

HEAD COACH-1ST SEASON AMY HOGUE

After leading the University of Utah softball team to new heights as a player, Amy Hogue now leads the *Utes* as the program's fifth Head Coach. Coach Hogue played for the *Utes* from 1991-94 and earned second team All-American honors as a senior. She led both the 1991 and 1994 squads to the College World Series. Amy was WAC Player of the Year, first team all-region, second team All-American, and the team MVP in 1994.

Hogue built and mentored Salt Lake Community College's softball team from 1999-2004, with a 197-82 (.706) record. At SLCC, Coach Hogue coached 36 all-region players and nine All-Americans. She was named SWAC Coach of the Year in 2003.

Amy got her start in coaching as Utah's graduate assistant at Utah from 1994-95. She was an Assistant Coach at Alta High from 1994-96 and joined the *Utes'* coaching staff as an assistant from 1996-99.

Adrian Gregory – 1st Season

Assistant Coach

Adrian comes to Utah from the New England Riptide of the National Pro Fastpitch League. She coached for one year with the Riptide after playing for two years with the Texas Thunder, where she started as shortstop. Adrian was drafted by the team in 2005.

Gregory began her coaching career as a student assistant at Texas A&M in 2006. The Aggies went 34-19 that year, reaching the NCAA Regionals.

Adrian was a four-year starter for Texas A&M, playing shortstop, second base, and outfield. As a senior, she led the Aggies to a Big 12 regular season title and an NCAA Super Regional appearance. Gregory coached and played at Texas A&M under former Utah head coach Jo Evans.

Tracee Withers – 1st Season

Assistant Coach

Tracee joins the *Utes'* coaching staff, having recently completed a playing career at BYU. She started at second base from 2006-07. As a Junior, Withers led the team with 121 fielding assists. She was named Academic All MWC.

Tracee played at Salt Lake Community College from 2003-05, competing for Coach Hogue her freshman year. She was a second-team NJCAA All American in 2005 and a two-time All Region 18 selection. Tracee led the team in home runs her second year at SLCC.

Cody Thomson, Volunteer Asst.

USA Softball Men's National Team pitcher, Cody has worked with the Utah softball team on numerous occasions. He brings a wealth of experience to the staff and works primarily with the pitchers.

Cody began his coaching career at his Alma Mater, Copper Hills High School, in 1996. He also served as an assistant at Southern Utah University in 1998.

Instruction & Supervision

Quality instruction in fundamentals of all areas of softball conducted daily, as well as games/competition after the dinner break. Utah Softball Coaches, current *Utes*, and guest coaches will work with camp participants. Campers are under constant supervision by coaches and staff.

Equipment/Dress

Campers should wear their own practice gear or other protective clothing and appropriate field shoes. Bring gloves, helmets, and hats, catching equipment, bats, water bottles, and suntan protection. Water will be available on the field.

❖ **Pitchers MUST** bring their own catcher. Catching gear required for catchers 18 years of age or younger.

❖ **Catchers MUST** bring their own protective catching gear, including protective facemask, helmet, chest protector, and shin guards.

❖ **Hitters MUST** bring their own bats and helmets. Batting gloves are optional.

❖ **Bring water bottles.** Water will be available on site.

PLEASE NOTE: above equipment **WILL NOT** be provided for Campers. If Campers are not properly equipped, they will not be allowed to participate.

Insurance

Camp insurance covers camp-related activities only and is **secondary** to personal insurance. Reasonable hospital and medical expenses resulting from injuries at camp (not paid by Camper's own insurance) will be covered by camp insurance. Expenses resulting from illness are the responsibility of the Camper's parents or guardians. All claims must be reported within 60 days of occurrence.

Transportation

No transportation provided to/from camp.

Refunds

The \$50.00 non-refundable service fee is non-transferable. Full refunds will be given only to those whose application(s) are received after camp is filled or in case of illness/injury to Camper prior to beginning of camp. **NO refunds given after camp begins.**

Agreement to Assumption of Risk, Release of Liability and Consent to Medical Treatment

As a condition of my/my child's participation in the 2008 Utah Softball Camp (hereinafter *USC*), and in consideration for the privileges that come from participation in the *USC* including instruction, use of facilities and equipment and other services provided by the *USC*, I hereby agree for myself and/or for my minor child as follows:

- I recognize and understand the *USC* is a coach's camp offered and operated by *USC*. The *USC* is NOT a University of Utah sponsored activity and the University of Utah does not have any responsibility for the operation of the camp.
- I recognize that the *USC* will involve various activities that may include, but are not limited to, instruction, conditioning, practices, games, meals, lodging, and travel to and from the *USC* (hereinafter *Camp Activities*).
- I recognize that there are certain risks of harm to me and/or my child and others associated with participation in the *USC* and *Camp Activities*, that there are dangers that cannot be fully foreseen, that there are risks and dangers that the *USC* and its agents and employees cannot control, and that such risks and dangers could result in bodily injury or death to me/my child and/or to others.
- I understand that some of the dangers and inherent risks to me/to my child in playing or practicing to play in any sport include, but are not limited to, death, serious neck and spinal injuries which may result in complete or partial paralysis, brain damage, serious injury related to the eye and/or head, serious injury to virtually all internal organs, serious injury to all bones, joints, ligaments, muscles, tendons, and other parts of the muscular/skeletal system, and serious injury or impairment to other aspects of my/my child's body and general health and well-being. I further understand that there are risks associated with travel and that I/my child could incur some or all of these injuries during travel to and from the *USC*.

IN SIGNING THIS RELEASE, I ACKNOWLEDGE AND REPRESENT THAT I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THE FOREGOING, THAT I UNDERSTAND IT, AND THAT I SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY AS MY OWN FREE ACT AND DEED. NO ONE HAS MADE ANY ORAL REPRESENTATION, STATEMENTS, OR INDUCEMENTS IN ORDER TO GET ME TO SIGN THIS DOCUMENT. I HAVE HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO CONSULT WITH MY OWN LEGAL COUNSEL BEFORE SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT.

I AM SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT FOR MYSELF AS PARTICIPANT. I represent and acknowledge that I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and that I understand the terms of this Agreement. I also acknowledge that this Agreement shall bind my heirs and personal representatives.

- I agree that if any injury or emergency should occur during *Camp Activities* with respect to myself/my child, the *USC* staff is authorized to take whatever steps are reasonably necessary in their judgment to attend to my/my child's medical needs. I agree to be responsible for any hospital expenses, doctor bills, or other expenses that may be incurred to attend to my/my child's medical needs.
- I represent that I have/my child has adequate health insurance to cover the costs of treatment in the event of any injury that I incur/my child incurs during participation in the *USC*.
- I agree to assume all risks and responsibility for any and all claims for damages, including personal injury or death, medical expenses, disability, lost wages, loss of earning capacity, and property damages which may be incurred by me/my child while engaged in *Camp Activities*.
- I agree to assume all risks and responsibility for any and all claims for damages, including personal injury or death, medical expenses, disability, lost wages, loss of earning capacity, and property damages which may be made by others and that result in part from my/my child's participation in *Camp Activities*.
- I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the University of Utah, Utah Softball Camp, and their agents and employees from any loss liability, damages or costs, including court costs and attorney fees, that they may incur due to my participation in the *USC*, whether caused by my/my child's negligence, the negligence of others and/or by the negligence of the University of Utah and/or *USC* (excluding the sole negligence of the University of Utah and/or *USC*).
