### THE OPENING ACT

#### UTEP To Conclude First Half Of League Play Vs. UCF

UTEP will wrap up the first half of its 16-game Conference USA slate when it plays host to UCF at 2:05 p.m. MST Sunday. The Miners (18-2, 7-0 C-USA) have peeled off eight wins in a row, including a 70-63 victory against Southern Miss. The Knights (9-10, 4-3 C-USA play) had ran off three straight league wins before being edged out by SMU, 60-48, last time out on Jan. 26. The game will be streamed on Miner TV (subscription required), and fans can also get live updates through Twitter (@UTEPWBB).

### Honor Thy Coach

**Head coach Keitha Adams** will be recognized for notching her 300th career win in a pre-game presentation. She reached the milestone after the Miners vanquished Southern Miss, 70-63, on the road on Jan. 26. Adams is one of five active coaches in C-USA to have reached the figure.

### Best Fan Support In C-USA

UTEP leads C-USA in attendance with 1,598 fans on average, including 2,754 per game since the onset of league play. Helping that figure has been eclipsing 2,000 fans in four of the past five contests and six times overall in 2011-12.

### Miners Receive Vote In Both Top-25 Polls

For the first time this season, UTEP picked up a vote in the top-25 of both the AP & ESPN/USA Coaches polls in the same week. The Miners had previously secured a pair of votes in the coaches poll on Dec. 19, 2011, which marked the earliest point in any season that they drew national attention.

## WHAT'S IN A NAME?

When referring to the University of Texas at El Paso and its intercollegiate athletics program please use the acronym "UTEP" or the "University of Texas at El Paso".

Please refrain from using "UT-El Paso", "Texas-El Paso", or "University of Texas-El Paso".

The nickname is the "MINERS" not the "Lady Miners."

### Off & Running In League Play

The Miners are off to a 7-0 start in league play for the second time in program history. The 2007-08 squad got off to a quick start in conference and never looked back en route to becoming the first women's school in Conference USA history to run the gauntlet to finish 16-0.

### Getting It Done On The Road

The Miners have surged to a school-record 7-1 start on the road, topping the prior standard at this juncture (6-2 in 2007-08). Overall, the seven road wins rank tied as the second most in a single season in program history (1980-81 & 1992-93). The season standard for top mark in hostile territory is 10-3 (2007-08).

### Flying High At Home

UTEP stands at 11-1 at home, which rates tied as the second-best mark at the point in program history. The 1988-89 squad did so (finished 12-1), as did the 2006-07 team (finished 16-2). The only undefeated home mark in program history was in the 2007-08 campaign (14-0).

### Not To Mention Overall

With a record of 18-2, the Miners have equaled their best record through 19 games in school history (2007-08). That 2007-08 squad climbed to 27-2 before suffering its third loss of the season & finished at a program-best 28-4.

### It's A Streak Thing

The Miners have two separate winning streaks of at least five games this year (10 & 8) to become the second team in program history to achieve the feat. The 1992-93 squad also did, but it used short surges (7 & 5 contests)

### Pretty Select Company

UTEP is one of 10 teams nationally to be both undefeated in league play & have two or fewer total losses.

### We Meet Again

UTEP leads the all-time series against UCF, 5-2, including a perfect 3-0 in El Paso. The Knights used a half-court buzzer beater to defeat the Miners, 68-65, in Orlando on Feb. 10, 2011, in the only meeting between the teams last year.

### GOING BACK IN TIME

**Brown Powers UTEP To 70-63 Win At Southern Miss**  
**Gloria Brown** posted a monstrous double-double and head coach **Keitha Adams** secured her 300th collegiate win after UTEP downed Southern Miss, 70-63, on the road on Jan. 26. UTEP started the second half on a 12-2 run, which not only erased a 30-28 halftime deficit but also propelled it into the lead for good. The Lady Eagles tried to rally but each push by the home side was countered by the Orange and Blue

### Brown Delivers The Goods

**Gloria Brown** poured in a career high 27 points, aided by making a school-record 17 free throws, while grabbing the second-most rebounds (19) in program history in a dominant display at Southern Miss (1/26/12). She also equaled the school standard for free-throws attempted (19).

### Who Else Drew Praise

**Kelli Willingham** tallied 13 points, including sinking four big three pointers while junior **Kristine Vitola** added 12 points and seven boards. **Kim Smith** also played an important role. She registered two assists, had a career-high-tying five boards and played 25 minutes of turnover-free basketball in a game which the Miners had 25 miscues.

### Second-Half Team In League Play

Thanks to the effort at Southern Miss, the Miners now boast a +12.0 scoring margin (37.6-25.6) in the second half of league games this year. They are at +0.7 (30.4-29.7) in the opening period of C-USA games.

### 18 Wins & Counting...

There have now been five squads in program history to secure at least 18 wins in a single season, and four of them have come during the **Keitha Adams** era. This year's team is now tied for the third-most wins in a single season at the school, joining the 1992-93 Miners (18-10) & 2008-09 squad (18-12). The school standard was set by the 2007-08 team (28-4), with the 2006-07 squad (22-8) checking in second.

### GETTING TO KNOW YOU

#### The 411 On UCF As An Institution

The University of Central Florida, or UCF as it is commonly known as, is a metropolitan public research university located in Orlando, Fla. In terms of enrollment (58,587), UCF is the largest university in the Sunshine State and the third biggest in the nation. The school was founded relatively recently (1963), and was done so with the intention of providing quality personnel to support the Kennedy Space Center. Notable alumni include former Cleveland Indians & Texas Rangers GM **John Hart** & FIFA Woman's Player of the Century, **Michelle Akers**.

#### The 411 On UCF Basketball

UCF's program was started for the 1977-78 season and has been at the division one level since the 1984-85 campaign. The Knights have appeared in the NCAA Tournament on four occasions, with the most-recent bid coming at last year's "Big Dance."

