### USC TO PLAY AT WASHINGTON STATE THURSDAY

• Trojans Begin Second Half Of Pac-12 Play •

TONIGHT'S GAME -- USC (6-16, 1-8) will play at Washington State (11-10, 3-6) in Pullman, Wash. on Feb. 2 at 7:00 p.m. USC snapped a nine-game losing streak in its last game and is seeking its first two-game winning streak since late November.

BREAKING DOWN THE COUGARS -- Washington State is coming off a 71-67 loss at Arizona State on Jan. 28 and is 2-5 in its last seven games. The Cougars are 8-1 in home games this season. WSU is led in scoring by junior forward Brock Motum (16.4 ppg). Senior guard Faisal Aden (14.5 ppg) was just diagnosed with a torn ACL and will miss the remainder of the season. USC is 67-44 all-time vs. the Cougars, but is 1-7 in its last eight trips to the Palouse.

USC SNAPS 9-GAME SKID -- USC jumped out to a 13-2 lead, led by 18 at the half and cruised to a 62-45 win at the Galen Center on Jan. 28, snapping a 9-game losing streak. The streak was the longest since losing 13 straight during the 1989 season. It was also the latest (0-8) the Trojans had picked up its first conference win since the 1989 season when they started 0-12. Garrett Jackson scored a career-high 16 points and Maurice Jones added 16 points, 5 rebounds and 5 assists. Byron Wesley had a season-best 7 assists and scored 9 points. USC shot 41.2 percent (7-for-17) from 3-point range, led by Greg Allen's 3-for-4 from beyond the arc. USC held Utah to 36.7 percent shooting for the game. It was the lowest shooting percentage by a Trojan opponent since holding New Mexico to 33.3 percent on Dec. 10.

WASHINGTON ON DECK -- USC will face Washington (14-7, 7-2) in Seattle on Feb. 4 at 8 p.m. The game will air on FSN with Joel Meyers and Ernie Kent calling the action. The Huskies are tied for first in the conference and will host UCLA on Feb. 2 before facing USC. Washington has won six of its last seven games and has three players averaging in double figures: Tony Wroten (17.1 ppg), Terrence Ross (15.1 ppg) and C.J. Wilcox (14.8 ppg). The Huskies are 11-2 at home this season. USC leads the all-time series 68-66 with the teams splitting the last 10 meetings. USC won at Washington last season and is 6-6 in the last 12 games at Washington.

AND THEN THERE WERE SEVEN SIX -- On the same day that USC's Aaron Fuller had surgery (Jan. 26), Dewayne Dedmon suffered an injury likely ending his season meaning USC now has five scholarship players who have suffered season-ending injuries: Dedmon (knee), Jio Fontan (knee), Fuller (labrum), Evan Smith (labrum) and Curtis Washington (labrum). USC has six scholarship players available on the active roster as two more players (Ari Stewart and Eric Wise) are transfers and unavailable until next season.

SUMMER MEMORIES... -- After the departure of four starters from last season, USC began its summer exhibition tour on Aug. 14 with a starting lineup of guards Jio Fontan, Maurice Jones and Evan Smith and forwards Aaron Fuller and Dewayne Dedmon. Only Maurice Jones remains playing from that starting lineup.

THE GOOD HANDS PEOPLE - As a young team playing with no senior scholarship players and just three scholarship players who had played in the USC system before, USC has committed just 11.5 turnovers per game, 26th best in the country. USC had 18 turnovers in the loss at Oregon State on Jan. 21, but has had 9 or less turnovers in six of the last seven games. USC has had 12 or less turnovers in 14 games. USC is tops in the Pac-12 with a +4.3 turnover margin.

FIRST AT THE HALF - USC led 32-14 at the half vs. Utah on Jan. 28, just the seventh time (5-2) all season the Trojans had led a game at halftime. USC's lead in the second half was its first following halftime in a game since winning 83-59 vs. TCU on Dec. 19.

