PURPOSE

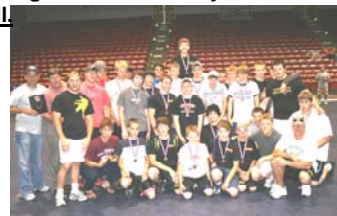
The purpose of this camp is to help young wrestlers achieve a higher level of success. Many of the best coaches and college wrestlers from the Midwest to the West Coast will gather to make this a tremendous experience.

CAMP FORMAT

The camp will be a TEAM CAMP. **Individuals can register in the camp and will be placed on teams** (there will be about 20 wrestlers per team). **All wrestlers will be paired against other wrestlers with equal experience. These teams will wrestle dual meets every day as well as be involved with the excellent technique sessions.** The camp technicians and college wrestlers will give valuable feedback during each of the dual meet sessions.

Any wrestler in middle school or high school wishing to attend this camp is welcome. They will be placed on a team for the dual meet competitions. There will be an All-Star meet at the end of the week in addition to team and individual recognition. This is a tremendous opportunity for wrestlers wanting to get extra mat experience under the supervision of excellent coaches. Aside from teaching during the technique sessions, the staff will work on skills during each dual meet (focusing on the areas they have observed need the most work). **College wrestlers will work one on one with the wrestlers as well.**

Note: We will have special instruction for heavyweights. Education about diet and strength training will also be provided. Coaches: There will be daily technique and philosophy sessions for you to participate in as well as evening socials (while we watch a tape of the 2006 NCAA Championships).



PAST PARTICIPANTS

Some of the Utah schools which have attended The Wrestling Academy regularly the past few years and have been quite successful include: Millard, Viewmont, Wayne, Northridge, Weber, Davis, Pl. Grove, Altamont, Monticello, and Bear River. Many out of state schools have participated in the camp recently, including: Pocatello and Bonneville, ID, Aztec, NM, Bayfield, CO, Las Vegas (Nevada State Champs), Green Valley (Nevada), and Porterville (California).

ROOM AND BOARD

The wrestlers will be staying at the Best Western Abbey Inn, the nicest hotel in St. George. They have very large air-conditioned rooms, an arcade, and a spacious outdoor pool. Breakfast will be served there. Lunch and dinners will be served at the college within a block of where the wrestling sessions will be held. The meals are all-you-can-eat buffets.

COACHING STAFF

This year's staff is excellent! Their experience includes wrestling and coaching at both the high school and college level. **They know what it takes to reach the top levels of wrestling** and have produced dozens of All-Americans and state champions in their programs. Several current college wrestlers will be involved to help wrestlers achieve their goals at the camp. There will be a few other college counselors added for this year's camp which are not listed. There will be many opportunities for wrestlers to get help from the college counselors.