#### Get To Know The UCF Head Coach

UCF is under the direction of fifth-year head coach **Joi Williams**, who has registered a mark of 69-74 while guiding the program. She stands at 123-135 in her ninth season overall as a collegiate head coach. Williams previously held the same position at Murray State. She is very very familiar with the "Sunshine State." The Jacksonville, Fla., native played for the women's basketball team at South Florida from 1984-88. She got her start in coaching at the University of Florida, serving as an assistant coach for 12 years with the SEC program.

### Looking At The UCF Season

UCF (9-10, 4-3 C-USA) has played 14 of its 19 games at home. After a 2-1 start, the Knights endured a stretch of 3-6 to cap non-league action at 5-7. UCF regrouped to knock off East Carolina, 59-53, in its C-USA opener on (1/5/12) but dropped consecutive road contests. UCF responded with a season-best three-match winning streak, but that surge was halted after a 60-48 loss to SMU (1/26/12).

### This And That On UCF's Offense

Four players contribute better than 7.0 ppg, including a pair in double figures in **Aisha Patrick** (14.4) & **Gevenia Carter** (12.1). 365 of its 399 FGM have been two-point shots. No Knight has more assists than turnovers, and UCF makes 20.1 tpg. **Erika Jones** is the only player above 45 percent from the floor (49.6). Jones (65) & Patrick (46) lead a group of four Knights with at least 25 offensive boards. After consecutive contests with more than 60 points for the second time on the year, UCF has tallied 55 & 48 in the two games since.

### This And That On UCF's Defense

Six players have 15+ steals, with **Aisha Patrick (43)** and **Gevenia Carter** (30) setting the pace. **Kayli Keough** (11) & **Erika Jones** (10) are the only players with double figures in blocked shots. Four of the first 11 opponents had at least 70 points on the year. No foe has accounted for more than 64 since.

### CRASH COURSE ON UTEP HOOPS

#### The Basic Facts On UTEP Basketball

2011-12 marks the 38th season for the UTEP women's basketball team. The Miners have an all-time record of 436-584, including 18-2 this year. UTEP has been a member of four leagues, including being affiliated with Conference USA since the start of the 2005-06 season. The Miners have one postseason appearance and one conference championship to their credit, both of which came during the historic 2007-08 season (28-4 overall, 16-0 C-USA). UTEP returned three starters (and eight letterwinners (four guards, four posts) overall from last year's squad (16-14, 7-9 C-USA). Six newcomers, all guards (freshmen **Syerra Davis**, **Jenzel Nash**, **Chrishauna Parker** & **Marissa Rodriguez**, sophomore **Ryah Lacy** and junior **Melisa Mendes**) are in the mix for the Orange and Blue in 2011-12.

### Getting To Know Coach Adams

UTEP is led by the winningest coach in program history, **Keitha Adams**. She is 173-145 in her 11th year at the school, including 18-2 this year. Overall Adams is 300-182 in her 16th season as a collegiate head coach, having compiled a mark of 127-37 in a five-year run at Independence Community College. Four of the five seasons in program history with at least 18 wins have been in her tenure. Additionally, seven of the 10 campaigns with 16+ wins are courtesy of Adams. She was the 2008 C-USA Coach of the Year/ finalist for national honor after leading the Miners to their first league championship & postseason bid (advanced to second round of NCAA Tournament). Every player who has exhausted her eligibility at UTEP during her tenure has graduated.

### Talk About A 10-Year Stretch

Including the mark of 18-2 in 2011-12, the Miners are now 170-120 over the past 10 years (2002-03 season-present). The effort obliterates the prior standard at the school for a decade-long stretch (115-155 from 1990-91 through 1999-2000).

### Winning Mark At Major Junctures

UTEP posted a school-record eight seasons with a winning mark through 15 games (prior standard four) & a program-best seven consecutive campaigns for the 20-contest juncture. Additionally, the Miners were above .500 for the fifth time in the past six years through 10 tilts.

### Hometown Heroes

The Miners have featured at least one player from the El Paso area in every year of the **Keitha Adams** era, with this year's team sporting a pair. Sophomore forward **Kayla Thornton** starred at Irvin High School in El Paso while freshman guard **Marissa Rodriguez** grew up in the area before moving to San Antonio and playing high school basketball at San Antonio Reagan.

### Taking Advantage Of National Spotlight

The Miners are 8-5 in national TV games during the **Keitha Adams** era, including 1-0 this year (66-60 win vs. Memphis). UTEP is also slated to play on national TV for the game at Rice (2/5/12), which will also be broadcast by Fox Sports Networks.

### Success In Non-League Play

UTEP is 87-56 in non-conference play during the **Keitha Adams** era, which was aided by going 11-2 this year. The Miners have posted a school-record seven straight years of .500 or better in non-league play (prior standard four, 1994-95 through 1997-98).

### In Brief 2010-11 Year-In-Review

UTEP overcame the loss of four key players to injuries at various points in the year on the way to finished with an overall record of 16-14 during the 2010-11 season. The Miners fought hard throughout the year, with a single-season school record 12 of the 14 setbacks coming by single digits. UTEP was 13-6 in El Paso, including 8-3 during non-conference play.

### TRENDING WITH THE TEAM

#### Getting Offensive

UTEP has posted 70+ points in consecutive contests, its best stretch since eclipsing that figure in the first three games of the year. UTEP made 35.1 percent from the floor at Southern Miss (1/26/12). It had been a combined 46.2 percent (60-130) the prior two tilts. UTEP had 20+ turnovers just three times in the first 16 games, but it has done so in three of the four since. After a two-game stretch of 56.4 percent (22-of-39) from the free-throw line, the Miners made 75.8 percent (25-33) at USM.

#### Getting Defensive

UTEP hasn't allowed more than 63 points in regulation this season. Included in the stretch was keeping a program-best 10 straight opponents (prior mark, five, 2007-08) to fewer than 55 points, with six of those squads failing to crack the 50's. 18 of the 20 opponents have been kept to below 40 percent, and 10 have failed to eclipse 34%. Those efforts have the Miners on pace to set single-season school records for FG% defense & scoring defense. The opposition has made 18+ turnovers in four of the past five games.