**KO'S CORNER** -- Kevin O'Neill was named the USC head coach on June 20, 2009 and brought with him a tireless energy, a brilliant basketball mind and a vast depth of experience at both the collegiate and NBA levels. He has had highly successful stops as a coach or head coach at both the college and NBA levels which have helped him develop strong NBA ties and some impressive defensive systems. In three seasons at the helm of the USC program, O'Neill has compiled a 41-45 record. He guided USC to a 19-15 record and into the NCAA Tournament last season. The Trojans finished tied for fourth in the Pac-10 conference and reached the Pac-10 semifinals. Along the way he oversaw the development of NBA first round draft selection Nikola Vucevic, who went from averaging 2.6 points per game prior to O'Neill's arrival to averaging 17.1 points, a conference-leading 10.3 rebounds and first team all-conference honors. In his first season in 2009-10, O'Neill led USC to a 16-14 record and a fifth-place tie in the Pac-10 Conference. He was named the 2010 Pac-10 Coach of the Year by CollegeInsiders.com. USC was in the hunt for the conference title until the final two weeks of the season, despite playing the second half of the year under the knowledge that self-imposed sanctions would prohibit them from postseason play. O'Neill brings 14 years of collegiate and NBA head coaching experience and has worked in the coaching ranks for 31 years. He has served as a collegiate head coach at Marycrest (1983), Marquette (1990-94), Tennessee (1995-97), Northwestern (1998-00), Arizona (2008) and USC. He also was the NBA's Toronto Raptors' head coach in 2004. O'Neill has compiled a 229-239 career mark as a collegiate head coach, despite for the most part taking over programs that were rebuilding. When he served as an assistant at Arizona under Lute Olson from 1987-89, the Wildcats went 82-19 and went to the Final Four one season. He was named Olson's successor for the 2008 season and guided Arizona to a 19-15 record and into the NCAA Tournament despite four of its top five players being freshmen or sophomores. In seven of his 14 seasons as a head coach of a Division I program, he has guided his teams into the postseason.

**BIG GAME HUNTERS** -- USC has four wins against ranked teams outside of the conference in the three seasons with Kevin O'Neill as the head coach. The Pac-12 as a whole has a total of nine wins in that stretch against ranked non-conference opponents.

**FACING THE BEST** -- USC's 2011-12 schedule features 22 of 31 games against teams which finished the 2010-11 season with a record of .500 or better. Among the nonconference highlights were games against perennial national powers Kansas, UNLV, New Mexico, Minnesota, Nebraska, South Carolina and Georgia. Through games of Jan. 27, the teams USC has played are a combined 263-156 (62.8 winning percentage) and 16 of the 20 teams have 10 or more wins and only four of the teams are under .500. USC's last 13 opponents have a combined record of 174-88.

**TROJANS ON THE RADIO** -- USC's radio flagship station once again will be ESPN Radio 710 with Chris Fisher and Jim Hefner calling all the action.

**PAC-12 PREDICTIONS** -- USC was picked to finish 7th (194 points) in 2011-12 in the Pac-10 Conference in a vote by the league media. UCLA was picked 1st (421), California 2nd (405), Arizona 3rd (404), Washington 4th (355), Oregon 5th (282), Stanford 6th (255), Oregon State 8th (188), Arizona State 9th (148), Colorado and Washington State 10th (119) and Utah 12th (74).

**A HISTORY OF WINNING** -- USC has compiled a record of 1,500-1,087\* in its 106 years of inter-collegiate basketball competition. USC has had a .500 or better record in 76 of the first 105 seasons.

**THE GALEN ADVANTAGE** -- USC is 4-9 at home this season and is 67-28 in six seasons at the Galen Center since it opened on Nov. 16, 2006. USC is also 34-11 in nonconference games at the Galen Center.

**IT'S A NEW DAY...** -- The Trojans had to replace a great deal of their production from the 2010-11 season as starters Nikola Vucevic, Alex Stepheson, Donte Smith and Marcus Simmons all departed and returning senior point guard Jio Fontan suffered a torn ACL on the team's trip to Brazil this summer. That left Maurice Jones' 9.9 points and Garrett Jackson's 3.2 as the only returning scorers from a season ago. The 5-7 Jones is also USC's leading returning rebounder at 2.6 boards per game. USC returns 19.7 percent of its points per game and 12.4 percent of its rebounds per game, all lows for a Pac-12 team.

**TROJAN TIDBITS** -- USC has only three seniors on its roster, Jio Fontan who will likely miss this season due to injury, Eric Wise who transferred from UC Irvine and will have to sit out the 2011-12 season and walk-on guard Eric Strangis. Nine of USC's 17 players are either freshmen or sophomores. Ten of the 17 players never played in a game for the Trojans before the opener.

