BOWL HISTORY

> Utah is 2-1 in Las Vegas Bowl games (see sidebar for complete bowl history).

> Utah has won 10 of its last 11 bowl games. Its only loss was to Boise State in the 2010 Las Vegas Bowl.

> Utah is playing in its 11th bowl game in the last 14 years.

> Kyle Whittingham is 7-1 in bowl games.

> From 1999-2009, Utah won nine-consecutive bowl games to tie for the second-longest bowl win streak in NCAA history.

> Utah went 2-0 in BCS bowl games, beating Pittsburgh in the 2005 Fiesta Bowl and Alabama in the 2009 Sugar Bowl.

INSIDE THE RANKINGS

> In the final regular-season rankings, Utah is No. 22 CFP, No. 23 A.P. and No. 25 Coaches.

> Utah has spent nine weeks in the A.P. Top 25.

> Utah appeared in all seven College Football Playoff rankings (No.17, 17, 23, 17, 25, 23, 22).

> Utah is 2-3 against ranked teams.

SACK LAKE CITY

> Utah leads the nation in total sacks (52) and sacks per game (4.33).

> Utah has been ranked No. 1 nationally in sacks for 10 straight weeks.

> Senior defensive end **Nate Orchard** leads the nation sacks per game (1.46) and is second in total sacks (17.5).

PAST LAS VEGAS BOWL HIGHLIGHTS

Utah earned the first bowl win for the new Mountain West Conference at the 1999 Las Vegas Bowl, edging Fresno State 17-15. Mike Anderson set a Las Vegas Bowl record that stands today with 254 rushing yards and scored both of Utah's touchdowns ... On Christmas day in 2001, Utah's defense sacked USC quarterback Carson Palmer five times and held the Trojans to 151 total yards and just one rushing yard in a 10-6 victory ... Ute highlights were few in a 26-3 loss to No. 10 Boise State in the 2010 Las Vegas Bowl. Utah forced and recovered a fumble on the Boise State 20-yard line on the game's first drive, but couldn't score.

Utah has four Las Vegas players on its roster: offensive tackle **Jeremiah Poutasi** (Desert Pines HS), running back **Bubba Poole** (Cimarron HS), linebacker **Marcus Sanders-Williams** (Durango HS) and defensive back **Casey Hughes** (Legacy Memorial HS). Poutasi is in his third year starting, Poole and Sanders-Williams are both in the two deep, and Hughes is redshirting in his first season at Utah. Hughes, Poole and Poutasi were all first-team all-state as preps.

UTES REAP NATIONAL HONORS

Junior punter **Tom Hackett** is the first Ray Guy Award winner in Utah and Pac-12 history. With several All-America teams still to be announced, **Hackett** and senior defensive end **Nate Orchard** have been named to five All-America teams (four first team, including the Walter Camp Foundation). **Orchard** won the Ted Hendricks Award as the nation's top defensive end who also demonstrates leadership and community contributions. Senior **Kaelin Clay** made the CBSSports.com (1st team) and Scout.com (2nd team) All-America teams. Freshman offensive lineman **Lowell Lotulelei** is a Scout.com second-team Freshman All-American. WHITTINGHAM FILE

Tenth-year Utah head coach **Kyle Whittingham**, the 2008 National Coach of the Year, has an 84-43 career record that includes seven bowl victories—among them a 2009 Sugar Bowl win over No. 4 Alabama. Whittingham was one of 13 coaches on the watch list for the 2014 Dodd Trophy and one of 20 semifinalists for the Maxwell Football Club Collegiate Coach of the Year Award. His teams have played in eight bowl games and the current team is awaiting its bowl destination. For more on Whittingham, see sidebar on page 2.

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

> 6'7" junior **Travis Wilson** has played in all 12 games with 10 starts and a 7-3 record. He has been the primary starter since the seventh game of his true freshman season, playing in 33 of 36 games with a 14-12 career record as the starter.

> **Wilson** is 173-for-287 (60.3%) passing for 2,012 yards and 17 touchdowns (4 INT).

