth career double-double, finishing with 18 points and nine rebounds. Amanda Johnson handed out a career best tying eight assists.

CLOSE GAMES FOR THE PACK

Although Nevada is 7-22 on the year, 16 of the games have been decided by 10 points or less. The Pack is 5-11 in those games, defeating LA Tech in the regular season finale 76-72 (4), Idaho in the first meeting this season 76-70 (6), CSU Bakersfield 85-76 (9), Oregon 76-74 (2) and Butler 71-69 (2) in the Nugget Classic. Nevada is 3-6 in games decided by 5 points or less, losing to Hawai'i in the season rematch 72-68 (4).

CAPTAIN KATE LEADS THE TEAM

Senior captain Kate Kevorken has been a constant presence for Nevada on the offensive end this season. The forward has led Nevada in scoring in 15 of its 29 games, leading the team with 19 points in the win over New Mexico State. Kevorken recorded her fourth double-double in the game, adding 11 rebounds to her stat total. Kevorken's 15.9 ppg average is good for third best in the WAC. Her 62 made three-pointers puts Kevorken in second place in the WAC, averaging 2.14 made 3fg per game.

SPEAKING OF CLOSE GAMES

Nevada has battled teams late in games this season. Three times this year the game has gone into overtime. Nevada is 0-3 in its overtime games this year, falling to Idaho 87-86, Pacific 75-70 and Long Beach State 61-58. As a program Nevada has played in 26 overtime games, going 8-18 (.31). Nevada's last overtime win occurred in the WAC tournament on March 12, 2009 against LA Tech 91-88. The most overtime games the Pack has had previously in a season was two (1997-1998).

WILLIAMS CLIMBS NEVADA'S BLOCKS LIST

Forward Kayla Williams is making her way up to the top of Nevada's career blocks list. The senior has swatted away 114 shots during her four years with the team, which is good for second best in the program with Chris Starr (1982-86). Williams needs seven more to tie Katie Golomb (1998-2002) for the program's lead. Williams also sits in third in the single-season block category with 44 blocks. She needs five more to tie second place Jelena Zrnic (1996-1997).

HEAD COACH JANE ALBRIGHT

- Head Coach Jane Albright will be in her fourth year leading the Wolf Pack, her 28th overall. She currently sits at a career record of 64-64 (.500) at Nevada, 461-375 (.551) overall and stands at 36th among active NCAA Division IA head coaches in total number of victories.

- Albright's 63 victories at the helm of Nevada puts her third all-time in the Wolf Pack record books. She stands as the winningest first-year head coach in school history when the 2008-09 team tallied 18 wins.

- After the 2009 season, Albright was honored at the Final Four by the WBCA with the Kay Yow "Heart of a Coach" award which is presented annually by the Fellowship of Christian Athletes to a basketball coach who has exemplified biblical practices over the course of his or her career.

- 2001-02 Naismith Coach of the Year finalist.

- Winningest coach in school history at two programs (Wisconsin and Northern Illinois).

- Coached Nevada's first-ever WNBA draftee in Tahnee Robinson (2011).

- Led Nevada to a school record 22 wins in 2011.

- Albright earned her 400th career win on Nov. 28, 2008, with a win over Northern Iowa.

- Albright has led her teams to nine NCAA Tournament appearances and three WNIT Tournament appearances including a second-place finish with Wisconsin during the 1998-99 season and a WNIT Championship with Wisconsin in 2000.

- Concerned with her student-athletes' development off the court as well as on it, Albright has led her team to complete more than 530 hours of community service over the last year.

- She has led her teams to nine 20-win seasons including a 26-win season in 1989-90 with Northern Illinois.

- Head coach of the 1996 gold medal-winning USA Basketball Jones Cup Team.

- Four-time conference coach of the year (Big Ten-1995, Mid-Continent-1993 and North Star -1989 & 1990).

- Two-time Women's Basketball Coaches Association District IV Coach of the Year (1990 & 1995).