**INJURY UPDATES** -- Curtis Washington (So, F) had surgery to repair his labrum on Aug. 24 and is expected to miss the season. Jio Fontan (Sr. G) had surgery to repair his left ACL on Sept. 13 and is expected to miss the season. Evan Smith (So.\*, F) reinjured the left glenoid labrum of his left shoulder on Oct. 18 which had previously been repaired on Dec. 23, 2010. Smith was treated with a conservative treatment plan of rest and rehabilitation, with the goal of returning him to basketball activity without surgical intervention. He returned to action on Dec. 10 vs. New Mexico, but was shut down after the Dec. 22 game vs. Kansas and is done for the season. Aaron Fuller is scheduled to have surgery on his left labrum on Jan. 26 and is done for the season. Dewayne Dedmon suffered a torn MCL on Jan. 26 and is likely out for the season.

**PAC-12 TELECONFERENCES**

The Pac-12 media teleconferences began on Tuesday, Dec. 20 and then go every Tuesday from Jan. 3 until March 6. Media can call the Pac-10 at (925) 932-4411 for the call-in number. Kevin O'Neill's time slot begins at 11:20 a.m. To listen to the taped replay, media can call (402) 222-9927.

**A BIG HILL TO CLIMB** -- When starting point guard and senior leader Jio Fontan went down with a knee injury in August it left USC with just 19.7 percent of its scoring returning and 12.4 percent of its rebounding returning entering the 2011-12 season. In terms of returning scoring for teams from BCS conferences (ACC, Big East, Big 12, Big Ten, SEC and Pac-12), only 3 schools: St. Johns (3.7 percent), Boston College (10.8 percent) and Texas (17.0 percent) have a lower percentage of returning production. There were only eight schools in the country which entered the season with less than 20 percent of its scoring returning from a season ago.

**FULLER HAS SURGERY** -- USC forward Aaron Fuller, who was second on the team in scoring (10.6) and first in rebounding (5.9) when he was shut down for the season with a labrum tear in his left shoulder. He underwent successful surgery on his shoulder at USC Hospital on Jan. 26 performed by Dr. James Tibone. Fuller originally suffered a bilateral labrum tear in his left shoulder, his shooting shoulder, in a preseason scrimmage against Air Force. He mainly shot right-handed this season, but then suffered a slight tear in his right shoulder on the trip to the Bay Area. He scored in double-figures the first 6 games, but only 3 times in his final 12 games (all starts).

**DEDMON SUFFERS MCL TEAR** -- USC sophomore forward Dewayne Dedmon was diagnosed with a torn medial collateral ligament (MCL) in his left knee and a tibial bone bruise of his left leg and is likely out for the remainder of the season, it was announced on Jan. 27 by USC head coach Kevin O'Neill. Dedmon hurt his knee four minutes into the game on Jan. 26 when a Colorado player took a charge and fell back into Dedmon, hyper-extending his leg. Dedmon will begin a non-surgical treatment of rest and rehabilitation and will be evaluated week to week. Dedmon averaged 7.6 points and 5.5 rebounds in 20 games this season. As Dedmon has gotten to practice and play on a consistent basis, he has improved upon those numbers to 9.6 points and 5.9 rebounds in the first seven Pac-12 games before suffering the injury.

**OSU KNOCKS USC OFF ROUTE 66** -- USC held its first 19 opponents to 66 points or less before Oregon State scored 78 against the Trojan defense on Jan. 21. It was the first time USC had started a season holding the opposition to 66 points or less for the first 19 games since the 1948 season when it held all 24 opponents to under 66 points. USC has held its opponents to 58.1 points per game, 13th in the country.

**TOE THE LINE** -- In games USC has at least 20 free throw attempts they are 3-2 with the losses being a double-overtime setback vs. Nebraska and a 4-point loss to Georgia, which made 9 of 13 3-point shots to earn the win.

**NO DEFENSE FOR THIS** -- USC has been outscored from the free throw line by 69 points. USC has struggled at the charity stripe, making just 60.9 percent (204-for-335). USC's opponents have connected at a 74.8 clip (273-for-365).