> **Wilson** passed for a season-high 311 yards in the final regular season game vs. Colorado. It is his only 300-yard passing game this season and the third of his career.

> **Wilson's** 5,150 career passing yards ranks sixth in school history. He is 53 yards from tying for fifth place (5,203, Alex Smith, 2002-04).

> **Wilson** has 40 career touchdown passes—fifth all-time at Utah and seven away from tying for fourth (47 by Alex Smith, 2002-04).

> **Kendal Thompson** played in seven games with two starts (1-1) before a season-ending knee injury against Oregon on Nov. 8.

> **Thompson** finished his junior season 32-of-52 passing for 324 yards, two touchdowns and two interceptions in seven games played.

> **Thompson** also rushed 56 times yards for 192 yards (second on the team at the time of his injury) and one touchdown.

> Redshirt freshman **Conner Manning** made his only appearance as a Ute in the fourth quarter against Arizona, completing 2-of-6 pass attempts for 28 yards and an interception.

> Redshirt freshman **Brandon Cox** saw his only career action in game one against Idaho State, going 3-for-3 passing for 17 yards and rushing twice for 22 yards and a touchdown (16 yards).

> Junior **Adam Schulz** (pronounced Shultz), who has not played in a game this season, is another potential backup for Wilson.

> **Schulz**, a former walk-on, played in six games last season with three starts, passing for 1,008 yards and six touchdowns (5 INT). He also played in one game as a freshman.

RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

> In his first season at Utah, junior **Devontae Booker** was named first-team All-Pac-12 after averaging 130.1 yards in nine conference games.

> **Booker** averaged 112.5 yards per game overall, which ranks second in the Pac-12 and 21st in the nation.

> **Booker's** 1,350 net yards ranks fourth in school single-season history. He needs 46 yards to tie for third (1,396, Dameon Hunter, 2001).

> After playing sparingly in the first three non-conference games, when he had just 31 total rushes for 179 yards (59.7 ypg), **Booker** has rushed 235 times for 1,171 yards (130.1 ypg) in the last nine games.

> **Booker** leads the team in carries (266), net yards (1,350), yards per carry (5.10) and rushing touchdowns (9). He also leads the team in total touchdowns with 11 (2 receiving).

> **Booker** has six 100-yard games, which is tied for the fourth-most in a season in school history. His 100-yard games have come against Oregon State (229), Washington State (178), UCLA (156), Arizona State (146), Arizona (142) and USC (102).

> **Junior Salt** plays both guard positions and has appeared in 11 games with eight starts. The senior has played in 23 of 24 games in his two seasons at Utah with 20 starts.

> **Salt** has played 542 snaps and has three cuts.

> Others who have seen action on the line: **Hiva Lutui** (118 plays), **Nick Nowakowski** (74 plays, 1 cut), **Sam Tevi** (42 plays), **Marc Pouvave** (35 plays) and **Andrew Albers** (20 plays).

> Senior tight end **Westlee Tonga** has started all 12 games and is third on the team in receiving yards (382) and fourth in receptions (29). He is tied for the team lead in receiving touchdowns (4).

> **Tonga** had a career-high 77 receiving yards and a touchdown at Colorado.

> Sophomore tight end **Siale Fakailoatonga** has played in every game with two starts (3 career starts).

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

> First-team All-American and all-conference defensive end **Nate Orchard** leads the nation in sacks per game (1.46) and is second in total sacks (17.5). His 17.5 sacks is a school record.

> **Orchard's** 113 yards off sacks ranks second in a season at Utah and is one shy of the school record of 114 (Bronzell Miller, 1994).

> **Orchard**, who has played in all 49 games since his true freshman season with 36 starts, has 24 career sacks. It is the fourth-most in school history (he needs one to move into a tie for third). The school record is 27 (John Frank, 1996-99).

> **Orchard**, winner of the Ted Hendricks Award for defensive ends, is fourth in the nation in tackles for loss per game (1.7) and ranks fifth in total tackles for loss (20.0 for 118 yards). He is third in the league in both categories.