- As the team steadily has improved over the last few seasons, Nevada's attendance has as well. The Wolf Pack has averaged over 1,000 fans per game the last two seasons and its WNIT second-round game against USC in 2011 set a school record in attendance with 3,361 fans packing Lawlor Events Center. Four of the top 10 crowds ever to attend a Nevada home game have occurred since 2009. In the five years before Albright's arrival, Nevada averaged 730 fans per game at home.

AMANDA THE ASSISTS MACHINE

Senior Amanda Johnson is quickly climbing Nevada's career assists list with a total of 380. The guard passed Dellena Criner for third best on the program's career list with eight assists in the LA Tech Win. The senior needs five more to tie Laura Ingham (2001-03) for second best. Johnson's 123 assists this season is good for second best in the conference. Johnson is averaging 4.2 assists per game.

BRENNAN STEPS UP

Guard Chanelle Brennan has stepped up in her expanded role this year. The Junior transfer had scored in double-figures in 14 straight games, leading up to the win over New Mexico State. Brennan recorded a career high 20 points in the first loss to Hawai'i. In the overtime loss against Long Beach State, Brennan collected her first career double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds. The junior transfer has appeared in all 27 games for the Pack, starting in 19.

PACK ON TOP OF THE WAC STATS

Forward Kayla Williams leads the WAC individual statistical category for blocks with 44 at an average of 1.8 blocks per game.

BLOCK PARTY FOR THE PACK

Nevada's 125 rejections on the year puts them in first place in that team WAC category. The Pack is averaging 4.31 blocks per game as a team. In the CSU Bakersfield win Kayla Williams recorded six blocks in the game which is third best in the program's history.

REBOUNDING EXPERTISE

Dating back to the beginning of the 2008-09 season, Nevada has out-rebounded or tied its opponents in rebounding in 62 games. This year, the Pack has out-rebounded 13 of its 29 opponents. The Pack sits in first in the WAC in offensive rebounding percentage and offensive rebounds, and third in rebounding margin and rebounding offense.

SHARP FROM THE LINE

Sophomore guard Danika Sharp has been impressive at the free throw line, converting on 65-80 of her attempts this season. Her sharp shooting from the stripe puts her in third place in the WAC free throw percentage category at .813. Sharp made 24 straight free throws dating back to Nevada's WNIT second round loss to USC on March 20, 2011.

TEAM EFFORT IN FIRST WAC WIN

Nevada's first conference win against Idaho saw four players score in double digit figures. Kate Kevorken (18), Chanelle Brennan (15), Amanda Johnson (15), and Emily Burns (11). The Pack has had five games in which four or more players scored in double figures. LA Tech pt. 2 (4), Idaho pt. 2 (5), St. Martin's (5), CSU Bakersfield (5), and Idaho (4). Nevada is 4-1 in those games, losing to Idaho in overtime 87-86.

CAREER NIGHT FOR KAYLA

Senior Kayla Williams had a strong showing in the loss to Fresno State. Williams led Nevada in the battle in the paint, recording a career high 24 points against the Bulldogs.

KEVORKEN NAMED TO CAPITAL ONE ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT 8 TEAM

Kate Kevorken has excelled on the court and in the classroom this season. The senior who is majoring in Community Health Sciences is carrying a 3.86 cumulative grade point average and was named to the Capital One Academic All-District 8 team last week.

BURNS ADDS TO CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE TOTAL

Freshman Emily Burns made the most of her extended minutes in the San Jose State loss. Burns logged a season high 31 minutes and finished with her second career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds. Burns recorded her first double-double in the Idaho win, finishing with 11 points and 13 rebounds.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE'S FOR #34

Senior forward Kayla Williams collected her 18th career double-double in the win over CSU Bakersfield with 14 points and 11 rebounds. Williams recorded a total of eight double-doubles in the 2010-11 season. She has collected five this season.

AMANDA WITH A CAREER HIGH

Point guard Amanda Johnson has taken on a facilitator role this season in running Jane Albright's offense. Sensing a need to score to help keep Nevada ahead over Idaho, the senior recorded a career high 15 points in the 76-70 win.

