

# **Utah vs. USC**

**Notes Update**

**Jan. 28, 2012**

## **Last Time Out**

A late surge by UCLA led to a heartbreaking loss for the Utah women's basketball team, 65-60 on Thursday evening.

With the Utes leading by nine, 55-46 with 5:30 remaining, the Bruins closed out the game with a 19-5 run to take the win. Utah struggled with UCLA's defensive press in the final minutes, making just one field goal and turning the ball over six times.

Four players scored in double figures for the Utes, led by 14 points from Taryn Wicijowski. Rachel Messer scored a career-high 13 points while Janita Badon and Iwalani Rodrigues each had 10 points. Michelle Plouffe had a team-high 12 rebounds.

The Utes fall to 2-6 in the Pac-12 and 9-10 overall.

## **USC Update**

Late free throws by Colorado lifted the Buffs to a 69-67 win over USC on Thursday evening.

USC and Colorado traded the lead 14 times and saw the score lock up even 11 times. USC took a 67-65 lead with 45 seconds to go on a jumper only to have Colorado answer for a 67-67 tie with 30 seconds left. On USC's last possession a jump ball went to Colorado with nine seconds left. On the other end, Colorado's Chucky Jeffery was fouled with 1.2 seconds left. She hit both free throws to give Colorado the win.

USC goes to 10-8 overall and 5-3 in Pac-12 play with the loss.

## **News and Notes**

- The Utes rank second in the Pac-12 in scoring defense (54.2) and free-throw percentage (.715).
- Utah's losses have come by an average of 8.1 points. Eight of Utah's 10 losses have been by single digits.
- Rachel Messer (13) and Rachel Morris (5) each had career highs in scoring against UCLA.
- Michelle Plouffe, who had a team-high 12 rebounds against UCLA, continues to lead the Utes in both scoring (14.1) and rebounding (8.5). She is ninth in the Pac-12 in scoring and fifth in rebounding. She is third in the Pac-12 in three-point field goal percentage (.397) and defensive rebounds (6.4).
- Taryn Wicijowski ranks sixth in the Pac-12 in rebounding (8.3).
- Janita Badon continues to lead the conference in assists (5.7). She had nine against UCLA. Badon ranks fourth in the conference in assist/turnover ratio (1.6).
- Utah will hold their annual Power of Pink game on Saturday against USC. Fans who wear pink will receive free admission. The team will hold a 'Pink Walk' before the game, starting at the Huntsman Cancer Institute and walking to the Huntsman Center. Fans who attend will receive pink giveaway items and admission to a pregame reception, in addition to free game admission.
- Jean's Golden Girls will be performing at halftime.

The Utah women's basketball team returns home this weekend to face UCLA and USC.

The Utes continue to be one of the top defensive teams in the country, ranking 27th in the NCAA in scoring defense (53.6).

"I am really happy with our team's progress," Utah head coach Anthony Levretts said. "Our goal is always to get better every week, and we feel like we are getting better. It is a really critical time as we move forward, that we don't stay where we are and we continue to improve in every facet of our game."

Saturday against USC is Utah's 'Power of Pink' game, with the team wearing pink uniforms for the contest. Fans who wear pink receive free admission. The team will hold a 'Pink Walk' before the game, starting at the Huntsman Cancer Institute and walking to the Huntsman Center. Fans who attend will receive pink giveaway items and admission to a pregame reception, in addition to free game admission.

"We believe this is our opportunity to bring some awareness to this horrible disease," Levretts said. "Every cent that goes to cancer research is incredibly important."

## Scouting UCLA

UCLA is 8-10 overall and 3-4 in the Pac-12. The Bruins split a pair of games last weekend, defeating Oregon State before falling to Oregon. Rebekah Gardner ranks third in the Pac-12 in scoring with 15.6 points per game.

Utah leads the all-time series against UCLA, 3-2. The two teams last played in 2009 at an early-season tournament in San Diego.

## Scouting USC

USC is third in the Pac-12 with a 5-2 conference record, and 10-7 overall. The Trojans had won five conference games in a row before falling in overtime to Oregon State in their last game.

