Utah Valley's Kayli Broadbent and NJIT's Sabrina Baby have been named the Division I Independent offensive and defensive players of the week.

Broadbent had 52 kills (4.73) and hit .344 for the week as Utah Valley went 2-1 with a loss at BYU and two wins at CSU Bakersfield.

In a five-game win at Bakersfield, she set a career high with 26 kills and hit .407 to go along with three aces, one block solo and six block assists, totaling 33.0 points (6.6 ppg).

It's the third straight week that a Utah Valley player has won the offensive player of week award.

In a 1-2 week for the Highlanders, Baby tallied 81 digs (6.75 dpg), 6 service aces and posted double-figure totals in five matches in the digs category.

She reached the 30-dig plateau twice during the week, against Wagner and St. Francis (PA), while notching 21 against UMBC.

The weekly Division I independent awards are nominated and voted on by the sports information department at seven independent NCAA schools.
