The game: High Point University (2-5, 0-1 Big South) hosts Wake Forest (5-3, 0-0 ACC) on Wednesday night, marking the first time a varsity ACC men's basketball team has come to the Millis Center. The Panthers are 2-1 at home and look to get their third win against a Demon Deacon squad that most recently took a 70-62 loss to Richmond in Winston-Salem last Saturday. HPU is coming off a 72-62 loss to league-newcomer Campbell in its Big South opener last Saturday in Buies Creek, N.C. High Point and Wake Forest have met 10 times since HPU started varsity basketball in 1927-28. The Panthers won just one of those 10 matchups, a 19-13 victory in the 1934-35 season. Only three of those games have come in the last half century, a lopsided 79-35 Wake Forest win on Dec. 17, 1999 – High Point's first season in NCAA Div. I – as well as matchups in each of the last two seasons in Winston-Salem. HPU traveled across the Piedmont Triad to face Wake Forest in HPU head coach Scott Cherry's second game on Nov. 18, 2009. The Panthers led late into the first half but the Demon Deacons pulled away after the break and won, 83-60. Last season was another close one, as High Point trailed by just five points late in the second half before Wake Forest pulled away to a 79-63 margin. This will be HPU's ninth game against an ACC opponent since 1999-2000, when the Panthers moved up to NCAA Div. I.

Honoring Tubby Smith: High Point University will honor all-time great Orlando "Tubby" Smith during halftime of Wednesday's game against Wake Forest at the Millis Center. Now the University of Minnesota head coach, Smith scored 1,589 points from 1969-73 and still ranks seventh all-time for the Panthers. He led Kentucky to the 1998 NCAA Championship and is three-time SEC and three-time National Coach of the Year. *See page 4 of the game notes for more information.*

The opponent: Wake Forest is 5-3 entering Wednesday's game, most recently taking a 70-62 loss to Richmond on Dec. 3 in Winston-Salem. Before that, the Demon Deacons knocked off Nebraska, 55-53, in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge. Forward Travis McKie leads Wake Forest with 18.9 points and 5.6 rebounds per game, just ahead of C.J. Harris, who is averaging 18.4 and 3.9 out of the backcourt. It's head coach Jeff Bzdelik's second season after three years at Colorado.

Last time out: Junior forward Corey Law scored a career-high 21 points and tied his career high with 15 rebounds but the

High Point University men's basketball team's shooting went cold in the final minutes and HPU took a 72-62 loss to Campbell last Saturday in Buies Creek, N.C. The Panthers were within a point with under four minutes remaining. Behind Law, senior Nick Barbour scored 15 points and sophomore Xavier Martin scored eight points. Campbell's Darren White led all scorers with 28 points and Trey Freeman scored 15. High Point held Campbell to season lows of 72 points and 46.8 percent shooting.

Barbour passes Tubby: With his 15 points at Campbell on Saturday, Nick Barbour has 1,601 for his career. He moved up to sixth on HPU's all-time scoring list, passing Orlando "Tubby" Smith, who had 1,589 from 1969-73. Barbour is averaging a team-best 16.1 points per game this season and 16.9 in his career. If he leads the Panthers in scoring this year, he will become just the second HPU player to lead the team in scoring all four years since records are available beginning in 1958-59. The only one to accomplish that is all-time leading scorer Gene Little, who scored 2,398 points and averaged 23.2 ppg from 1965-69. Barbour has led the Panthers in scoring 56 times and has scored at least 20 points 35 times in his 95 career games. He ranks second all-time in three-pointers made (229) and attempted (609) and his .376 three-point percentage ranks sixth.

Law gets career highs: Redshirt-junior forward Corey Law scored a career-high 21 points and tied his career high with 15 rebounds at Campbell last Saturday, raising his season averages to 12.9 ppg and 9.7 rpg. His previous scoring high was 17 points against UNC Asheville on Dec. 4, 2010, and he has gotten 15 rebounds four times. The Campbell game was Law's third double-double and fifth double-digit scoring effort of the season. He is averaging 9.1 points and 7.3 rebounds in his 58 games at HPU.