Three players are averaging in double figures for the Trojans, led by 12.6 points per game from Ashley Corral. She leads the Pac-12 in three pointers made.

USC leads the all-time series against Utah with a 5-3 advantage, but the Utes have won two of the last three. The two teams played three times from 2006 to 2008.

## Recapping Last Week

The Utes split a pair of games during their weekend on the road, defeating Arizona in overtime, 65-60, before falling to Arizona State, 59-51.

Against Arizona, Rachel Messer hit a pair of three-pointers in the final minute to help push the game into overtime. Utah outscored the Wildcats 11-6 in the extra stanza, led by eight points from Janita Badon.

Down 22-19 at halftime, an 8-2 second-half run by Arizona State put the Sun Devils up by 10 points, 30-20. The Utes would end up fighting to cut into that early lead throughout the second half. Utah cut it to four several times but could not come any closer.

## News and Notes

- Seven of Utah's nine losses have come by less than 10 points. The Utes losses are by an average of 8.4 points.
- Utah ranks 18th nationally in turnovers per game (14.2).
- The Utes rank 27th in the NCAA in scoring defense (53.6), ranking second in the conference in the category.
- Utah ranks second in the Pac-12 in free-throw percentage (.720).
- Utah's 58.9 shooting percentage (33-56) against Weber State is the best in a game in the Pac-12 this year.
- Utah allowed just 31 points to Idaho State, which is the least points a Pac-12 school has held their opponent to this year.
- Utah's wins have been by an average of 21.6 points.
- Both of Utah's Pac-12 wins have come in overtime, against Washington and Arizona.
- The Utes held Stanford to just 62 points, just the third time this season they have been held under 65 points, and 19 points below their scoring average coming into the game (81.4).

## Guard Notes

- **Janita Badon** leads the Pac-12 in assists (5.5) while ranking fifth in assist/turnover ratio (1.6).
- **Badon**, the team's lone senior, is averaging 10.7 points and 5.9 rebounds per game.
- **Badon** became the 22nd 1,000-point scorer in Utah history against Washington, when she scored 16 points including the game-tying three-pointer with six seconds remaining to push the game to overtime.
- **Badon** reached 500 career assists against Washington State. She ranks third all-time at Utah with 534 career assists.
- **Badon** had a season-high 10 assists against California, which also tied her career high.
- **Badon** is tied for third all-time at Utah in steals (225).
- **Badon** has a season-high 22 points against Arizona, including eight points in overtime to lead the Utes to the win.
- **Badon** has two double-doubles this year (Michigan, Detroit).
- Junior **Iwalani Rodrigues** is averaging 10.9 points per game. She ranks third in the Pac-12 in three-pointers per game (2.1).
- **Rodrigues** scored a season-high 26 points against Utah Valley, and has been in double-figure scoring in eight games.

- **Rodrigues** had a career-high eight rebounds against Arizona State.
- **Rodrigues** made six three-pointers against Utah Valley, which is tied for the second-most in the Pac-12 in a game this year.
- **Rodrigues** ranks ninth all-time at Utah in three-pointers made (153) and is eighth in three-pointers attempted (398).
- **Rodrigues** is second in the Pac-12 in minutes played (36.0).
- Junior **Rachel Messer** has started 17 of Utah's 18 games. She averages 30.7 minutes per game with 5.0 points per game.
- **Messer** hit a pair of three's against Arizona in the final minutes to help push the game into overtime.
- **Messer** had a season-high 11 points against Detroit and New Mexico State.
- **Messer** has an .895 free-throw percentage (17-of-19).
- **Messer** had a career-high six assists against Texas Southern.
- Freshman **Cheyenne Wilson** has played in 15 games, making her first career start in the season opener against SUU. She averages 14.7 minutes per game.
- **Wilson** had her best game against Weber State, scoring 12 points on 5-of-5 shooting (2-of-2 from three) with four rebounds.
- Sophomore **Allison Gida** has played in eight games this season. She had four points against Texas Southern and three points against New Mexico State.
- Junior **Rita Sitivi** was pulled out of a planned redshirt year against Washington State. She has played in every game since then (six total games).
- **Sitivi** had two rebounds against both Washington and California. She had two assists against Arizona State.
- **Sitivi** has played in 18 games over her career.