### Not Just Winning But Winning Big

Thirteen of UTEP's 18 wins have come by double figures, which ranks tied for third all time in a single season at the school. The standard is held by the 2007-08 squad (18), followed by the 2006-07 team (15) & 1992-93 squad (13). A school-record-tying eight of the triumphs have been by at least 20 points, matching the effort in 2006-07.

### Even In Defeat, UTEP Is Competitive

Dating to the start of last season, 16 of the 18 setbacks in that timeframe have been by single digits. The Miners were saddled with a single-season school record 14 defeats by fewer than 10 points in 2010-11 while the two losses in 2011-12 have been by a combined three points.

### Playing Time A Plenty

UTEP has 12 players earning double figures in minutes played (min. appearance in 75% of games played), which checks in tied for most in the country according to Stats Inc. Sophomore guard **Kelli Willingham** tops the list at 26.0 mpg, while five others are snagging better than 17.0 mpg.

### The Bench Bunch

The Miners' back-ups are accounting for 37.5 points per game, which has been aided by 30+ points in 16 of the 20 contests. UTEP has eight outings with 40+ points, including a **Keitha Adams** era best 55-point showing against Texas State (12/31/11).

### Diving Deeper With The Reserves

UTEP's bench has outscored the opposition's reserves in every game, with a double-digit advantage in 19 of the 20 contests. Furthermore, the Miners' reserves have either out-scored the opponent's starters (nine) or matched them (two) 11 times.

### Ready To Rebound

UTEP was out-rebounded in the first two games but has won the battle of the boards in 15 of 18 contests since. The Miners boast a C-USA best +9.5 margin and are grabbing 44.8 rpg, which would break the single-season school record 44.5 (1996-97)

### Controlling The Paint

UTEP is generating 32.9 points per game in the paint, which has been helped with 14 games of 28+ points. The Miners have eclipsed 40 points down low on six occasions. The opposition has managed just 21.4 ppg in the paint, with only two teams (Northern Colorado, 30, 12/13/11 & at Southern Miss 38, 1/26/12) topping 29.

## FRONT COURT VETS TRENDING

### What Can Brown Do For You

**Gloria Brown** was the 2011 second-team all C-USA member & Newcomer/Sixth Player. After four points in five minutes against Houston (1/22/12), a well-rested Brown torched Southern Miss for 27 points (career-high) and 19 rebounds (2nd most ever in school history). She set the school standard for free-throws made (17) & tied it for attempts (19). After a sequence of 3-of-5 at the line, she was 17-19 at USM. Brown has 10+ boards in six of the past nine games. She has hit on 63.6 percent (14-of-22) from the field the past three tilts to snap out of a slump where she was at 28.0 percent (7-25) in the prior three. She has at least four blocks in five of the past seven games, and is responsible for 57 of the team's 107 rejections on the year.

### Vitola's Venue

Junior **Kristine Vitola** has made huge strides from her first two seasons with UTEP. Her shooting percentage is up from 36.8 to 44.1, scoring average has gone from 4.7 to 6.1 & rebounding average moved from 3.3 to 6.3. She has 26 points in the past three games, topping her sum (24) from the prior seven. Vitola is at 48.0 percent (12-of-25) from the floor in the recent hot streak. She had been at 28.6 percent (8-28) during that skid. For the third time this season, she has back-to-back games with 7+ boards. After making 24-of-27 at the free-throw line to start the year, she missed 2-of-5 at Southern Miss (1/26/12).

### Kayla's Corner

Sophomore **Kayla Thornton** has been an impact player with high-energy motor. She had four points at Southern Miss (1/26/12), halting a stretch of five straight & six of seven with 10+ points. Thornton also had just four boards at USM. She had posted 8+ rebounds in five of the prior six. After a two-game stretch of going 6-of-10 at the line, she has made 4-of-5. She has 3+ offensive rebounds in eight consecutive contests to double her sum (four) of in the first 12 tilts.

### Anete's Area

Junior **Anete Steinberga** has hit 57.6 percent (34-of-59) while scoring 5.1 ppg & grabbing 2.9 rpg in 11.1 mpg in 15 games off the bench this year. In five starts at 9.8 mpg, her rebounding is up to 3.4 but she has hit on just 10.5 percent (2-of-19) for 1.8 ppg. Steinberga has defended smartly, with two or fewer fouls in 17 of the past 18 match-ups.

## BACK COURT VETS TRENDING

### Willingham's Will To Succeed

**Kelli Willingham** was a 2011 All C-USA Freshman honoree. She has made 8-of-17 from the floor in the past three games. She was in a 4-of-18 skid prior. She was 1-of-2 at the free-throw line at Southern Miss, ending a 20-of-23 surge. She also had an offensive rebound in the contest, just her fourth all year. Willingham has drilled 3+ triples seven times, including two such showings since C-USA play started. She had five turnovers against USM. She hadn't committed more than three previously this year.

### No Ordinary Smith

Senior **Kim Smith** has been a quality on-ball defender while getting involved in the offense in her second & final season for the Miners. She has at least two helpers in 14 of the past 16 games. She started 16 straight, came off the bench at ECU (1/18/12), but has been back in the line-up in the two games since. After tallying 4+ points a total of four times in the first 14 contests on the year, she has done so in four of the past six. Smith has 11 rebounds in the past three tilts, topping her tally (10) from the previous 10.

## Not Easy Being Green

Senior **Briana Green**, who has fought through a pair of season-ending injuries (freshman & junior), has played injury free this year. Green is 3-of-6 from the floor and has a total of six points in the past two games. She had been scoreless in the prior four and managed eight points while hitting 3-of-17 in the previous eight. She has hit multiple three pointers in a trio of contests, and is a combined 6-of-15 in them. In her other 17 games, Green is 4-of-22 from beyond-the-arc.

### Warren's Way

Second-year Miner & senior **Erika Warren** has started the past two games, and has produced nine points. That effort tops her total (7) from the prior four. She had fewer than 10 minutes of playing time in two of the first five games but hasn't been in single digits since. After a stretch of nailing six free throws in a row, she has made four of her past nine. Nine of her 26 turnovers on the season have come in the past three tilts.