Close losses: High Point's five losses this season have come by an average of 5.8 points and the Panthers were within a point in the final four minutes of four of the five games. At Purdue on Nov. 14, HPU led 62-60 with 2:26 remaining and lost by two. The Panthers' loss to Tennessee Tech on Nov. 22 came in overtime. At Hampton on Nov. 29, Xavier Martin hit a pair of free throws to get High Point within one (65-64) with 14 seconds remaining. Last Saturday at Campbell, High Point was within a point with 3:45 left in the game before taking the loss.

Hosting Div. I opponents: High Point hosts four non-conference Div. I opponents this season – Tennessee Tech, the Citadel, Wake Forest and Wofford. It's the team's most Div. I non-conference home games since 2001-02, when High Point hosted six.

trailed Hampton by as many as 15 in the game and was behind, 60-49, with 3:27 left before going on a 15-5 run to cut the lead to cut it to 65-64, but ended up with a 68-64 loss on the road on Nov. 29. Shay Shine, Nick Barbour and Xavier Martin all hit three-pointers in the final stretch, Hampton's Darrion Pellum (26 points) hit two free throws and Danny Agbelese hit one to seal it for the Pirates. Pellum hit five three-pointers. Shine led HPU with 19 points followed by Barbour's 17 and Martin's 11. Corey Law led the Panthers with eight rebounds.

Shine bounces back to lead HPU: Senior guard Shay Shine left High Point's win over the Citadel with an injury in the second half and didn't practice, but suited up and led the Panthers with 19 points, including 15 in the second half, at Hampton on Nov. 29. Shine shot 6-for-10 from the floor and 3-for-5 from three-point range in the second half. It was the second time Shine led the team in scoring this season and he is averaging 12.9 points, 5.4 rebounds and 2.1 assists. After coming off the bench at Hampton, Shine has started 37 of his 38 games at HPU. He got his first double-double in a High Point uniform at UCF on Nov. 18 with 15 points and 10 rebounds.

Martin scores big again: Sophomore guard Xavier Martin has averaged 13.3 points over the last three games, well above his career mark of 5.4 ppg. He scored a career-high 21 points against the Citadel on Nov. 26, then came back with 11 points – all in the second half – at Hampton three days later. He scored eight points and dished three assists at Campbell last Saturday. He had a career-high six assists against Tennessee Tech on Nov. 22. On the season, he has marks of 8.9 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game.

Panthers top Citadel in OT: High Point played its second overtime game in a row, topping the Citadel 80-72 on Nov. 26 at the Millis Center. Xavier Martin scored a career-high 21 points to lead all scorers and senior Nick Barbour scored 20, including 10 in overtime. Barbour and Martin combined to score all 15 of HPU's overtime points. Junior forward Corey Law scored 13 points and tied his career high with 15 rebounds and sophomore Travis Elliott grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds. The Panthers had led by 10 points in the second half before the Citadel got back into it. The Citadel's Mike Groselle notched his fifth double-double of the season (15 points, 13 rebounds).

Panthers in overtime: High Point is 6-2 in its last eight overtime games after splitting two at the Millis Center this season, a 62-57 loss to Tennessee Tech and an 80-72 win over the Citadel. It was the first time in HPU's Div. I era (since 1999-2000) that the Panthers played consecutive overtime games. The 6-2 record dates back to a 98-93 win at UNC Asheville in the Big South quarterfinals on March 1, 2005. The most overtime games HPU has played in a season is three in 2001-02 and 2004-05.

Mikulic getting starts: Junior Branimir Mikulic started the past three games for High Point after coming off the bench in his first three. He came to

High Point after two years at Santa Fe College in Florida. Mikulic missed the season opener with an injury and made his debut at Purdue, where his hit his first shot – a three-pointer – and went 6-for-6 from the free-throw line. He is averaging 5.2 points and 3.0 rebounds in six games. He has hit at least one three-pointer in all six of his games.

Wallace grabs six boards: Freshman Devante Wallace grabbed a season-high six rebounds in HPU's game at Campbell last Saturday after playing just six minutes against Hampton on Nov. 29. In the game prior, he went 4-for-4 from the floor for eight points along with three blocks in 16 minutes of play against the Citadel on Nov. 26. The eight points were his highest since 14 in the season-opener against Bridgewater. He is averaging 4.7 points on a team-best 59.1 percent shooting.

