Texas-Pan American swept this week's independent awards as junior setter Chelsea Blakely (pictured, right) and sophomore libero Rebecca Toddy (left) led the Broncs to a perfect 4-0 mark last week.

Blakely became UTPA's all-time leader in career assists after dishing out her 2,493rd assist in the third match of the Prairie View A&M Tournament.

Blakely was named to the all-tournament team after recorded 180 assists in four matches last week (11.25 avg) as the Broncs won the tournament title.

Blakely dished out 54 assists in a five-set victory over the University of Texas-San Antonio, which was the first time in 27 tries that the Lady Broncs defeated the Roadrunners. She also added 47 assists in UTPA's first-ever victory over the Air Force Academy and collected 45 assists versus Texas Southern and 34 assists versus Prairie View A&M.

Toddy was selected as the Libero of the Tournament at the Prairie View A&M Tournament where she collected 83 digs (5.19 dpg). Toddy set a career-high with 30 digs in UTPA's five-set victory over Air Force and notched 22 digs in the win over The University of Texas at San Antonio.

The weekly Division I independent awards are nominated and voted on by the sports information department at seven independent NCAA schools.