### Eglite's Extent

Senior **Baiba Eglite** is healthy & has appeared in 14 games as a senior. She had nine points on 3-of-5 shooting against Houston (1/22/12), but was scoreless in five minutes at Southern Miss (1/26/12). She had garnered 10+ minutes in back-to-back games for the first time this season. Ten of her 13 FGM have been of the three-point variety.

### Whitney Worth The Wait

Senior **Whitney Houston** transferred to UTEP from Colorado prior to the start of the 2010-11 season, but she missed a year-and-a-half due to a knee injury. She has played in eight contests. She has scored 14 points, with five points against both Texas State (12/31/11) & Houston (1/22/12).

## NEWBIES TRENDING

### Parker Power

Freshman **Chrisauna Parker** was a top-50 guard nationally out of Atascocita HS. After coming off the bench for nine of her first 10 appearances, she has started seven in a row. She hasn't played the past two games due to team rules. She is 8-of-20 at the free-throw line over her last eight games played.

### Mendes Means Business

Junior **Melisa Mendes** was an all-conference performer at NW Florida State College. Mendes has seven points the past two games. She had been scoreless on the road trip to Tulane & ECU. She is still stuck in a bit of a shooting slump, standing at 10-of-39 from the floor over her past six games. Mendes has made multiple three pointers in a quartet of contests, and is a combined 10-of-20 from distance in those games. She is 5-of-38 on triples in her other tilts on the year.

### The Name Is Nash

Freshman **Jenzel Nash** joined UTEP as the program's first Parade All-American after leading the nation in scoring with 37.7 ppg for Worthing HS. She had four points at Southern Miss (1/26/12). She had ran off three in a row with 5+ for the first time of her career, including a career-best 25 points at Tulane (1/15/12). She has played 14+ minutes seven times this year, and is accounting for 11.9 ppg while hitting 44.1 percent from the floor (30-of-68) & 66.7 (22-33) at the free-throw line. In her other 12 games played, she has had 1.4 ppg while making 15.0 percent from the field (6-of-40) and 66.7 percent (4-of-6) at the charity stripe. She is 21-of-27 at the free-throw line in her past six games. She was 5-of-10 in that department to start the year. She has 15 rebounds the past four tilts, surpassing her effort (11) from the prior 11. Nash made her first career start at ECU (1/18/12).

### Lace It Up With Lacy

Sophomore **Ryah Lacy**, who led Grayson County College to a fifth-place finish nationally, has missed the past five games (three injury, two team rules). She made a combined 5-of-12 from the floor for 12 points against Houston Baptist (11/19/11 & NM State, 11/29/11). In her other 11 contests played she checks in at 5-of-25 for 11 points. She has posted one steal (or more) in 11 of her 13 games played.

### Davis Does It

**Syerra Davis**, a top-50 guard who won three straight state titles with Tallason HS, was 0-6 from the floor in her first five games as a Miner, but she is 5-of-7 in her seven contests since. Half of her points on the year (seven) & almost half of her rebounds (seven) were against Houston (1/22/12). She did not play at Southern Miss.

### Welcome Home, Marissa

Freshman **Marissa Rodriguez** grew up in El Paso before starring at San Antonio Reagan High School after her family moved. She has appeared in three games, securing four minutes and a rebound in that timeframe.

### THREE-POINT LAND

#### New Line Impacting Miners

The three-point line was moved back this year, and it has had an impact. Through 20 games, the Miners are down from 36.2 percent (118-of-326) in 2010-11 to 28.2 percent (100-of-354) on three-point shooting this season. The opposition has also suffered, though, slipping from 30.1 percent (104-of-346) to 24.0 (63-of-262).

### Threes A Plenty Since 2008

From the time the three-point shot was introduced in college basketball (1986-87) through 2007-08, UTEP had eight games with at least 10 triples. The Miners have compiled 11 since, including one during the 2011-12 season.

### 187 Straight Games With A Triple

UTEP has made at least one three-point shot in a program-record 187 straight games. The last time UTEP failed to fill up a triple in a contest was on Dec. 30, 2005. They have hit one in all but four games during **Keith Adams'** era.

### The Magical 70-Point Barrier

The Miners are 108-12 during the **Keith Adams** era, including 9-0 this year, in games which they eclipsed 70 points.

### Seems Logical

UTEP holds a record of 89-15 in the past 104 contests in which it has hit on at least 40.5 percent from the field. The Miners are 11-0 in the situation this year.

### It's All About The Triple

UTEP sports a mark of 47-9 in its past 56 games when making 40 percent or better from three-point range (min. 5 3PM), but they have done so just once (1-0) this year.

### Better Get Ready To Rebound

UTEP has a record of 104-41 under **Keith Adams**, including 38-10 in the past 48 games, when out-rebounding the opposition. It is 13-1 in the situation this year, with the lone loss coming to UCSB (12/21/11).

### Helping Hand Leads To Triumphs

UTEP is a robust 54-2 under **Keith Adams**, including 5-0 this year, when registering at least 20 assists in a contest. Sharing hasn't always been so common, though. UTEP compiled 19 such games from 1984-85 through 2000-01, going 13-6.

### As Does Forcing Turnovers

The Miners are 63-15 over their past 78 games that they've forced the opposition into committing at least 20 turnovers. UTEP is 7-0 in the situation this year. Ten have committed 18 or more.

### Turning Up The Pressure

UTEP is 63-12 during the **Keith Adams** era, including 45-3 since the start of the 2006-07 campaign, when forcing the opposition into committing more turnovers than field goals made in a game. The Miners are 9-0 in the situation this year.

### Making Free Throws Can Help

UTEP is 48-10 over the past 58 contests when knocking down better than 70 percent at the free-throw line (minimum 10 FTM), including 8-0 in 2011-12.