**ALWAYS ENTERTAINING** -- Fifty-one of the 86 games played by USC in the last three seasons have been decided by 10 points or less (59.3 percent). Also, 22 of the 45 losses have been decided by 6 points or less. USC played five consecutive games decided by 7 points or less to start the season before losing by 11 points to UNLV on Nov. 25. It was the first time since the 2010 season and just the third time in the past 21 seasons USC had played five straight games decided by 7 points or less. USC then defeated South Carolina by three points on Nov. 26, before winning by 21 at UC Riverside and losing by 15 at Minnesota. USC then returned home to lose by three points to New Mexico and by four to Georgia. Ten of USC's 22 games this season have been decided by 7 points or less and seven by 4 points or less.

**DRIVEN BY DEFENSE** -- USC has held its opponents to 58.1 points per game and a 42.3 shooting percentage through the first 22 games. USC held opponents to a conference low of 62.7 points per game during the 2010-11 season. USC was 13-1 in games it held the opponent under 60 points last season, the lone loss being its NCAA Tournament loss to VCU (59-46), yet is 4-7 this season when holding the opponent under 60 points. In the past three seasons, USC has held the opponent to under 60 points 92 times and is 71-21 in those games (.772 winning percentage). USC also held the opposition to under 40 percent shooting 16 times during the 2010-11 season and was 14-2 in those games. During the past seven seasons USC has held the opponent to under 40 percent shooting 110 times and is 85-25 in those games (.773 winning percentage). USC has allowed 80 points or more just five times in the first 86 games under head coach Kevin O'Neill and one of those games was a double-overtime contest. USC is 0-5 in those games.

**IT'S A FINE LINE** -- In five of USC's 16 losses this season, it has made more baskets than the opposition (Nebraska, SDSU, UNLV, UNM, Oregon). In those five losses the Trojans were outscored 81-36 from the free throw line. In the 16 losses overall, USC has been outscored 207-131 from the free throw line. In 8 of the 16 losses, USC was within 3 points, tied or had the lead with under 4 minutes left in the game.

**LET'S GIVE THE DEFENSE SOME CREDIT...** -- USC has struggled to score points this season, averaging 54.0 points per game and eight times being held under 50 points which has all been duly noted. What hasn't been mentioned is that five teams USC has faced rank in the top 50 and 14 in the top 100 (out of 344 teams) in opponents scoring. Also, 8 of USC's 22 opponents rank in the top 61 in the country in opponents shooting percentage.

### USC RECRUITING CLASS FOR 2012-13 SEASON

The USC men's basketball program received signed National Letters of Intent (NLI) from guard J.T. Terrell of Peninsula JC in Port Angeles, Washington and forward Strahinja Gavrilovic from La Jolla Prep in La Jolla, Calif. it was announced on Nov. 9 by USC men's basketball head coach Kevin O'Neill.

"J.T. is a dynamic scorer that will be able to impact our team offensively next year," said O'Neill. "He comes in with the experience of playing in the ACC which will allow him to have an immediate impact in the conference. He's an exceptional athlete that can score in a number of ways. He's as talented a perimeter player as I've coached in college."

Terrell is rated as the No. 1 junior college player in America by Swannys Roundball Review. The ultra-quick guard is playing this season at Peninsula JC in Washington, following a freshman season at Wake Forest. In one exhibition game this season for Peninsula, he scored 29 points. Terrell averaged 11.1 points per game during the 2010-11 season at WF, second on the team and fifth among ACC freshmen. Terrell played in all 32 games for WF and made 18 starts, while recording 16 double-figure scoring games. He made a splash in his collegiate debut by scoring 26 points vs. Stetson on Nov. 12, 2010, setting the WF freshman record for points in a first game. He had a season-best 32 points vs. Iowa on Nov. 30, 2010, making seven three-pointers, including the game-winner with two seconds left in the game. His seven three-pointers made tied a WF freshman record. He made 35.7 percent from beyond the arc (50-for-140) and his 50 three-point baskets are the fourth-most ever by a WF freshman. Terrell was one of the top high school scorers in the country as a senior at West Charlotte High, averaging 30 points per game. He was ranked the No. 49 prospect overall by ESPN.com. Terrell was a two-time All-State selection and led West Charlotte to a 22-10 record and the 4A Finals as a senior. His father James lettered two years in basketball at UNC Charlotte (1991-92).

"Strahinja is a very skilled forward who has the ability to use both hands and score inside and outside," said O'Neill. "He can really rebound outside of his area. He has a bright future and his best basketball is ahead of him. Once he adjusts to the college game, we expect him to have a key role in our future. He has a wide repertoire of moves which allows him to score in a number of ways and makes him hard to defend."

