NOTES

The Larry Krystkowiak Era Begins

- On April 4, 2011, Larry Krystkowiak was hired to become the 15th head coach in the history of Utah men's basketball. Krystkowiak (pronounced krist-KOH-vee-ak), who has head coaching experience in the NCAA, CBA and NBA, left a position as an assistant coach with the New Jersey Nets to return to the college ranks.

- Krystkowiak's previous collegiate head coaching appointment was at his alma mater, the University of Montana, where he racked up a 42-20 record from 2004-06. He led the Grizzlies to NCAA tournament appearances in both years, winning the Big Sky Conference Tournament in 2005 to earn an automatic bid, then receiving an at-large selection in 2006.

Utah Prepares for Inaugural Season in the Pac-12

- Utah basketball will take its heralded tradition to a new stratosphere this season as the Runnin' Utes and the rest of the Utah Athletics department makes the move to the Pac-12.

- The Runnin' Utes own an all-time record of 146-114 (.562) against Pac-12 teams. Their record at home against Pac-12 foes stands at 92-31 (.748).

- Utah's record against each Pac-12 team is as follows: Arizona (28-21); Arizona State (25-17); California (8-8); Colorado (15-20); Oregon (8-7); Oregon State (12-7); Stanford (14-7); UCLA (4-4); USC (14-15); Washington (5-6); Washington State (13-2).

- As a previous member of the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (1925-37), Skyline Conference (1938-62), Western Athletic Conference (1963-99) and Mountain West Conference (1999-2011), Utah has racked up 29 conference titles, the fifth-most in NCAA Div. I history. Krystkowiak's Utes will now look to create and maintain that same success at an even greater level of competition and noteriety.

Utes Bring Back Four and Welcome 11 New Players in 2011-12

- Utah returns four players from the 2010-11 squad, including two starters, seniors David Foster and Josh Watkins. Watkins, a third-team all-MWC selection last year, is the team's top returning scorer and assists-man with 14.5 points and 3.5 helpers per game. Foster led the MWC in blocks the last two years and was ranked among the top 10 in the nation. A two-time MWC All-Defensive Team selection and the MWC Defensive Player of the Year in 2010, he is also the Utes' top returning rebounder at 5.2 boards per game.

- Using last year's Pac-10 final statistics (including all games), Watkins' 14.1 points per game would rank No. 11 in the league, while his 3.5 assists would rank ninth. Foster's 3.2 blocks would have ranked No. 1 in the conference by a full block per game, while his 5.2 boards per contest would have been among the top 20. Additionally, junior center Jason Washburn's 61.8% shooting from the field would have ranked No. 1, had he made the required 3.0 field goals per game.

- The Utes bring in 11 new players to the squad this year, including seven transfers and four true freshmen. Eight of the 11 newcomers will be eligible to play in 2011-12, while three will have to sit out due to NCAA transfer rules.

The 2011-12 Schedule

- Utah will participate in the "Battle 4 Atlantis", a Thanksgiving tournament in the Bahamas, held at The Atlantis resort. The specific matchups have yet to be announced, but the field includes reigning NCAA champion UConn, Central Florida, College of Charleston, Florida State, Harvard, UMass and UNC Asheville.

- Fittingly, the Utes' will begin play in their new conference on New Year's Eve as they travel to face Colorado in Boulder. It will be the first game for both schools as members of the Pac-12. Utah's first Pac-12 home game will be Jan. 5 against Washington State.

- Utah's television schedule will be announced later this summer.

NOTES

Home Sweet Huntsman Center

- The Runnin' Utes are 526-124 (.809) all-time in their current home, the Jon M. Huntsman Center. Utah's 500th win in the 41-year old facility came on Dec. 6, 2008, as the Utes posted a 91-61 blowout of eventual Southeastern Conference champion LSU.
- Utah finished 9-6 at home last season. The Utes have posted a winning record at home in 38 consecutive seasons, since going 6-10 at the Huntsman Center in 1972-73.
- In conference home games over the last 17 years, Utah is 107-23 (.823). The Utes went 3-5 in conference home games last year.

Utes Among Elite In Regard to League Titles

- Utah and Kentucky are tied with 12 regular-season conference titles over the last 20 years. Only Kansas has won more league championships in that same span.
- All-time, Utah has won 29 regular-season conference titles, the fifth most in NCAA history. Kansas is first with 53 titles, followed by Kentucky (44), Western Kentucky (38) and North Carolina (35).
- In 12 years as a member of the Mountain West Conference, Utah won nearly half of the regular-season titles during that span. Upon joining the MWC in 1999, Utah won the title in each of the first two years of the league's existence. Those two championships extended a string of seven straight regular-season conference titles for the Utes. Utah won MWC championships in 2000 (10-4, shared with UNLV), 2000-01 (10-4, shared with BYU and Wyoming), 2003 (11-3, shared with BYU), 2005 (13-1, outright championship) and 2009 (12-4, shared with BYU and New Mexico).
