## ACC NOTABLES

ACC play continues with seven games on Thursday, Sept. 21 and another seven on Sunday, Sept. 24. Highlighting the next two play dates are a four of Top 25 matchups - No. 19/22 Clemson at No. 8/9 North Carolina and No. 4/5 Duke at RV/18 Notre Dame on Thursday, and No. 24/23 NC State at RV/18 Notre Dame and No. 8/9 North Carolina at No. 11/8 Virginia on Sunday. All four games will be available on the ESPN App.

**.740** - ACC teams have combined for a 73-23-8 mark against non-conference/non-ACC competition through Sunday, Sept. 17. The .740 win percentage is second nationally.

**1** - Florida State, the winner of the last four Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Soccer Championships, was the preseason favorite to win yet another ACC title in a vote of the league's 14 head coaches.

**4** - The ACC has four MAC Hermann Trophy candidates: Florida State's Deyna Castellanos, Natalia Kulkka and Cassie Miller, and North Carolina's Bridgette Andrzejewski.

**4** - Notre Dame sophomore forward Natalie Jacobs, this week's ACC Offensive Player of the Week, played a role in three of Notre Dame's season-high four goals in the Irish's 4-2 win at No. 11/13 Clemson on Sept. 16, finishing the night with a career-high four points (1g, 2a).

**5** - Boston College, Duke, North Carolina, Notre Dame, NC State and Wake Forest all earned wins in the opening weekend of ACC play. Teams will play a 10-game conference schedule this season.

**7** - The ACC has a national best seven women's soccer teams ranked in this week's United Soccer Coaches NCAA Division I Top 25. Duke is ranked No. 4 this week, followed by No. 8 North Carolina, No. 11 Virginia, No. 19 Wake Forest, No. 19 Clemson, No. 23 Florida State and No. 24 NC State. Notre Dame is receiving votes in this week's poll.

**8** - Eight ACC teams are ranked in this week's Soccer America poll - the most of any league: No. 5 Duke, No. 8

Virginia, No. 9 North Carolina, No. 12 Florida State, No. 17 Wake Forest, No. 18 Notre Dame, No. 22 Clemson and No. 23 NC State.

**7** - The ACC owns seven wins over top 25 non-conference opponents, including four over Top 10 teams. (Clemson 2-1 over No. 20/25 Auburn; Duke 4-0 over No. 3/3 West Virginia; Duke 2-1 over No. 21/23 Utah; Notre Dame 3-1 over RV/22 Santa Clara; Virginia 2-1 over No. 1/2 West Virginia; Virginia 3-2 over No. 5/4 Penn State, and Wake Forest 3-2 over No. 3/6 South Carolina.

**8** - The top eight teams in the final regular season conference standings will compete in the 2017 ACC Women's Soccer Championship. The top four seeds will host quarterfinal games on campus sites on Sunday, Oct. 29. The semifinals will be held at MUSC Health Stadium on Friday, Nov. 3, while the title game will be played on Sunday, Nov. 5.

**8** - Duke senior forward Imani Dorsey has tallied a point in eight of the Blue Devils' nine matches and has scored a goal in seven matches this season. She owns 16 points on seven goals and two assists.

**10** - NC State goalkeeper Sydney Wooten, this week's ACC Defensive Player of the Week, posted back-to-back shutouts and totaled 10 saves on the weekend, including a season-high six in a double overtime draw against No. 5/3 Virginia.

**36** - North Carolina broke Florida State's 36-home game unbeaten streak with its 1-0 victory in Tallahassee on Sept. 17.

**43** - Duke ended West Virginia's streak of 43-straight home games without a loss in regulation with a 4-0 victory in Morgantown on Sept. 8.

**400** - Florida State head coach Mark Krikorian is two wins shy of his 400th career victory. When he reaches the 400-win plateau, he will be one of eight active NCAA D1 head coaches with at least 400 wins and one of 16 in NCAA women's soccer history (all-divisions). Krikorian has a career record of 398-100-32.

## 2017 @ACCWSoccer Preseason Poll and All-ACC Team

Florida State, the winner of the last four Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Soccer Championships, is preseason favorite to win yet another ACC title in a vote of the league's 14 head coaches.

The Seminoles received eight first-place votes and 186 points, followed by North Carolina (two first-place votes, 172 points), Duke (one first-place vote, 170 points), Virginia (two first-place votes, 160 points) and Notre Dame (one first place vote, 145 points).

Clemson placed sixth in the voting followed by NC State, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest. Boston College placed 10th followed by Miami, Louisville, Syracuse and Pitt.

The Seminoles lead the 2017 Preseason All-ACC Team with four selections among the 11 members, including returning first-team NSCAA All-American Cassie Miller. In addition to Miller, the preseason All-ACC Team features two more returning NSCAA All-Americans in teammate Natalia Kuikka and North Carolina's Bridgette Andrzejewski.

The 2017 season will feature unprecedented digital and television coverage for ACC women's soccer. 111 games will be broadcast, including 104 that will be exclusively carried on ACC Network Extra, a dedicated digital channel for ACC sports. The events covered by ACC Network Extra are available to users who have access to WatchESPN and the ESPN app. The coverage continues the initial phase of the full ACC Network announced in July 2016 by ESPN and the Atlantic Coast Conference. Live streaming of Olympic sports is expected to increase annually. More than 1,500 total events involving at least one ACC school were live-streamed during 2016-17.
