SERIES HISTORY

This is the 219th meeting between USC and UCLA. The Bruins lead, 120-98. However, USC has won five of the last seven against the Bruins and two in a row at Pauley Pavilion.

LAST MEETING: Dijon Thompson scored eight of his 24 points in the final 4:45 and UCLA rallied from an 18-point halftime deficit to beat USC, 72-69, at the Sports Arena, snapping a four-game losing streak to the Trojans. Freshman Nick Young led USC with 22 points, while fellow frosh Gabe Pruitt added 19.

THE COACHES

USC: The Trojans are coached by Jim Saia, who is 9-13 so far serving as interim head coach following the dismissal of Henry Bibby on Dec. 6. He is 0-1 against UCLA as a head coach.

UCLA: Ben Howland is in his second year coaching the Bruins, with an overall record of 25-26. He is 1-2 against the Trojans while at UCLA.

QUICKIE THEMES:

--USC is looking to win at Pauley Pavilion for the third-straight time, a feat the Trojans have never pulled off

--The Return of **Jim Saia**, former UCLA assistant, to Pauley Pavilion. He was Steve Lavin's top assistant for seven years (1997-2003) and helped the team to an Elite Eight and five Sweet 16 appearances.

--The Top 2 Pac-10 Freshmen of the Year candidates--**Gabe Pruitt** and **Jordan Farmar**--square off in round 2 of their opening seasons

LOS ANGELES — The USC men's basketball team--now 11-15 overall and 4-11 in Pac-10 play--goes for its third-straight win at UCLA's Pauley Pavilion as it takes on the resurgent Bruins (14-9, 8-7) on Thursday at 7:30 p.m. in a game that will be telecast live on Fox Sports Net 2. No Trojan team has ever beaten the Bruins three-straight in Pauley dating back to when the building opened in 1965. It's the return of USC interim coach **Jim Saia** to Westwood, where he was a top assistant under Steve Lavin from 1997-2003. USC is trying to crawl out of the cellar of the Pac-10 in time to make the conference tournament in early March and has won two of its last three. Following Trojan head coach Henry Bibby's dismissal on Dec. 6, the Trojans are 9-13 under Saia's direction. New coach **Tim Floyd** is waiting in the wings to take over at Troy when the season concludes.

SCOUTING USC — The Trojans are led by two of the top freshmen in the Pac-10: **Pac-10 Freshman of the Year Candidate Gabe Pruitt** (12.7 ppg, team-best .450 from 3-point range) and explosive 6-6 swingman **Nick Young** (11.5 ppg), who is tied with UCLA's Jordan Farmar for the lead among Pac-10 frosh in conference scoring (13.9, with Pruitt a shade behind at 13.8). But the Trojans' leading scorer is lights-out shooter **Lodrick Stewart**, a sophomore who averages 13.0 ppg. USC has six seniors--the most on any team in the Pac-10.

SCOUTING UCLA — The Bruins are led by senior forward Dijon Thompson (18.7 ppg, 8.1 rpg), who is among the most versatile players in the Pac-10. On his heels are three talented freshmen led by point guard Jordan Farmar (13.5 ppg, 5.13 apg), guard Arron Afflalo (10.2 ppg) and forward Josh Shipp (9.0 ppg). UCLA is coming off a 78-65 loss at Stanford. The Bruins are 9-3 at home this season, but have dropped three of their last four at Pauley.

LEXUS GAUNTLET — This game is worth five points in the battle for the Lexus Gauntlet, the annual all-sports contest between USC and UCLA. The Bruins currently lead, 35-20.

NEXT UP — The Trojans close out their regular season by hosting Oregon on Thursday, March 3, and Oregon State on Saturday, March 5. Both games will be played at the Sports Arena at 7:30 p.m.

INTERIM HEAD COACH JIM SAIA (9-13)

Jim Saia, previously an assistant coach at UCLA and a veteran of West Coast basketball, was named the 2004-05 interim head coach of the USC men's basketball program on Dec. 4, 2004, following the dismissal of Henry Bibby.

Saia, 40, came to USC after seven years (1997-2003) as an assistant coach at UCLA, where he helped the Bruins advance to an Elite Eight (1997) and make five Sweet 16 appearances (1998-2002). UCLA won more than 20 games in each of his first six years there.

