## DEREK GREENE Vanderbilt Women's Soccer Head Coach

A dynamic recruiter, excellent tactician and passionate leader, Derek Greene officially was named the head coach of the Vanderbilt women's soccer program in November after serving as the team's interim head coach since July.

A 16-year veteran of collegiate women's soccer, Greene's coaching career has been highlighted by success at a number of schools in the southeast. Hired as an assistant coach at Ole Miss before being promoted to associate head coach, Greene recruited four Freshman All-Americans to Oxford. He helped guide the Rebels to their first three NCAA Tournament appearances and seven consecutive SEC Tournament berths. Ole Miss captured a Western Division title in 2005, finishing second overall in the league.

Greene has been in Nashville for the past three years. He came to Vanderbilt as an assistant in 2010 after a one-year stop at Belmont that saw the Bruins win an Atlantic Sun regular season co-championship and advance to the tournament finals.

Greene got his start in coaching nearly 20 years ago with the Knoxville Stars Soccer Club. He developed a team that went from third to second to first in the Tennessee youth soccer ranks over a period of three years, and guided that program to the Region III semifinals.

## SEBASTIAN VECCHIO Vanderbilt Women's Soccer Assistant Coach

Sebastian Vecchio, formerly the goalkeeping coach at Rice and Memphis, joined the women's soccer staff in the spring of 2010.

Vecchio, who mentors goalkeepers and coordinates Vanderbilt's recruiting effort, spent one year at Rice after coaching for four seasons at his alma mater, Memphis. His 2008 Tigers led Conference USA in shutouts while winning a second straight C-USA Tournament and advancing to the NCAA Tournament.

He holds an NSCAA National Goalkeeping Diploma and served as the goalkeeper coach for the ODP Region III team that traveled to Mexico in 2009. A native of Buenos Aires, Vecchio was a member of the Argentinean U-16 National Team prior to his collegiate playing days.

## CHRISTINE BREAUX Vanderbilt Women's Soccer Assistant Coach

Former Ole Miss standout Christine Breaux joined the Vanderbilt women's soccer program as an assistant coach last season.

A 2005 freshman All-American and 2008 All-SEC honoree, Breaux started all 81 matches in her career. A native of Gonzales, La., she earned All-State honors three times and was named the 2004-05 Louisiana Gatorade Player of the Year.

After graduating from Ole Miss in 2009, Breaux joined the Mississippi Teacher Corps. She started the boys soccer program at Byhalia High School in 2010 and earned a master's degree in curriculum and instruction from Ole Miss in 2011.

\* - The Elite Residential Camp is designed to improve the skill level and tactical understanding of all players. Practice sessions will be intense and very competitive to challenge every level of the player's ability.