> **Orchard's** 20 TFL is tied for the third most in a season at Utah, while his 118 yards in tackles for loss ranks fourth.

> **Orchard's** 37.5 career tackles for loss and 201 yards of losses are both the fourth-highest totals all-time at Utah.

> **Orchard** is second on the team in tackles with 81. He had double-figure tackle games against UCLA (11), ASU (10) and Stanford (10).

> **Orchard** is tied for ninth in the Pac-12 in forced fumbles (2). He has seven career forced fumbles, which is tied for third-most all-time at Utah.

> **Orchard** also has five career fumble recoveries (1 this season), which is tied for fifth most in school history.

> **Orchard** is a two-time Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week (vs. UCLA and Stanford). Against UCLA, he was also named the FWAA/Bronko Nagurski National Defensive Player of the Week, Chuck Bednarik Award Player of the Week and CFPA Defensive Lineman of the Week.

> Honorable mention All-Pac-12 left end **Hunter Dimick** is 12th in sacks per game (0.91) and is tied for 13th in total sacks (10.0, tie). He is fourth in the Pac-12 in sacks per game and tied for fifth in total sacks.

> **Dimick's** 10.0 sacks ties him for the seventh-most in a season at Utah.

> **Dimick** is fifth in the Pac-12 (second on the team) in total tackles for loss (14.5) and is fifth in TFL per game (1.32).

> **Dimick** tied his career tackle high of eight twice this season (Arizona State, Oregon State).

> **Dimick** is tied for ninth in the Pac-12 in forced fumbles (2). The sophomore has three career forced fumbles.

> **Dimick** has 52 total tackles and two pass breakups in 11 games. He missed the Colorado game with an injury.

> Junior **Jason Fanaika** is in the two deep at left end, although he has

> True freshman **Lowell Lotulelei**, a second-team Scout.com Freshman All-American and an honorable mention All-Pac-12 pick, has played in all 12 games, starting at nose tackle in the last eight. He has 30 tackles (4.5 TFL, 4.0 sacks) and a forced fumble.

> Senior tackle **Sese Ianu** has played in all 12 games with seven starts. He has 28 tackles, a sack and a pass breakup.

> Others who have played on the defensive line are junior **Viliseni Fauonuku** (2 starts, 22 tackles, 5.5 TFL, 2.0 sacks, 1 pass breakup), redshirt freshman **Filipo Mokofisi** (2 starts, 17 tackles, 3.0 TFL, 1.5 sack), junior **Clint Shepard** (3 starts, 15 tackles, 4.0 TFL, 1.0 sack), sophomore **Pita Taumoepenu**, (14 tackles, 4.5 sacks), sophomore **Stevie Tu'ikolovatu** (7 tackles, 1.0 TFL), senior **Greg Reese** (2 tackles) and sophomore **Hayden Clegg** (1 start).

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

> Honorable mention all-conference junior **Jared Norris** leads the Utes and ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in total tackles (108) and tackles per game (9.0).

> **Norris** is tied for 10th in the Pac-12 in tackles for loss (13.0) and ranks 11th in TFL per game (1.08). He has 4.0 sacks.

> **Norris** has five double-digit tackle games this season (13 vs. Oregon State, 12 vs. Washington State, 11 vs. Oregon, 11 vs. Arizona, 10 vs. UCLA) and seven in his career.

> Junior **Jason Fanaika**, who also plays end, has started in seven games, including five starts at linebacker.

> **Fanaika** has 54 total tackles (4.0 sacks, 8.5 TFL), an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

> **Fanaika** led Utah with eight tackles and 3.0 TFL against Colorado. His season high is 10 tackles (vs. Oregon State).

> Junior **Jason Whittingham** (17 tackles, 1.0 TFL) has played in the last two games (4 games total) after missing eight games with injury.

> Senior **Jacoby Hale** has played in six games and has seven tackles (1.0 TFL).

> Utah has lost junior starter **Gionni Paul** for the season to a foot injury, which also kept him out of the first two games of the season.

> **Paul** played in eight games and had 61 tackles (3.0 TFL, 1.0 sack), four interceptions (most on the team), a pass breakup and a fumble recovery.