### Finding A Way To Win When Not Though

Dating to the start of the 2006-07 campaign, the Orange and Blue boast a head-scratching mark of 24-11 in games in which they were below 61-percent from the free-throw line (minimum 10 attempts). The Miners are 4-2 in that situation this year.

### Go Figure

The Miners are 16-8 in their past 24 regular-season contests, including 1-0 this year, in which they have made more three pointers than free throws.

### Start Them Up

The Miners are 29-9 when **Kristine Vitola** has started in her career. UTEP is 24-8 with **Kayla Thornton** earning a starting nod since arriving on campus.

### MILESTONE MOMENTS

**Adams Adding To Record With Every Win**  
Eleventh-year UTEP head coach **Keith Adams**, the winningest coach in program history, has compiled a mark of 173-145 in her time in the Sun City. She has led her charges to a record of 170-120 from the start of the 2002-03 campaign. From the program's inception in 1974-75 through the end of the 1990-91 season, six different coaches aided UTEP to a record of 145-286. Sandra Rushing was 123-175 in 11 seasons on the sideline (1990-91-2000-01).

### Green's Got It Going On

**Briana Green's** career has been hindered with injuries (missed 29 games), making her numbers across the board even more impressive. She is sixth for individual wins (68) & 10th for assists (194). She is one of 25 Miners with at least 75+ steals (79) one of 27 with 600+ points (620). She has logged 2,079 minutes of playing time, making her one of 16 in the program to have 2000+.

### Brown Getting It Done In All Areas

**Gloria Brown** will leave a big dent in the UTEP record books despite joining the program as a junior. She is currently first all time at the school for career field-goal percentage at 55.0 (222-404) & FT percentage at 80.8 (155-192). Brown has piled up 602 points to become the 10th Miner to have at least 600 after transferring in as a junior & 28th overall. Additionally she is tied for first in blocks per game (2.5), third for total blocks (122) & fourth in double-doubles (16).

### Vitola's A Big Shot Blocker Too

Junior **Kristine Vitola** has swatted 81 shots in her career, which ranks fifth all time at the school. She has also tallied 410 career points while grabbing 324 boards in 81 games played.

### Steinberga Marching Toward 500

Junior **Anete Steinberga** is slowly but surely making the climb toward joining the 500-point club at UTEP. She had a season-best 15 points at East Carolina (1/18/12), and now stands at 437 for her career.

### Looking Back On 10-0 Start

UTEP opened up at 10-0 (now 18-2) to stand alone for the best start to a season in program history, besting the prior standard out of the gates (7-0) during the 1996-97 season. The Miners became the first Conference USA school since 2004-05 & fifth overall to open up with 10 straight wins. Overall it tied as the third-best start in league history.

### Piled Up The Non-League Wins

UTEP went 11-2 in non-conference play. The 11 wins tied for the most in school history heading into the start of league action, matching the effort by the 2006-07 squad (11-1).

### UTEP Stomps Houston, 87-43

UTEP bolted out to a 41-21 lead at the half and never looked back on the way throttling Houston, 87-43, to secure its largest margin of victory in a conference game in program history on Jan. 22.

### Nash's Star Showing At Tulane

Freshman **Jenzel Nash** poured in 25 points to go along with seven rebounds and seven steals at Tulane (1/15/12). She is the second player in school history to have at least 25-7-7 (of that combination) in a single game. Former standout & current WNBA player **Natasha Lacy** achieved the feat with 25-8-8 in an 86-69 rout of Southern Miss in the semifinals of the 2008 C-USA tournament on March 8, 2008.

### Rally Time

UTEP roared back from 19 down to defeat Memphis, 66-60, on Jan. 8. The come-from-behind triumph is the biggest in terms of league games for UTEP, eclipsing the prior standard (15) in a 67-64 defeat against UAB on Jan. 18, 2008. Overall it equals the effort by the Miners in 72-71 OT win against Illinois State on Dec. 19, 2004.

### Now That's Balance

The Miners racked up 81 points against Lamar (12/1/11) despite their leading scorer for the game (**Melisa Mendes**) finishing with only 10 points. UTEP averaged 47 points in 29 games dating to the 1983-84 season in which its leading scorer finished with 10 or fewer points. It only eclipsed 60 in one of those contests, with a 71-point effort against McNeese State on Nov. 24, 1989.

### Dominant Three-Game Stretch

The Miners blew past Denver, 80-49, on Nov. 26, New Mexico State, 63-27, on Nov. 29 & Lamar, 81-52, on Dec. 1, which marked the first time they won three straight games by at least 29 points against a Division I foe for the first time in school history.

### Historic Night Of Defense

UTEP smothered New Mexico State (11/29/11), setting program records against a division I opponent for fewest points allowed in a half (eight) and game (27) and field-goal percentage defense (18.4 percent). Additionally, it ranked as the third-fewest points permitted by a Conference USA school.

### Bombs Away

The Miners sunk 11 three pointers in the win against Denver (11/26/11), which rated tied for the seventh-highest single-game total in program history.

### Crashing The Glass

UTEP secured 29 offensive rebounds, the third most in program history, which led to 33 second-chance points in the win against Houston Baptist (11/19/11). Overall the Miners tallied 60 rebounds, which was their highest sum since the 2005-06 season and tied for ninth overall in school history.

### Gloria Was Glorious

**Gloria Brown** flirted with a triple-double (21 points, nine boards, eight blocks) while playing a career-high 31 minutes in the win at NM State (11/16/11). The eight rejections rate third all time at the school, trailing only former Miner **Izabela Piekarska's** single-game effort (10, twice).

### Double Your Pleasure

**Gloria Brown** posted a double-double (18/10) in the season opener, becoming the first Miner to register the feat in consecutive years. Overall she has 16 double-doubles in her two years at UTEP (4th all time), with eight of those coming this season.

### HOME SWEET HOME

#### Loving Life In El Paso

The Miners are 78-18 in El Paso since the start of the 2006-07 season, including 11-1 this year. **Keitha Adams'** charges have strung together a school-record four straight seasons with 12 or more home triumphs. UTEP only had four campaigns where it even reached double figures in home wins during the first 27 years of the program, with the high water mark (12-1) coming in 1988-89.