He was the offensive coordinator from 2000-2002, helping direct one of most potent offenses in the Pac-10. UCLA led the conference in field goal percentage (48.0%) in 2000 and was second in three-point percentage (37.1%). In 2001, the Bruins were second in three-point percentage (35.5%) and third in scoring (79.5). In 2002, UCLA was second in both field goal (47.2%) and three-point (39.0%) percentage.

In his three years as coordinator, UCLA posted its most prolific three-point totals ever, making a school record 223 in 2002, 205 in 2000 and 190 in 2001. The 2002 Bruin team also posted the second-highest single game field goal percentage mark in school history when it shot 72.9% against South Carolina.

Saia's Bruin coaching successes carried over into recruiting, where his talents assisted UCLA in landing the nation's No. 1 (2001, 1998) and No. 2 (1997) ranked recruiting classes. Saia coached 10 Bruins who went on to the NBA, including Baron Davis, Dan Gadzuric, Earl Watson, Jason Kapono and Jerome Moiso.

Before arriving at Westwood, Saia was the head coach at Columbia College, a junior college in Sonora, CA, from 1994-96. During his two-year head-coaching career at Columbia, he led the Claim Jumpers to a 61-10 overall record, two Central Valley Conference (CVC) championships and he earned two CVC Coach of the Year honors. In 1996, Columbia advanced to the Final Eight in state junior college play and ended the season ranked No. 3 with a 30-5 overall record. Saia's 1995 club was rated No. 7 in the state and finished with an overall record of 31-5.

His two-year conference mark was 25-3. Every sophomore on Saia's Columbia teams graduated or pursued their education at a four-year college. When Saia took over the Columbia program in 1994, the Claim Jumpers had no returning starters and he only had six weeks to recruit a team. His 1994-95 squad, picked for last place in the coaches' preseason poll, finished with a 31-5 overall record.

Prior to his head coaching stint at Columbia, Saia was an assistant coach at the Division I level at Fresno State (1990-94, earning a Master's degree), Indiana State (1989-90) and at California (1988-89). During his years at Fresno State, the Bulldogs in 1994 were 21-11 overall and advanced to the NIT and in 1991, FSU was runner-up in the Big West Tournament. While at Cal in 1989, the Golden Bears were 20-13 overall and also played in the NIT.

In 1994, Saia was head coach of the Athletes In Action USA team and in 1993 he coached AIA's Division I summer tour squad. A respected clinician, Saia was director of the Fresno State Camp from 1990-94 and has toured the country lecturing at clinics about individual offensive and defensive skills.

As a player, Saia's basketball career began at Sir Francis Drake High in San Anselmo, Calif. In 1981 and '82, Saia's junior and senior prep years, Sir Francis Drake was 65-1 overall and won two California state championships. From 1982-84, he played at Cal Poly-San Luis Obispo and helped lead the Mustangs to a 20-win season. Saia spent the 1984-85 college season at College of Marin in Kentfield, Calif, leading the Mariners to the state tournament and earning all-conference honors. He concluded his college career at Chapman University. From 1985-87 at Chapman, Saia earned Best Defensive Player and Coaches Awards.

Born June 15, 1964 in San Francisco, Saia is single and resides in Marina Del Rey.

LAST GAME — Freshman Gabe Pruitt hit five 3-pointers in the first half, and Jeff McMillan had 19 points and 10 rebounds to lead USC to its second road victory of the season, 89-70 over California on Saturday, Feb. 19. Pruitt scored all 19 of his points before halftime, and Nick Young added 15 for the Trojans, who swept Cal for the first time since 2001. USC built a 13-point halftime lead and led by as much as 24 in the second half. The Trojans had a season-high 26 assists and notched five players in double figures for the sixth time this season.

NEW COACH ON THE HORIZON—It's been a coaching whirlwind for USC this season. First ninth-year coach Henry Bibby was fired on Dec. 6, and replaced by interim coach Jim Saia. Then former Utah coach Rick Majerus took the job on Dec. 15, only to back out five days later, citing health reasons. Friday, Jan. 14, saw the hiring of **Tim Floyd**, who previously coached in college at Iowa State (where he had great success, posting three-straight 20-win seasons). Floyd will spend this season as a Trojan assistant so that he can recruit, but he will not be involved in coaching the 2004-2005 USC team. Saia will finish out this season for Troy.

