## Wolverines Host Nevada in Final Regular Season Match

Utah Valley hosts Nevada Saturday at 1pm in the final regular season match leading up to next week's Division I Independent Championship in Orem. A win Saturday would set the new NCAA school record for wins in a season.

The Wolverines have been off since last Thursday's sweep of in-state rival Utah State. In the match Jessica Endres hit .520 with 15 kills to lead the team to its first ever win over the Aggies.

On Tuesday, Endres was named the Division I Independent Player of the Week for the third time this season.

Endres, the school's career leader in kills and blocks, is one of three seniors that will be recognized before Saturday's match.

"Jessica has meant so much to the program, from day one," said head coach Sam Atoa. "Her athletic ability has really helped propel our program to another level. It's been great coaching her and to see her improve every year that she's been here."

Chelsea Baugh and Terin Ledall are the other seniors that will be recognized.

"It's been great to have Chelsea for four years," said Atoa. Her enthusiasm for the game and her desire to get better has really helped improve her game and has helped us succeed."

Baugh and Endres are both four-year seniors while is in her second season on the court.

"Terin's been a great addition. She's been a delight to work with, a great individual and has fit very well with what we are doing here."

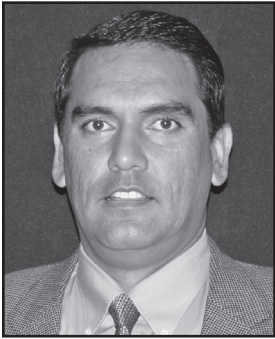

# 2007 Utah Valley Volleyball

## Head Coach Sam Atoa



Sam Atoa enters his 9th year at the helm of the Utah Valley women's volleyball program in 2007. During his tenure, the Wolverines have posted a 212-92 record overall including a 74-61 mark in four NCAA Division I seasons.

Atoa notched his 200th career win at Idaho State on September 22, 2007.

Atoa's spikers finished 17-11 in 2006, following up a school-record 18-11 season and a Division I Independent Tournament Championship in 2005. During that Independent Championship season, UV won 10 of its last 11 matches and Atoa was named the Division I

Independent "Coach of the Year" in 2005.

In 2005 & 2006, Atoa coached the Division I Independent Setter of the Year in 1st year assistant Lacey Koelliker.

In their second season as a Division I program in 2004 the Wolverines finished with an 11-16 record that included wins over Memphis, Central Florida, Montana, Portland State, and Boise State. As well as two wins each over fellow D-I Independent teams: Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Texas-Pan American.

In the first year of D-I competition in 2003, Atoa led the Wolverine volleyball program to a 10-14 record, including wins over D-I opponents Boise State and Pac-10 power Washington State.

Atoa took over the reins of the UV volleyball program in 1999 after six years as an assistant to former head coach Lori Richards. In his first season at the helm of the volleyball program Atoa led the Wolverines to a 32-12 record. In just his second season at the helm, Atoa led the Wolverines to the national tournament and a third place finish in the nation. Atoa was named Tachikara/AVCA Junior College National Coach of the Year and Region 18 Coach of the Year. In 2002, Atoa led the Wolverines to a sixth place finish at nationals.

Atoa played for Brigham Young University from 1984 to 1988, and was named a Collegiate Club All-American.

Atoa has also taught physical education classes at UV and directed the intramural sports program from 1993-2001. He was also the tournament director for the NJCAA national championships in 1997 and 1998.

Atoa was born and raised in Apia, Samoa, and has a rich cultural and athletic background. He is highly honored and respected in his country, having received the Papalii or "Son of the King" title from the Head of State of Samoa, His Highness Malietoa Tanumafili II.

Atoa went to high school at the Church College of Western Samoa, but developed his volleyball skills in church and government leagues, because the school did not have a varsity volleyball program.

After graduating from high school, Atoa went to BYU Hawaii and played for two years at the NAIA level. He earned his way through school by entertaining and dancing at the Polynesian Cultural Center. In 1982, he left for a two-year LDS Church mission to San Jose, California.

Atoa and his wife, Lori, reside in Orem and are the parents of six children: Sam, Bradley, Devri, Andrew, Darci and Saini.

## About the Opposition

Nevada is 14-10 after a four-game lost at Utah State on Thursday night. The Wolf Pack are 10-6 in the WAC. Despite the loss, Nevada is 10-4 in its last 14 matches.

Teal Ericson leads the team with a 4.74 kills per game average.

Nevada has won the only previous match between the two schools, doing so in four games during the 2004 season.

## 2007 Milestones

Utah Valley volleyball has seen three individuals reach big milestones so far this season.

In a win over Northern Illinois in August, Jessica Endres became the first Wolverines at the NCAA level to surpass 1,000 career kills.

Head coach Sam Atoa won his 200th career match in a 3-1 win at Idaho State on September 22nd. Atoa currently has 205 career wins, including 66 at the Division-I level.

Two days after Atoa's 200th, Camie Manwill equalled Endres in reaching 1,000 career kills in a win at Montana State.

## Independent Championship

Utah Valley is hosting the 2007 Independent Championship on November 16-17. The Wolverines, who won the tournament at the end of the 2005 season, placed second in 2006.

CSU Bakersfield, Chicago State, NJIT, Providence, Texas-Pan American and the Wolverines will compete in the two-day event to determine this season's top independent team.

The Wolverines open play in the tournament against Providence on Friday at 1pm and will finish pool play against Texas-Pan American at 6pm.

If UV wins both matches Friday, they will play in Saturday's championship at 6pm.