### Home Games A Plenty In 2011-12

By year's end, the Miners will have played 17 home games (nine non-conference & eight C-USA), which ties as the third-highest figure in program history. The school standard (19 games, 13-6 record) was set last season, which was aided by the Miners playing host to the 2011 Conference USA Tournament. UTEP rolled to a record of 16-2 in 2006-07 while forging a mark of 12-5 in 2008-09.

### Don't Take Things For Granted

UTEP has posted a program-best nine straight years with at least nine home victories and boasts an overall record of 113-50 in El Paso during the **Keitha Adams** era. The Miners had six such seasons in the 27 years prior to her tenure, and were a combined 163-142.

### Not Too Shabby Of A Homestand

UTEP rolled to a record of 5-0 in its homestand from Nov. 19 through Dec. 1. The Miners' largest deficit during the sequence was three, 5-2 with 18:47 to play first half against Lamar. Overall UTEP only trailed for a combined time of two minutes and 25 seconds in the five games.

### TRAVEL TIME

#### Road Wins Starting To Add Up

UTEP is off to a 7-1 start on the road, the best start away from home in program history. Overall the seven triumphs rate tied as the second most in school history. The program standard is 10 (2007-08) while the 1980-81 & 1992-93 squads each grabbed seven victories.

### Making Progress On The Road

UTEP is 45-84 on the road under **Keitha Adams**, but they have made strides of late. UTEP is 33-33 away from home dating to the 2006-07 season, including the 7-1 record this year.

### Appreciating The Efforts Under Adams

UTEP is ensured of its second winning record on the road under **Keitha Adams** & fourth year at .500 or better away from home. Prior to her arrival, the Miners' never had a winning road mark & were at .500 just twice in 27 years.

### Have Had Some Big Wins Away From Home

UTEP boasts 19 double-digit victories on the road under head coach **Keitha Adams**. The Miners had 27 such victories before her tenure, 13 were against non-DI schools.

### Did You Know

The Miners are 2-1 on the year (wins at New Mexico & Tulane, loss at Arizona State) when falling shy of 33.5 percent from the floor in road games. UTEP had dropped 41 straight such contests dating to the 1996-97 campaign.

### LEAGUE MATTERS

#### Miners Picked Fourth In Preseason Poll

UTEP was selected tied for fourth in the 2011-12 Conference USA Preseason Poll, as voted upon the league's 12 head coaches. **Gloria Brown** was tabbed to the all-conference preseason team, which was also revealed by the league office on Oct. 6. Memphis was selected as the preseason favorite, with Tiger guard **Brittany Carter** being named the preseason player of the year.

### Getting It Done Of Late In League Openers

UTEP is 6-2 since 2005 in league openers, including 4-1 at home during that time frame. Overall, the Miners are 6-5 in conference christenings during the **Keitha Adams** era. They were 3-12 before her.

### Especially On The Road

The Miners are now 3-2 in league openers on the road since 2008 & are 4-7 overall in the situation under head coach **Keitha Adams**. UTEP was 4-16 prior to Adams' tenure in its initial conference road contest.

### Balanced Attack

All 13 Miners who saw action scored at least four points, with sophomore **Kayla Thornton** leading the way with 18 points on 8-of-12 shooting. The Miners' bench poured in 48 points, out-scoring the entire UH squad in the process.

### UTEP Secures First Win In Greenville, 66-56

UTEP pounded East Carolina down low while punishing it on the glass on the way to picking up its first victory in four tries at Minges Coliseum, 66-56, on Jan. 18. The game was tied at 35 at the half but the Miners ripped control of the contest with an 11-2 run over the first nine minutes of the second stanza. The Pirates tried to rally but each run was answered with one by the visitors.

### Stars Of The Contest

**Gloria Brown** posted her seventh double-double of the year (17 points, 11 boards) to lead the way while **Anete Steinberga** added a season-best 15 points and Kayla Thornton pitched in 10. Senior **Kim Smith** also stood out with a career-best five rebounds and a career-high-tying six assists in 26 minutes of action.

### Nash Carries Miners Past Tulane, 65-64 In OT

**Jenzel Nash** poured in a career-high 25 points, and UTEP got three stops in the final 45 seconds on the way to handing Tulane its first home loss of the season, 65-64, on Jan. 15. Nash scored six points in the extra session, including banking in a jump shot with 1:11 to play in OT that would serve as the eventual game-winner.

### It's Not Over 'Til The Fat Lady Sings

The Miners closed regulation on a 12-3 run to force OT in the eventual win at Tulane (1/15/12). **Kayla Thornton** hit her first three pointer of the season to pull UTEP within one (55-54, 1:27 to play), and **Gloria Brown** eventually tied it by sinking two clutch free throws with 20 seconds to play.

### Brown Tabbed C-USA Player Of The Week

**Gloria Brown** was named the Conference USA Player of the Week, the league office announced on Jan. 9. Brown helped lead the Miners to a perfect 2-0 start in league action by averaging 12.5 points, 11 rebounds, 5.0 blocks and 2.5 steals in 23.5 minutes.

### UTEP Topples Tulsa, 67-56

**Kayla Thornton** scored 17 points and UTEP used a solid approach defensively on the way to downing Tulsa, 67-56, on Jan. 12. The Miners led the final 37:45 of the game, and were up by at least seven points over the final 10 minutes.

### Deeeee-Fense

Tulsa hit just 29.4 percent from the floor, and had only six second-half field goals. It finished with more free-throws made (23) and turnovers committed (20) than total field goals (15).

### Steinberga Steps Up

With **Gloria Brown** limited due to foul trouble, junior **Anete Steinberga** provided a lift against Tulsa (1/12/12). She tallied 10 points while grabbing five rebounds.

