Men's & Women's Championship Recap

WINSTON-SALEM, N.C. - Petros Chrysochos of Wake Forest and Arianne Hartono of Ole Miss won the NCAA men's and women's singles championships on Monday at the 2018 NCAA Division I Tennis Championships at the Wake Forest Tennis Complex.

Chrysochos, who helped lead Wake Forest to the team national championship on Tuesday, defeated teammate Borna Gojo 6-3, 6-3 on Monday to claim the NCAA men's singles title. Arianne Hartono of Ole Miss defeated Pepperdine's Ashley Lahey in straight sets, 6-4, 6-2 to claim the women's singles title.

LSU's duo of Jessica Golovin/Eden Richardson won the women's doubles national title by defeating Oklahoma State's team of Vladic Babic/Sofia Blanco, 6-3, 6-2.

In men's doubles, UCLA's Martin Redlicki and Evan Zhu won the national title with a 6-7 (8), 7-6 (4), 11-9 victory over Martin Joyce and Mikael Torpegaard of Ohio State.
