Webb now has 843 yards rushing, but he was smothered by the Gators after rushing for 67 yards on 10 carries in the first quarter. Southeastern Conference game for the first time since 2009 in Bobby Johnson's last season.

"I have an idea what I want, but what will happen is I need to take a couple of days and look back," Mason said. "I'm not adding (specifics). As soon as I know, you'll know."