**Stunning Comeback Lifts UTEP Past Memphis, 66-60**  
UTEP equaled the biggest comeback in school history, erasing a 19-point halftime deficit to down Memphis, 66-60, on Jan. 8. The Miners used a 36-12 surge, including a 17-0 run to start the stanza, to not only erase the 41-22 deficit but take a lead they would never relinquish. The Tigers pulled within two (62-60) with 24 seconds left but UTEP sealed the comeback by knocking down its final four free throws.

#### **Nash Was Big**

**Jenzel Nash** was instrumental in the rally. Nash scored the first five points and nine total during a 17-0 run to open the period and get UTEP back in the game. After Memphis had pulled back ahead, the Miners struck back with eight in a row, and six of them came from Nash. She hit 7-of-11 from the floor and was 7-of-9 at the charity stripe.

#### **Thornton Was Too**

**Kayla Thornton** scored 17 points to match **Jenzel Nash**, including a pair of free throws in the waning seconds to seal the game for the Miners.

#### **Big Rebounding Night Sends UTEP Past SMU**

**Gloria Brown** posted her third consecutive double-double (17 points, 11 rebounds), **Kelli Willingham** added 16 points and UTEP crushed SMU on the boards in a 64-53 win inside Moody Coliseum on Jan. 8. The Miners out-rebounded the Mustangs 52-28, including a dominant readout of 32-9 in the second half. The effort afforded UTEP an advantage of 15-4 on second-chance points, with 13 of those points coming over the final 20 minutes.

#### **Welcome Back, Kristine**

**Kristine Vitola** was back on the court after missing one game due to an illness, and she looked to be in good form at SMU (1/5/12). The junior toyed with a double-double before finishing with nine points & eight boards in 29 minutes of action.

#### **That's How You Close Out A Contest**

UTEP led by two (55-53) with 3:10 to play but out-scored SMU 9-0 down the stretch to close out the contest in style. The Miners iced it late by going 5-of-6 at the free-throw line in the final minute of action.

#### **UTEP Thrashes Texas State, 81-58**

**Kayla Thornton** poured in a career-high 20 points, **Gloria Brown** notched her second straight double-double (10 points, 13 rebounds) and **Baiba Eglite** provided a spark off the bench with a season-high 11 points to help UTEP rout Texas State, 81-58, on Dec. 31. The Miners trailed 12-8 with 10:36 to play in the first half before going on a 17-5 run on the way to taking control of the contest. Eglite fueled the sequence with a trio of three pointers, and the Bobcats who had won three in a row- never recovered.

#### **Houston Shows Her Skills**

Senior **Whitney Houston**, who made her UTEP debut at Arizona State (12/28/11), displayed some scoring ability by pitching in five points in six minutes of action against Texas State (12/31/11).

#### **Arizona State Holds Off UTEP, 47-45**

**Kelli Willingham's** potential go-ahead three pointer from the right wing was blocked with seven seconds to play, allowing Arizona State to creep past UTEP, 47-45, inside Wells Fargo Arena on Dec. 28. It was a back-and-forth defensive battle, with seven ties & nine lead changes. The Miners trailed by four (47-43) with 1:20 remaining in regulation but held the Sun Devils scoreless down the stretch to give themselves a chance at a comeback.

#### **Vitola Has Another Big Night On Boards**

**Kristine Vitola** notched her third double-digit rebounding effort to that point with a career-high 11 boards at Arizona State (12/28/11).

#### **UTEP Falls For First Time, 49-48, To UCSB**

UTEP was saddled with its first loss of the season in challenging fashion, falling to UC Santa Barbara, 49-48, on a last-second shot by **Sweets Underwood** at home on Dec. 21. The Miners led 47-40 with 2:56 to play only to have the Gauchos close out in the contest on a 9-2 push, which was capped by Underwood's short jumper off an out-of-bounds play with 0.4 seconds remaining.

#### **Sometimes Shots Don't Fall**

UTEP finished at 35.2 percent from the floor (19-of-54), with a readout of 18.8 percent (3-of-16) from three-point land impacting that figure. The Miners heated up in the second stanza to drill 45.5 percent from the floor, including 2-of-4 from distance, but ultimately it wasn't enough.

#### **Miners Roll To 68-48 Win At Loyola Marymount**

**Kelli Willingham** poured in a season-high 18 points to help lead UTEP to a 68-48 triumph at Loyola Marymount on Dec. 17. The Miners bolted out to a 15-2 lead. The Lions fought back to trim the deficit to four on a couple of occasions but the Miners used a 14-6 surge to carry a 37-25 advantage into the locker room. LMU never got closer than eight from that point on.

#### **Brown Powers Miners Past UNC, 74-51**

**Gloria Brown** recorded her third double-double of the season (16 points, 11 rebounds) to help the Miners post a 74-51 conquest of Northern Colorado at home on Dec. 13. The Miners were up 19-17 with 9:17 to play in the first half before putting together a 20-2 run to break the game wide open. They led 41-27 at the half, pushed their advantage out to as many as 31 (74-43).

#### **Balanced Approach Does It**

Seven different players scored at least six points against Northern Colorado (12/13/11). **Gloria Brown** keyed the efforts with 16 while **Anete Steinberga** registered a season-high 11 points to join her in double figures. **Chrishauna Parker** (nine points), **Kayla Thornton** and **Kelli Willingham** (eight points) and **Kristine Vitola** and **Baiba Eglite** (six points) all got in the act as well.

#### **Willingham Dishes It Out**

Sophomore **Kelli Willingham** tallied a season-high nine assists while committing only one turnover to help the Miners turn in an efficient offensive night against Northern Colorado (12/13/11). UTEP finished with 20 assists on 28 field-goals made.

#### **UTEP Smothers New Mexico, 53-43**

Stifling defense, a quality effort at the free-throw line and baskets at key times carried UTEP past New Mexico, 53-43, on the road on Dec. 10. **Gloria Brown** (12 points, 7 rebounds), **Briana Green** (10 points), **Kelli Willingham** (10 points) and **Kristine Vitola** (six points, 10 rebounds) led the way for the Miners.

#### **Lockdown Defense**

UTEP kept the Lobos to 25.5 percent from the floor and harassed them into committing 22 turnovers.