JOHNSON PERFECT FROM THE FIELD IN CSU BAKERSFIELD WIN

Aja Johnson has provided a spark for Nevada in her young career wearing silver and blue. The freshman had a major impact on the win against the Roadrunners, finishing a perfect 8-8 from the field for a career high 17 points. Johnson also had six rebounds, three blocks, and two steals.

FRESHMEN MAKING THEIR MARK

As a young team, Nevada is leaning on production from its newcomers. Aja Johnson received her first career start in the Peppermill Holiday Classic consolation game against Mississippi St., logging 28 minutes and finishing with five points, five rebounds and four blocks. Johnson had a breakout game in the win over CSU Bakersfield, eclipsing her career high off the bench with 17 points, six rebounds and three blocks. Johnson shot 75 percent from the field in the Idaho win, finishing with six points and seven rebounds. Emily Burns recorded her second career double-double in the San Jose State loss. Logging 31 minutes of action with 10 points and 12 rebounds. The two newcomers both started the game against in-state rival UNLV. Johnson has started in four games this year while Burns has started in three.

WAC POW FOR KEVORKEN

Kate Kevorken had an impressive outing in the 76-74 win over Oregon. The senior recorded her second career double-double with 25 points, 11 rebounds and knocked down the game winning shot at the buzzer. With that performance Kevorken was named the Verizon Western Athletic Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week for Dec. 12-18. The honor marked the first WAC Player of the Week of her career.

THE YOUNG BUNCH

After losing six seniors, Nevada is a young team in 2011-12. The Wolf Pack's 13-player roster features five newcomers, and just two seniors with more than one year of competition experience. Nevada has five newcomers joining the squad this year, all of whom will be true freshmen. The class adds two guards, two forwards and a center to the roster. Nevada added guards Faith Lois (5-11, Westosha, Wisc.) and Kelsey Kaelin (5-8, Tigard, Ore.) and forwards Emily Burns (6-0, Reno, Nev.) and Aja Johnson (6-1, Danville, Calif.). The final player of the incoming class adds significant size to the team. Standing at 6-7, Mimi Mungedi found her way to Nevada from Africa, hailing from Libreville, Gabon.

PEPPERMILL HOLIDAY CLASSIC HONORS KEVORKEN

Senior Kate Kevorken had solid performances in both Nevada's Peppermill Holiday Classic games. Kevorken was named to the All-Tournament Team after finishing with 20 points and six rebounds against Long Island and a career high 27 points and seven rebounds against Mississippi State. This marked the second All-Tournament selection this season for Kevorken as she was named to the John Ascuaga's All-Tournament team earlier this year.

NUGGET CLASSIC HONORS FOR NEVADA

Seniors Kayla Williams and Kate Kevorken were both named to the John Ascuaga's Nugget Classic All-Tournament team this past weekend. Kevorken was a major factor in the team's Nugget Classic 71-69 win over Butler, leading all scorers with a career high 23 points. Kevorken followed that performance with 14 points and four assists in the Nugget Classic Championship loss to No. 16 Penn State. Williams barely missed a 15th career double-double against the Bulldogs, finishing with 16 points and nine rebounds. The forward battled in the paint with the Lady Lions in the championship game, adding 14 points and five rebounds.

KAELIN OUT

Freshman guard Kelsey Kaelin is out for the season after suffering a torn ACL. The guard suffered the injury during a pre-season scrimmage against Utah and will use a medical red shirt.

Head Coach Jane Albright has named Seniors Kayla Williams, Amanda Johnson, and Kate Kevorken Captains for the 2011-12 season.

WILLIAMS AND JOHNSON HONORED BY WAC

Senior Kayla Williams was selected to the Preseason All-WAC first-team by the coaches and second-team All-WAC by the media. Fellow senior Amanda Johnson was named second-team All-WAC by the media.

NEVADA PICKED FOURTH IN WAC PRESEASON POLLS

The University of Nevada women's basketball team was selected fourth in both the preseason coaches and media polls released by the Western Athletic Conference this season. Nevada finished fourth last season with a 9-7 mark in WAC play. Louisiana Tech topped both polls with 144 points (13 first-place votes) in the media poll and 47 (five first-place votes) in the coaches poll.