Gavrilovic is a 6-8, 220 forward from Kragujevac, Serbia who came to the U.S. this fall and will play his senior year at La Jolla Prep. He is known to have a solid inside and outside game out to three-point range and honed those skills as a member of the Serbian U18 team at the European Championships. His father Zoran played professionally in Europe for more than a decade and is now the Secretary General of the Basketball Association in Serbia.

**FRESHMAN FOUNDATION** - USC freshmen guards Byron Wesley and Alexis Moore look to be providing the Trojans with good building blocks for the future. Through 22 games, Wesley is the fourth-leading scorer and third-leading rebounder on the team with averages of 7.4 and 4.8 respectively. He is also second on the team in assists with 41. Moore is fifth on the team with a 5.5 scoring average and is second on the team in three-point baskets (21). Wesley has started every game and his 33.5 minutes per game played are the most by a freshman in the Pac-12. Wesley's season high in points is 16 vs. UNLV on Nov. 25. Moore has started 14 times this season, including 12 of the last 13 games. Moore had a season-best 18 points on Dec. 17 vs. Georgia and has scored in double figures five times. Moore had a season-high five assists vs. Arizona on Jan. 8 and a season-best six rebounds on Jan. 28 vs. Utah.

**MIGHTY MO** -- USC's Maurice Jones is second the country in minutes played per game, averaging 38.32 through the first 22 games, one of only five players in the country averaging more than 38.0 minutes per game.

**BOARD GAMES** -- USC outrebounded California 38-28 on Dec. 29, including getting 18 offensive boards, its most since registering 20 in the third game of the 2010-11 season. USC is 4-2 this season when having more or the same amount of rebounds as the opposition and is 2-14 when being outrebounded. USC has been outrebounded in its last eight games. USC has allowed 10 or more offensive rebounds 12 times. Colorado had 51 rebounds vs. USC on Jan. 26, the most by a Trojan opponent since Stanford also had 51 on March 7, 2002.

**SHOOTERS FINDING THEIR MARK?** -- USC snapped a streak of six consecutive games shooting under 40 percent from the field when it shot 41.0 percent at Oregon on Jan. 19. In the last four games USC is shooting 42.3 percent from the floor (93-for-220), including one game of 32.2 percent. USC made just 34.4 percent of its shots (108-for-314) in its previous six games and is making 40.2 percent of its shots this season, last in the Pac-12. USC was 7-for-17 from three-point range (41.2 percent) on Jan. 28 vs. Utah after shooting 19.8 percent from three-point range in the previous seven games (18-for-91).

**TERRELL'S BEEN A TERROR** -- USC's top recruit JC guard J.T. Terrell has averaged 27.0 points through 19 games for No. 2 Peninsula JC (Wash.). He's hitting 51 percent from the field, 40 percent from three-point range and 81 percent from the foul line. In Peninsula's win on Dec. 3 vs. No. 7 Highline, Terrell scored 38 points, hit a three-pointer for the lead and then added two free throws to seal the victory. Terrell has scored 30 or more points in 9 of Peninsula's 19 games.

**WHERE DID HE COME FROM...** - Junior 5-10 walk-on Daniel Munoz came out of nowhere on Jan. 19 at Oregon to play 27 minutes for the Trojans, his first game of the season. His minutes, shots (0-for-3), points (2) and rebounds (3) were all career highs. Munoz had played a total of 5 minutes without a shot attempt in his 3-year career prior to the game at Oregon. Munoz then started on Jan. 21 at Oregon State and played a total of 12 minutes, including making his first career three-point basket to finish with three points.

**SLOW STARTS** -- In 14 of its 22 games, USC has scored more points in the second half. In the last 14 games, USC has scored under 20 points in the first half six times, but scored 28 or more points in the second half in 10 of those games. In the last 14 games, USC has shot under 30 percent in the first half five times. USC has shot under 30 percent only one time in the second half in the last 14 games (at Stanford, .261).

**TROJANS ON TV** -- USC's men's basketball team will have 21 to 26 of its 31 regular season games broadcast on television or available online this season. Six games are slated to be aired nationally on Fox Sports Net (FSN), seven regionally on Prime Ticket or Fox Sports West (FS West) and one each on the Big Ten Network, the Mountain West Sports Network and Comcast SportsNet California. Four games are potential wildcard selections during Pac-12 play. Additionally, five Trojan home games will be streamed live exclusively on USCTrojans.com and as always, all home games will be archived on USCTrojans.com.