#### **Winning At The Pit Is Always Special**

Thanks to the effort at New Mexico (12/10/11), the Miners picked up their first win at The Pit since the 1994-95 season to stand at fourth all time (4-20). Additionally, it marked the Lobos' first double-digit home setback of the season.

#### **Miners Crush Lamar, 81-52**

UTEP played its most complete game of the year to remain undefeated on the season with a resounding 81-52 victory against Lamar on Dec. 1. Eight different players scored at least seven points for the Miners (7-0). UTEP bolted out to a 39-21 halftime lead, extended it to as many as 36 (79-43) before putting it on cruise control down the stretch.

#### **How Sweep It Is; UTEP Crushes NM State, 63-27**

Behind stifling defense, UTEP cruised past New Mexico State, 63-27, to complete the sweep of the Sonic Battle of I-10 series at the Don Haskins Center on Nov. 29. The Miners led 23-8 at the break and were up by at least 30 points over the final 10 minutes of the contest. It marked the largest margin of victory in the series for the Miners and the second-biggest overall.

#### **Big-Time Defense**

UTEP limited NM State to just 9-of-49 shooting from the floor, including 1-of-11 from beyond-the-arc on Nov. 29. The Miners also harassed the visitors into committing 25 points, only two shy of the Aggies' point total.

#### **Break Out The Brooms**

The effort against NM State (11/29/11) locked up the Miners' first sweep of the series since 2007-08 and ninth overall. Five of the sweeps have come during **Keitha Adams'** tenure. UTEP is now 13-9 against the Aggies under Adams, making her the lone coach in school history to have a winning record against their Sonic I-10 rivals.

#### **UTEP Stomps Denver, 80-49**

UTEP overpowered Denver, 80-49, in a clash of unbeaten squads on Nov. 26. Sophomore **Kelli Willingham** poured in a season-high 18 points to lead a quartet of players in double figures. UTEP was up, 40-26, at the half and led by as many as 38 (80-42) at one point. The Miners drilled 11 threes (17th-most school history), with Willingham making four of them.

#### **Getting It Done At The Line**

UTEP used good movement & motion to earn ample trips to the free-throw line against Denver (11/26/11). The Miners hit a campaign-best 19-of-27 at the free-throw line.

#### **UTEP Takes Down UTPA, 62-51**

Powered by **Gloria Brown's** second double-double on the year, UTEP dispatched UTPA, 62-51, on Nov. 22. The Miners jumped out to a 29-17 lead at the half, extended it to as many as 19 (58-39 with 4:56 to play) before a mini run late made the final score a little more aesthetically pleasing for UTPA. The Miners dominated down low, scoring 40 of their 62 points in the paint, in addition to winning the rebounding battle, 40-35.

#### **Brown & Vitola Got It Done**

**Gloria Brown** led the way for the Orange and Blue with 13 points, 11 rebounds while also registering five blocked shots against UTPA (11/22/11). **Kristine Vitola** recorded eight points to go along with five boards to support Brown.

#### **Plenty Of Playing Time**

Head coach **Keitha Adams** used 14 of the 15 played dressed in the win against UTPA (11/22/11). Twelve of those 14 logged at least 10 minutes on the court.

### **UTEP Routs Houston Baptist, 82-53**

**Kayla Thornton** posted a double-double (14 points, 11 rebounds) while freshman **Jenzel Nash** poured in a career-high 18 points to propel UTEP past Houston Baptist, 82-53, at home on Nov. 19. The Huskies led 2-0 but the Miners used an 11-0 run to stake an advantage they would never relinquish. UTEP led 43-17 at the half before putting it on cruise control in the second half.

### **Big Rebounding Nights For Vitola & Warren**

**Kristine Vitola** and **Erika Warren** both got after it on the glass with nine rebounds each. The nine board is a career high for Warren, while it matched Vitola's personal-best at the time (since eclipsed).

### **Nash Finds Her Rhythm**

**Jenzel Nash** was 0-7 from the floor in her first two collegiate games before breaking through against Houston Baptist (11/19/11). She nailed 8-of-16 from the floor, including a dazzling fake on a one-on-one situation midway through the second half on a lay-up to bring the crowd to life. She finished with a team-high 18 points.

### **Brown Leads UTEP To 76-72 OT Win At NM State**

**Gloria Brown** poured in 21 points while grabbing nine rebounds and blocking eight shots to help lead UTEP to a 76-72 overtime victory at New Mexico State in the SONIC® America's Drive-In® battle of I-10 on Nov. 16. The Aggies scored the first two points of OT before the Miners ripped off nine straight to surge ahead, 70-63, with 3:03 to play. NM State eventually whittled the margin down to two (74-72) but **Melisa Mendes** came up with a clutch steal and sank a pair of free throws with six seconds left to seal the win.

### **Other Standouts At NM State**

**Chrishauna Parker** delivered 11 points and five rebounds in 27 minutes in her first career start while **Melissa Mendes**, **Kristine Vitola** came through with eight points-including six in OT- to go along with eight rebounds.

### **Second-Half Magic**

UTEP trailed by as many as nine in the first half and was down by six with 9:27 to play. The Miners utilized a 17-3 run over the next seven-plus minutes on the way to surging into the lead (60-52). NM State forced OT by closed the period on a 9-1 run, including a lay-up at the buzzer.

### **UTEP Rides Big Second Half To Topple ISU, 79-63**

UTEP thumped Idaho State, 53-28, during a dominating second half on the way to securing a 79-63 win in the 2011-12 season opener for both squads at the Don Haskins Center on Nov. 12.

### **Defense Does It**

The Miners held the Bengals to 30.8 percent (16-of-52) from the floor, including just 4-of-26 (15.4) in the second half. ISU committed 27 turnovers, which led to 28 UTEP points.

### **Helping Hands**

Unselfish play helped with UTEP registering 20 assists on 29 field goals against Idaho State (11/12). **Kelli Willingham** & **Kim Smith** accounted for half of them, with five helpers each.