Purdue edges HPU: High Point led 62-60 with under three minutes remaining but couldn't match shots with the Big Ten's Purdue at the end and took a 67-65 loss on Nov. 14 in West Lafayette, Ind. Senior Nick Barbour led the Panthers with 17 points and senior Shay Shine scored 14 – all in the second half – including a three-pointer that got HPU within two at the end. Barbour had a shot to win it but his three-point attempt rimmed out in the final seconds. Junior guard Jairus Simms scored 10

points on 5-for-7 shooting. The Boilermakers made 13 three-pointers, including eight by the game's high scorer, Ryne Smith (26 points).

•BCS significance: HPU's loss at Purdue was its closes ever to a BCS-level opponent. The previous closest was four points in a 63-59 loss at Auburn on Nov. 16, 2001. The Panthers took Virginia Tech to OT in an eventual 84-75 loss on Dec. 30, 2000.

HPU inks two recruits: High Point inked two recruits to NLI's for next season: forward Cliff Cornish of North County High School (Md.) and wing player Lorenzo Cugini out of St. Vincent-St. Mary (Ohio). Cherry expects to add another recruit soon as well as one in the spring signing period.

•Cornish: Cliff Cornish is 6-foot-8 and 240 pounds, providing a physical presence with skills around the basket and as a shooter. He spent his junior season at St. Paul's School, where he averaged 14 points and 10 rebounds and helped the team to a 20-7 record and a 17-3 mark in the B Conference in 2010-11.

•Cugini: Lorenzo Cugini is a wing but at 6-foot-7 and 215 pounds, can take smaller players inside and score around the basket. He is rated the No. 8 senior from Ohio by ESPN after averaging 14.8 points and 6.5 rebounds as a junior. He led his team to the Ohio Div. II state title and was named tournament Most Outstanding Player.

TUBBY SMITH

High Point University Class of 1973

Wednesday is "Tubby Smith Night" at the Millis Center in honor of 1973 High Point University graduate Orlando "Tubby" Smith, a star player for the Panthers from 1969-73 who went on to become a national champion head coach.

Smith played at High Point University from 1969-73, playing under coach J.D. Barnett his junior year and Jerry Steele his senior year. Barnett later became head coach at Virginia Commonwealth University and hired Smith as his assistant coach, giving Smith his first collegiate coaching job.

Originally from Scotland, Md., Smith was named honorable mention All-American while playing for Great Mills High School. He made an immediate impact for the Panthers, averaging 13.3 points and 5.2 rebounds his freshman year. He began his sophomore year after having surgery on his wrist during the offseason, but still managed 12.6 points per game.

Smith was one of HPU's top scoring threats his junior and senior seasons, averaging 16.4 points on 45.9 percent shooting in 1971-72 and averaging 17.3 points 49.2 percent shooting along with 5.2 rebounds in 1972-73.

Along with his well-known basketball exploits, Smith was an outstanding sprinter for High Point's track & field team and helped HPU to three conference championships. He was a member of HPU's record-setting 440-yard relay team.

Smith went on to become one of the top

college basketball coaches in the nation with head coaching stops at Tulsa (1991-95), Georgia (1995-97) and Kentucky (1997-2007) before being named the University of Minnesota's head coach in 2007.

In his first four seasons at Minnesota, Smith's teams won 80 games – the most of any coach's first four years in the history of Minnesota basketball. Smith's wins at Minnesota include five over top-10 teams, the Gophers' first-ever trip to the Big Ten championship game and consecutive 20-win seasons for the first time in program history. Minnesota is 8-1 this season, most recently getting wins over Virginia Tech and Southern California.

Smith spent 10 highly-successful seasons at Kentucky, leading the Wildcats to the 1998 NCAA Championship, four Elite Eight appearances, six Sweet Sixteen appearances, five SEC regular season titles and five SEC tournament titles. His teams went 263-83, averaging over 26 wins per year.

Smith was named National Coach of the Year and SEC Coach of the Year in 1998, 2003 and 2005. He has sent 19 players to the NBA during his coaching career.

With the honor, Smith joins Steele, HPU's all-time winningest coach, along with all-time leading scorer Gene Littles, career point-per-game leader Danny Sewell and women's all-time leading scorer Karen Curtis McConico as HPU greats with banners in the Millis Center.