> **Paul** had a career-high 14 tackles against both Michigan and Oregon State.

> In his first game as a Ute against Michigan, **Paul** was named the *Athlon Sports* National Defensive Player of the Week and the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week after leading Utah with 14 tackles, an interception and a fumble recovery in a 26-10 win.

CORNERBACK NOTEBOOK

> Senior **Eric Rowe**, a two-time honorable mention All-Pac-12 selection, has played in 46 games (starting 45) since his true freshman season when he was a Freshman All-American. He played safety his first three seasons before moving to corner this year.

> **Rowe** leads Utah in pass breakups (12) and is third in the Pac-12 in passes defended per game (1.18). He is tied for fourth in the conference in total passes defended with 13 (12 PBU, 1 INT).

> **Rowe's** 12 pass breakups is tied for fourth-most in a season at Utah.

> **Rowe** has 33 career pass breakups, which is third all-time at Utah.

> **Rowe** has 57 tackles (3.0 TFL) in 11 games played (missed Oregon with an injury). He also has a fumble recovery and blocked a kick on special teams.

> **Dominique Hatfield**, who began the season as a receiver, has started all but two games at corner and has 35 tackles (1.5 TFL), nine pass breakups (second on the team) and an interception.

2014 UTAH BOWL NOTES

- > **Hatfield** scored what proved to be the winning touchdown against Colorado after returning his first career interception 20 yards for a score.
- > **Davion Orphey** has played in all 12 games with four starts. He has 22 tackles, 1.5 TFL, five pass breakups and two fumble recoveries.
- > **Orphey** is tied for third in the Pac-12 in fumble recoveries (2) and is tied for fourth in fumbles recovered per game (0.17). He scored on a 53-yard touchdown on a recovered fumble against USC.
- > **Justin Thomas** has played in 11 games with eight starts.
- > **Thomas** has 35 tackles (3.0 TFL, 1.0 sack) and seven pass breakups. He recovered a fumble against Arizona.

SAFETY NOTEBOOK

- > Three-time honorable mention All-Pac-12 senior safety **Brian Blechen** has played and started in 47 games since his true freshman season, when he was Freshman All-American.
- > **Blechen** has six pass breakups, an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.
- > **Blechen** has seven career forced fumbles, which is tied for the third-most all-time at Utah.
- > **Blechen** has nine career interceptions (1 this season), including two game-saving picks.
- > **Blechen** has 57 total tackles. He had a season-high 10 tackles against Washington State—his third career double-digit tackle game.
- > True freshman **Marcus Williams** has played in all 12 games with five starts. He has 54 tackles (1.0 TFL), an interception and two forced fumbles (tied for ninth in the Pac-12).
- > Utah will apply for a medical hardship season for senior **Tevin Carter**. Carter played in four of Utah's first five games and had emerged as one of the best free safeties in the conference prior to his injury.
- > **Carter** finished his first season at Utah with two interceptions (one for a touchdown against UCLA), 16 tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss and a pass breakup.

PUNTING NOTEBOOK

- > Ray Guy Award winner, first-team All-American and two-time first-team All-Pac-12 punter **Tom Hackett** leads the nation in punts inside the 20 (35) and 10-yard lines (19).
- > **Hackett's** 47.0 punt average ranks second nationally and first in the Pac-12. He has 77 punts for 3,619 yards.
- > **Hackett** has landed 35-of-77 (45.5%) punts inside the 20 this season (a percentage that leads the Pac-12) and has 77-of-178 (43.3%) punts inside the 20 for his career.
- > **Hackett** has 19 punts inside the 10-yard line this season (37 in his career) and six inside the 5-yard line (16 in his career).
- > **Hackett** has 25 punts of 50+ yards this season, which is second in the Pac-12 and is second all-time at Utah.
- > Against the Pac-12's No. 2 and 4 punt returners, **Hackett's** punting held USC's Nelson Agholor (10.6 average) without a return (USC had 1 return for 2 yards) and UCLA's Ishmael Adams (9.7 average) to one return for one yard. Stanford's Ty Montgomery (19.8 average, two touchdowns) was held without a return.
- > **Hackett** is second in the Pac-12 in punts of 50+ yards (25) this season (second-most in a season at Utah) and has 45 in his

career to rank fourth all-time at Utah.

