Press Credentials

Media credentials for all Wake Forest home games can be obtained by sending a written request on company letterhead (via email or fax) to Lisa Hunter in the Media Relations Office.

All requests are screened to ensure a working pressbox with priority given to daily newspapers, radio/TV sports directors and other media who cover the Demon Deacons and their opponents on a regular basis.

Guests are not permitted in any working media area. If you wish to bring a guest to any game, contact the media relations office regarding tickets.

Media Will Call Entrance

Credentials will be mailed for all requests received seven days in advance of the specified game. All other credentials should be picked up in the Media Relations office the day before the game, or at the Media Will Call Window no earlier than two and a half hours prior to kickoff.

Temporary Media Entrance

During the construction of Deacon Tower, media should enter Groves Stadium through Gate 2 and enter the pressbox by walking through the west bleachers.

Sideline Regulations

In order to be permitted on the sidelines, photographers must have a credential. Tripods are allowed on the field but must be at least five yards away from the sideline or end line.

No photographers or media personnel are permitted within the team areas (midfield between the 25-yard lines) at any time. Please work from either side

Deacon supporters worldwide can tune in as well to all network broadcasts on the Internet at WakeForestSports.com.

The Wake Forest ISP Sports Network boasts one of the strongest flagship stations in the ACC in WBRF-FM. Based in Galax, VA, the 100,000-watt strength signal (98.1) assures Deacon fans throughout the Triad, western North Carolina, and south-western Virginia complete coverage during the season.

Adding to the network's strong coverage for Wake Forest followers in central and eastern North Carolina, as well as south central Virginia, is a second powerful FM station, 100,000-watt WZTK (FM Talk 101.1) in Burlington.

Calling the action is veteran play-by-play announcer and two-time North Carolina "Sportscaster of the Year" Stan Cotten, now in his 12th season behind the Demon Deacon microphone.

A native of Knoxville, Tenn., Cotten became the "Voice of the Deacs" after serving as play-by-play man at Marshall University and Division II football power Carson-Newman College. He was three times



honored in his home state by the Associated Press Broadcasters' Association prior to moving to Marshall, and more recently was voted 2006 North Carolina Sportscaster of the Year by his peers.

Cotten also serves as host of the popular "Jim Grobe Show," a weekly call-in show on the ISP Sports Network and Internet. The lively hour-long broadcast originates from The Loop Pizza Grill in Winston-Salem every Thursday evening during the season, normally with an enthusiastic crowd of Deacon fans on hand as well.

Joining the Wake Forest ISP Sports Network for a fourth season as color analyst is Bill Urbanik, a veteran assistant coach on both the collegiate and professional levels.

Urbanik served on the Deacon staffs of John Mackovic and Al Groh from 1978-83 before joining the NFL, where he helped the Cincinnati Bengals advance to Super Bowl XXIII. He later coached for the Los Angeles and Oakland Raiders, as well as in the Canadian Football League and the XFL.

A 1970 graduate of Ohio State where he was a three-year letterman under legendary coach Woody Hayes, Urbanik played on the Buckeyes' 1968 national championship team and was a 1969 Academic All-American.

The crew also includes three valuable members in the pressbox and behind the scenes.

Alan York mans the ISP Sports Network studio for game broadcasts, updating listeners on scores around the ACC and nation.

Joining Cotten and Urbanik at the site of each Deacon contest are veteran spotter/statistician Clent Gentry, who has been a second set of eyes for WFU play-by-play men for nearly two decades, and engineer/producer Josh Nixon, who oversees the set-up of equipment and assists with the execution of all segments.

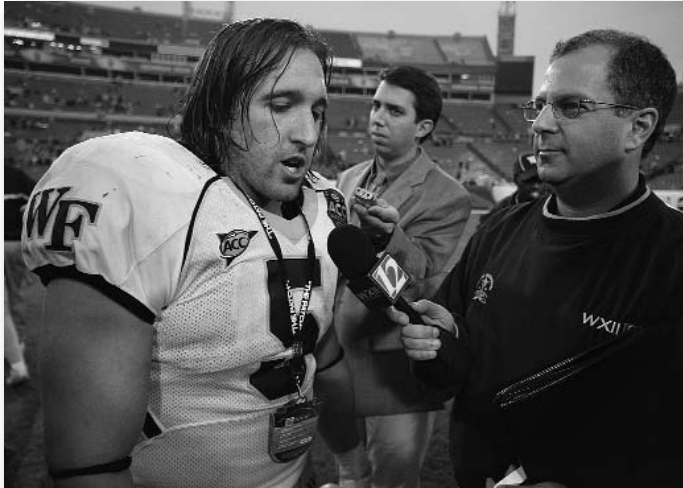