NOODLES—USC's recruiting class was ranked as high as seventh by one expert. The two jewels of the class--and the prime building blocks of USC teams to come--are Gabe Pruitt and **Nick Young**. While Pruitt's exploits are noted later, Young--nicknamed "Noodles"--is making quite a name for himself lately. An explosive 6-6 swingman who can jump out of the gym, Young leads the team in scoring in conference games at 13.9 ppg--tied with Jordan Farmar of UCLA for highest in-conference scoring average for a Pac-10 freshman. He has four games of 20 points or more this season and is quickly becoming known around the league for his highlight-reel dunks and acrobatic moves around the basket. In his first game against the Bruins, he led the Trojans with a career-high-tying 22 points on 8-of-12 shooting (including 3-of-4 from 3-point range). He has scored in double figures in 10 of 15 Pac-10 games. In the last four contests, he is averaging 15.0 ppg.

LOD AND CLEAR — Sophomore guard **Lodrick Stewart** is one of the top outside shooters in the Pac-10, with a stroke that is hard to stop once it gets going. He leads the Trojans in scoring this season (13.0 ppg). He has scored in double figures in 17 games this season and has scored 20 points or more six times, including a career-and-USC-season-high 27 against San Diego. In his career, he has eight games of 20 points or more. Coming into this week, he is seventh in the Pac-10 in 3-point FG% (.417) and second in 3-pointers made (2.62 pg). His 68 3-pointers made this year are the most ever by a Trojan sophomore and tied for sixth on the all-time USC single-season 3-point list. His .417 shooting from beyond the arc is the best-ever percentage by a Trojan sophomore.

YOUTH IS NOT WASTED ON YOUNG, PRUITT AND STEWART — Sophomore Lod Stewart and freshmen Gabe Pruitt and Nick Young are the top three scorers on the Trojan basketball team. Between the three of them, they account for 50.2% of USC's points scored this season (966 out of 1,925). They average a combined 37.1 points per game. In conference play, they have scored 595 of USC's 1,077 points--55% of USC's total (39.6 points per game). Stewart (8 times), Pruitt (8 times) and Young (5 times) have led the Trojans in scoring in 21 of USC's 26 games. This is the first time in USC history that neither a junior or senior is among the top three in scoring for the Trojans.

BABY SHAQ IS BACK! — In game one against UC Irvine, junior guard Dwayne 'Baby Shaq' Shackelford made a big splash with 12 points, then didn't reach double figures again until game 24 against ASU, when he scored 10. He added 11 against Stanford to go with a then-career-high 5 assists. He then topped that mark with 7 assists against California. So in the last three games, Shackelford has been a boost off the bench at the point guard spot, averaging 8.6 points and 5.0 assists while making 6-of-13 three pointers (.460).

SENIORITIS — The Trojans have six seniors--guards Errick and Derrick Craven, and forwards Rory O'Neil, Jeff McMillan, Nick Curtis and Greg Guenther--the most of any team in the Pac-10. Between the six of them, they have played 12,071 minutes, scored 4,233 points, snagged 2,400 rebounds and dished out 759 assists in their careers.

BALANCING ACTS — USC is 6-0 this year in games where at least five players score in double figures.

3-POINT KINGS — The Trojans lead the Pac-10 in three-point field goals made per game (8.0). USC is 9-2 in games where it hits at least nine three pointers. In the past four games, the Trojans are 43-of-98 (.438) from beyond the arc, hitting at least 10 threes in each of those games. The Trojans have hit 23 3-pointers in their last two games.

ROAD WOES — The Trojans have only two road wins this year--a 98-94 victory over Arizona State on Jan. 15 in Tempe and last week's 89-70 win over Cal. If USC fails to beat UCLA, it will have its fewest road wins in a season since also winning two in 1990.

Gabriel Pruitt

2005 Pac-10 Freshman of the Year Candidate

Freshman point guard **Gabe Pruitt** is quickly establishing himself as one of the best young point guards in the country. He is known as “Smilin’ Gabe” to Sports Arena PA announcer Petros Papadakis because of his pleasant demeanor on the court.

