### 2013-14 SEASON (SR):

Earned honorable mention all-MW honors... Started 27 games... In the final NCAA stats, ranked 73rd in overall rebounding (8.3), also ranking 35th in defensive rebounds per game (6.33) and 93rd in double-doubles (8)... Ranked 13th in the MW in scoring (14.1) and eighth in rebounding (8.3), also ranking fourth in field goal percentage (.483), as well as eighth in blocks (1.1)... In MW only stats, ranked tied for 14th in scoring (13.6), as well as fifth in both rebounds (8.8), field goal percentage (.455) and eighth in blocked shots (1.2)... Shot 48.3 percent (157-of-325) from the field along with 78.2 percent (68-of-87) at the free throw line... Posted second-straight and eighth double-double of the season and 17th of career with 14 points and 10 rebounds against Wyoming (3/5), which came after 19 points and career-high 17 rebounds at San José State (3/1)... Registered first double-double of the season with season-high 24 points and 10 rebounds against Southern Utah (11/12), then logged second double-double of season with 12 points and season-high 13 rebounds against BYU (11/30), before recording third of year with 17 points and 10 rebounds against Colorado State (1/15)... Also posted double-doubles in back-to-back games with 17 points and season-high tying 13 rebounds vs. Nevada (2/5) and 17 points and 10 boards against Boise State (2/8), then third in four games with 20 points, 12 rebounds vs. UNLV (2/15)... Tallied double-digit points in 18 of last 24 games as part of 20 total times this season... Had career-long streak of scoring in double-digits snapped at 15-straight games dating back to last season, with nine at UC Santa Barbara (11/16)... Logged double-digits in 44 of his 56 career games... Had four 20-point games this season and eight for his career, after tying season-high with 24 points at Boise State (1/18), matching 24 from the Southern Utah (11/12), adding 20 points against both Weber State (11/26) and UNLV (2/15)... Snared at least seven boards in 19 of last 22 games played and 22 total times this season... Had double-digit rebounds in nine games this season and 17 career games, including streak of four-straight in early February... His 17 rebounds were most by an Aggie and most since Spencer Butterfield snared 20 last season against Texas State on March 7, 2013... Posted 11 games this season and 15 career games with multiple blocks with three against USC (11/8), Colorado State (1/15), Nevada (2/5) and Fresno State (2/22), marking the seventh time with three or more rejections.

### 2012-13 SEASON (JR):

Played in all 31 games, one of five Aggies to do so, and made 30 starts... Led the team and ranked sixth in the WAC with 14.2 points per game, while also averaging 8.4 rebounds per game, also leading the team and ranking third in the league and 71st in the nation... Posted a 53.9 percent field goal percentage (179-of-332), ranking fourth in the conference and 50th in the NCAA... Was also 81st in the country in double-doubles with nine... Shot 72.3 percent at the free throw line (81-of-112), ranking 12th in the WAC... Additionally, ranked ninth in the WAC in blocked shots with 0.97 per game... Tallied career-high scoring in back-to-back games with 21 points against Louisiana Tech (1/26) and then topping that with 27 points at Idaho (1/31)... Registered team-leading nine double-doubles, most recently with team-high 15 points and 10 rebounds in Texas State game on March 7... Logged his other eight double-doubles against Saint Mary's (17 pts./15 reb.), Weber State (16p/12r), Utah Valley (12p/11r), Nicholls State (19p/11r), and back-to-back games against Idaho (12p/12r), San José State (12p/10r), Louisiana Tech (21p/14r) and Illinois State (18p/11r), just missing a
