Tournament Guidelines (PLEASE READ!!!)

- * Home team is listed first on the schedule (Utah Valley and Brigham Young will *ALWAYS* be home team on their respective fields)
- * Underlined team occupies first base dugout
- * All games played at Utah Valley's field unless otherwise noted (and played *at BYU*)
- * The official NCAA softball (Worth NC12L) will be used for all games (exception: When two Junior Colleges play, you may use your NJCAA approved ball...the two involved teams must provide the balls for this game ... please work this out with one another)
- * Unlimited substitution is permitted with only the limitations stated below
 - You may pinch-run for the same player more than once. A player used as a pinch-runner may do so **once per inning** and must not be in the current batting order.
 - You may bat as many players as you wish (10, 11, etc) but you must designate the number prior to the game, and it must maintain that number throughout the game.
 - Once a hitter has been placed into the batting order that is the only position in which that hitter may bat.
- * **Games are 7 innings or drop-dead at 2 hours. Coaches can agree prior to game to establish a tiebreaker after seven innings if time allows (DROP-DEAD TIME FIXED)**
- * 10-run rule after five innings, 8-run rule after six innings
- * Lineup must be exchanged between coaches prior to each game