## Forward Notes

- Sophomore **Michelle Plouffe** ranks eighth in the Pac-12 in scoring (14.6), sixth in rebounding (8.3), while ranking fourth in defensive rebounds (6.1).
- **Plouffe** ranks third in the conference in three-point field goal percentage (.403) while ranking eighth in three-point field goals made (1.6).
- **Plouffe** has seven double-doubles this season (tying her for third in the Pac-12) and 16 career double-doubles.
- **Plouffe** has scored in double figures in all but three games this year.
- **Plouffe** had a season-high 24 points against New Mexico State.
- **Plouffe** tied her career-high with 14 rebounds against Arkansas.
- **Taryn Wicijowski** is fifth in the Pac-12 in rebounding (8.4) and is averaging 12.2 points per game. She is fifth in defensive rebounds (5.9).
- **Wicijowski** ranks ninth in the conference in field-goal percentage (.516).
- **Wicijowski** ranks seventh in the conference in blocked shots (1.6). She has 28 blocks.
- **Wicijowski** has scored in double figures in all but four games this season with a season-high 20 points against Southern Utah and Weber State.

- **Wicijowski** had a season-high 13 rebounds against Arizona.
- **Wicijowski** has five double-doubles this season. She has 11 career double-doubles.

- **Diana Rolniak** has started two games this season and made appearances in 13 games. She is averaging 14.2 minutes per game and has nine blocks with 2.5 rebounds per game.
- **Rolniak** suffered an ankle sprain against Washington State and has not played since.
- **Rolniak** had a season-high nine rebounds against Texas Southern.
- **Chelsea Bridgewater** has played in 16 games this year, averaging 9.1 minutes per game.
- **Bridgewater** had a career-high six rebounds against Southern Utah. She scored six points against Texas Southern and New Mexico State.
- Freshman **Rachel Morris** has played in 13 games this season. She is averaging 6.5 minutes per game, including a season-high 14 minutes against Cal.

### Injury Report

Sophomores **Brittany Knighton** and **Ciera Dunbar** are indefinitely out with knee injuries. Knighton played in 29 games last season with six starts, while Dunbar saw action in 28 games.

### Utah Picked Sixth in Pac-12

#### Coaches Poll

Utah was been picked to finish sixth in the Pac-12 Preseason Women's Basketball Coaches Poll. Stanford was picked as the preseason favorite for the 11th year in a row, garnering 11 first-place votes and 121 maximum points. USC was selected second with 111 points after advancing to the WNIT Championship game last season, followed by California in third with 98 points, UCLA (83 points) and Arizona State (68 points). The Utes, who won the Mountain West Conference Tournament last year, garnered 61 points to stand sixth.

Washington State came away 7th with 59 points, followed by Oregon, Arizona, Washington, Colorado and Oregon State.

### The Sign of Four

Utah has signed four student-athletes to national letters of intent: Ariel Reynolds (Portland, Ore.), Danielle Rodriguez (Downey, Calif.), Nakia Arquette (Spokane, Wash.) and Paige Crozon (Humboldt, Saskatchewan). The four will join Utah for the 2012-13 campaign.

Led by a double-double from Michelle Plouffe and 20 points from Taryn Wicijowski, the Utah women's basketball team made a second half rally to defeat Southern Utah, 74-60 in their season opener on Sunday evening.

Southern Utah took a 30-28 lead into halftime and the score continued to go back and forth through the second half. Utah held a one-point lead with 11 minutes remaining, 40-39 before they began to take control with a 12-2 run that started with a steal by Janita Badon and subsequent three-pointer from Chelsea Bridgewater. Wicijowski had five points of the run, including a three-point play when she was fouled on a shot, while Iwalani Rodrigues also hit a three-pointer in the run for a 52-41 lead.