- > **Hackett's** 3,619 punt yards is a school record, breaking the record he set last season (3,300).
- > **Hackett** has had just 17 touchbacks in his three-year career (10 this season).
- > **Hackett** has 178 career punts, which is the fifth-most all-time at Utah.
- > **Hackett's** 7,891 career punt yards ranks fifth all-time at Utah.
- > **Hackett** was named the Ray Guy Award Player of the Week three times this season (vs. Fresno State, UCLA and Stanford) and was the Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week vs. Colorado. He was the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) National Punter of the Week vs. UCLA.
- > **Hackett** is 2-for-2 this season on fake punts for first downs (Idaho State, Colorado).

KICKING NOTEBOOK

- > First-team All-Pac-12 placekicker and two-time Lou Groza semifinalist "Automatic" **Andy Phillips** is a former U.S. Ski Team member (2007-11) who had never played in a football game at any level prior to last season.
- > **Phillips** ranks second in the nation in field goals of 40+ yards with 12 (12-of-15), with makes of 41, 43 (twice), 44, 45, 46 (twice), 47, 48 (twice) and 50 yards (twice).
- > **Phillips** leads the Pac-12 in field goals per game (1.83), which is tied for fifth in the nation.
- > **Phillips** is 2-of-2 in 50-yard field goals this season (Michigan, Arizona State) and 3-of-3 in his career, with a long of 51 yards against Arizona State in 2013.
- > **Phillips** is 22-of-26 (84.6%) overall in field goal attempts. His 22 field goals leads the Pac-12 and is tied for fifth in the nation. He is tied for 11th in the nation and is second in the conference in field goal percentage.
- > **Phillips' 22** field goals ties the school single-season record with Louie Sakoda (2008).
- > **Phillips** has connected on 39-of-46 field goals in his career (84.8%). His 39 total field goals is third all-time at Utah while 46 attempts is fourth-most all-time.
- > In his career, **Phillips** is 21-of-26 (80.7%) from 40+ yards.
- > **Phillips** is second in the Pac-12 in scoring (8.7 points per game).
- > **Phillips** has made at least three field goals in four games this season (Michigan, UCLA, Oregon State, Arizona State).
- > **Phillips** made 12 consecutive field goals during one stretch of the season before his streak was snapped on his fourth kick against ASU. It tied the third-longest made field goal streak in school history.
- > **Phillips** is 38-of-39 in PATs this season and 79-of-80 in his career. He missed the first PAT of his career against Colorado after 78-straight makes.
- > **Phillips** was a two-time Lou Groza Star of the Week (vs. Michigan, UCLA) and a two-time Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week (Michigan and Oregon State).
- > **Phillips** is 3-for-3 in successful onside kicks in his career.
- > **Phillips** has 38 touchbacks on 67 kickoffs and a 62.1-yard average.
- > Utah has 39 touchbacks on 69 total kickoffs.

2014 UTAH BOWL NOTES

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTEBOOK

> Head coach **Kyle Whittingham** is in his first season as the special teams' coordinator and his unit captured three of the four first-team specialist awards on the 2014 All-Pac-12 Conference team: punter **Tom Hackett**, kicker **Andy Phillips** and return specialist **Kaelin Clay**.

> Utah ranks third in the nation and leads the Pac-12 in net punting (42.81).

> The Utes lead the Pac-12 (10th nationally) in kick return average (24.48) and are sixth nationally and second in the Pac-12 in punt return average (15.15).

> In his first season, first-team All-American and All-Pac-12 senior returner **Clay** leads the Pac-12 and ranks fourth in the nation in punt return average (16.9). He has 21 punt returns for 354 yards and three touchdowns.

> **Clay** is one of two players in the country this season with three punt returns for touchdowns and four total returns (1 kick-off) for a touchdown.