Reasons for Gabe to Smile:

- He leads all Pac-10 freshmen in points scored (331), 3-point FG% (.450), 3-point FGs made (59) and steals (52). He is second among all freshman in assists (86) and is third in overall scoring average (12.7).
- In conference games, his 13.8 ppg is just a shade behind the 13.9 average shared by teammate Nick Young and UCLA’s Jordan Farmar for highest average in Pac-10 games by a freshman.
- His .450 shooting from 3-point range is the best percentage in USC history and currently fourth-best in the Pac-10
- He is second in the conference in steals at 2.0 per game
- He has a chance to become the first freshman to lead USC in scoring since Harold Miner in 1990
- His .485 FG% is the best-ever by a Trojan freshman guard
- He has hit at least one 3-pointer in 24 of 26 games this year
- He is just one 3-pointer shy of Harold Miner’s USC freshman record for 3-pointers made in a season (60)
- In his last 2 games, he is averaging 21.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg, 2.0 apg and 2.0 spg, while shooting .520 from the field (13-of-25) and .600 from 3-point range (12-of-20)
- In his last 4 games, he is averaging 19.5 ppg, 5.0 rpg, 3.0 apg and 2.0 spg, while shooting .490 from the field (25-of-51) and 18-of-34 from 3-point range (.529)
- In his last 8 games, he is averaging 17.1 ppg on 47-of-93 from the field (.505) and 30-of-56 from 3-point range (.535)
- In his last 11 games, he is averaging 14.1 ppg on 56-of-111 from the field (.504) and 37-of-66 from 3-point range (.560)
- He has led USC in scoring in 4 of the last 6 games and in 5 of the last 8 and a total of 8 times on the season
- His 12.7 ppg is the fourth-highest scoring average ever by a USC freshman and best since Harold Miner averaged 20.6 ppg on his way to earning Pac-10 Freshman of the Year honors in 1990
- His 86 assists is the fifth-most by a Trojan freshman
- He has shot 50% or better from the field in 15 of USC’s 26 games
- His seven 3-pointers against Stanford was the second most in a game in USC history

USC has already signed two players for 2005-2006: 6-8 small forward Mike Freeman of Alexandria, VA, and 6-3 shooting guard Sead Odzic of Skokie, IL.

SENIORS AND UCLA — The current crop of USC seniors are 5-2 against UCLA. Technically, however, senior forward Gregg Guenther has been on teams that went 9-2 against the Bruins—when you count his stint with the USC football team from 2000-2003.

IMPROVEMENT ON OFFENSE — The 1-4 Ralph Miller offense installed by Jim Saia this season has resulted in some improved statistics for USC on that side of the ball. The Trojans are better than last year in shooting percentage (.449 vs. .432), 3pt FG% (.367 vs. .308) and assists (15.4 per game vs. 13.6 per game).

LOTS OF ASSISTS — Speaking of assists, USC had a season-high 26 against California last Saturday, which was its most since also getting 26 against Arizona State in 1998.

PAST GLORY — Fifty years ago this calendar year, the Trojans went to their last NCAA Final Four. The 1953-54 USC basketball team was coached by Forrest Twogood and was captained by forward Dick Welsh. The Trojans fell to Bradley, 74-72, in their semifinal game. Bradley went on to lose to La Salle (which beat USC earlier this season, coincidentally) in the NCAA title game.

NEW ARENA COMING — Thanks to the generosity of Louis and Helene Galen, USC's athletic department has begun construction on The Galen Center—a new \$114 million, 10,258-seat campus events center that will be home to USC men's basketball. Complete with locker rooms, offices and practice facilities for both basketball and volleyball, The Galen Center is scheduled to be completed in 2006.

FLOYD — Tim Floyd, who has 17 years of head coaching experience at the collegiate and NBA levels, was hired on Jan. 14 as the head men's basketball coach at USC, effective on April 1, 2005, Trojan athletic director Mike Garrett announced. Floyd will spend this year as a Trojan assistant so that he can recruit, but he will not be involved in coaching the 2004-05 Trojans. Jim Saia, who was appointed USC's interim head coach when Henry Bibby was relieved of his duties as head coach on Dec. 6, will remain in that role the remainder of this season. Floyd, 50, served as a college head coach at Idaho, New Orleans and Iowa State before NBA head coaching stints with the Chicago Bulls and New Orleans Hornets. He had great success during his 12 seasons at the college level, going 243-130 (.651) overall with 5 NCAA Tournament appearances.