**JONES EARNS HONORS** -- USC guard Maurice Jones was named Pac-12 Player of the Week for the week of Nov. 21-27 as he averaged 19.0 points and 3.0 assists and the Trojans went 2-1. In the 63-60 win vs. South Carolina on Nov. 26, Jones set a USC record by making all seven 3-point attempts. He made 57.1 percent of his field goal attempts for the week (20-for-35) and 62.5 percent of his 3-point attempts (10-for-16). He was also named Pac-12 Player of the Week by College Sports Madness and was named to the Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament team.

**ROSTER BREAKDOWN** -- There are 17 players on the 2011-12 USC men's basketball roster, including two transfers who will have to sit out this season (Ari Stewart and Eric Wise) and two players who are injured and will likely miss the season (Jio Fontan and Curtis Washington). **VUCEVIC KEEPS USC ROLLING IN THE NBA DRAFT** -- USC's Nikola Vucevic was selected by Philadelphia as the 16th pick in the 2011 NBA Draft, becoming the fifth Trojan selected in the first round of the draft since 2007. USC's five first-round selections ties for the fifth-most in the country during that period and only USC and Kansas have had at least one player selected in the top 16 picks in four of the last five drafts. USC has had more first round selections in the past five years (2007-11) than any Big East team and more than perennial power Duke.

**SUMMER BUSINESS TRIP TO BRAZIL** -- USC went 2-2 on a four-game trip to Brazil in August in which they played some of the top Brazilian professional teams. Jio Fontan scored 57 points in the first two games before getting injured in the third game. Maurice Jones averaged 13.8 points and Garrett Jackson averaged 9.5 points and 8.0 rebounds in the four games. Dewayne Dedmon improved in each game and finished the trip with a 19-point, 5-rebound and 4-block effort. Alexis Moore started the final game in place of Fontan and poured in 16 points and had four assists and just one turnover.

USC made two more field goals and two more 3-pointers than SDSU. The Aztecs also controlled the boards, outrebounding USC 36-26. Jones led USC with 15 points and Garrett Jackson keyed the comeback with two late 3-pointers and finished with a career-high 13 points. Aaron Fuller had 12 points and 7 rebounds, while Dewayne Dedmon added 10 points, all in the second half.

Phil Martin had 13 points to lead UCR, who saw its 16-game home winning streak against non-conference opponents snapped. A sellout crowd of 2,753 packed the small Student Recreation Center to see the game, more than 2,000 more fans than UCR had in its first home game. UCR jumped out to a 10-2 lead by hitting its first three shots and two free throws 16-5 run and never looked back. Maurice Jones added 6 points and a career-high 7 assists for USC. USC shot a season-best 54.3 percent and outrebounded UCR 27-22, despite playing its first game without forward Dewayne Dedmon who was diagnosed with a stress injury in his right foot two days ago and is expected to miss 4-6 weeks. Dewayne Dedmon added 14 points, 6 rebounds, 3 blocks and 3 steals. Bryron Wesley had 13 points and a season-best six assists. USC's 83 points were its most since scoring a 2010-11 season-best 86 points vs. Santa Clara on Nov. 15, 2010. Aaron Fuller just missed on his first double-double as a Trojan by scoring 9 points and grabbing a season-best to date 11 rebounds. The losing streak was the longest since losing 13 straight during the 1989 season. THE 2011-12 TROJANS -- USC returns only two players who logged significant minutes for the 2010-11 team. USC went 19-15 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament where it lost in the first round to eventual NCAA Final Four team VCU. The lone player returning who started a year ago is 2010-11 Pac-10 All-Freshman team selection Maurice Jones (25 starts). Jones averaged 9.9 points, 3.2 assists and 2.6 rebounds, while setting the USC freshman steals record with 69. The 5-7 guard's 2.6 rebounds per game are the most by a returning Trojan. USC lost key seniors Marcus Simmons, Donte Smith and Alex Stepheson and junior Nikola Vucevic departed early for the NBA. Also, USC had expected to rely heavily on senior point guard and co-captain Jio Fontan, but he tore his ACL on the team's exhibition trip to Brazil in August. With Fontan's injury, only Jones (337 points), sophomore forward Garrett Jackson (107 points) and injured redshirt sophomore forward Evan Smith (13 points) have scored any points in a Trojan uniform entering this season.