> Three of **Clay's** 21 punt returns this year have gone for touchdowns (66 yards vs. Michigan, 46 yards vs. Idaho State and 58 yards vs. Washington State). One of his 21 kickoff returns was also for a touchdown (100 yards vs. Idaho State).

> **Clay's** three punt return touchdowns ties the Utah single-season record set by Steve Smith (currently of the NFL's Baltimore Ravens) in 1999.

> **Clay's** 354 yards in punt returns ranks seventh in a season at Utah.

> **Clay** also ranks third in the Pac-12 in kickoff return average (25.4). He has 21 kick returns for 534 yards and one touchdown.

> **Clay** had seven kick returns for 179 yards against Oregon. His 179 yards in kick returns is the fifth-most ever in a game by a Ute and his seven returns is tied for the third-most all-time in a game.

> **Clay's** school-record 331 all-purpose yards against Oregon is the sixth-most in a game by an FBS player this season (179 kick return, 152 receiving).

> **Clay** was named the Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week the first week of the season against Idaho State after returning a punt (46 yards) and kickoff (100 yards) for touchdowns. > **Clay's** punt return for a touchdown against ISU came on his first touch as a Ute.

> Sophomore **Chase Dominguez** has handled all of the special teams' snaps since last fall, which includes 153 punt, 46 field goal and 80 PATs for a total of 279 snaps.

UTAH VS. THE PAC-12

Utah is 90-142-6 all-time against Pac-12 schools and 14-22 as a member of the conference. Here's the breakdown: Arizona (20-18-2), Arizona State (6-20), California (4-5), Colorado (27-31-3), Oregon (8-20), Oregon State (7-11-1), USC (4-9), Stanford (4-3), UCLA (3-10), Washington (0-8), Washington State (7-7).

CAPACITY CROWDS

Utah broke the school record for season attendance this fall, averaging 46,436 fans a game. All six home games exceeded Rice-Eccles Stadium's seating capacity of 45,807. Utah has played to 31 straight sellouts in Rice-Eccles Stadium extending back to the 2010 season-opener against Pittsburgh. Of the sellouts, 28 were played before standing-room only crowds that

exceeded Rice-Eccles Stadium's seating capacity (45,017 from 1998-13; 45,807 starting this season). The largest home crowd in school history (47,619) saw Utah beat No. 20 USC on Oct. 25, 2014.

COACHES' CORNER

Three members of Utah's staff have been head coaches at the NCAA level: head coach **Kyle Whittingham**, offensive coordinator **Dave Christensen** (Wyoming) and running backs coach **Dennis Erickson** (Idaho, Wyoming, Washington State, Miami, Oregon State and Arizona State). All three have been recognized as a conference coach of the year: **Whittingham** (Utah/Mountain West), **Christensen** (Wyoming/Mountain West) and **Erickson** (Washington State, Oregon State, Arizona State/Pac-12; Miami/Big East; and Idaho/Big Sky). **Whittingham** (2008/Utah) and **Erickson** (2000/Miami) were National Coach of the Year recipients.

Viliseni Fauonuku was the first member of his family to graduate from high school ... **Jared Norris** attended a pro skateboarding camp (Camp Woodward) in high school, and at 6'1", 230 pounds, was the biggest skateboarder ever to attend ... **Eric Rowe** lived in six cities in four states growing up ... Walk-on wide receiver **Ryan Petersen** was "discovered" after being named the MVP of the 2013 and 2014 MUSS flag football games, held annually before the Red-White spring game. A club/intramural baseball, basketball and volleyball star, Petersen has also played for the men's practice squad at Utah women's basketball practices ... **Andy Phillips**, a former five-year member of the U.S. Ski Team (2007-11), had never played in a football game at any level prior to walking on at Utah ... **Junior Salt** played a role in the rugby-themed movie *Forever Strong* ... **Kendal Thompson** is a member of the Kiowa Tribe of Oklahoma (his mother is one half Kiowa) ... **Travis Wilson** is one quarter Japanese (his paternal grandmother).
