ACC NOTABLES

ACC play continues with seven games on Thursday, Oct. 5 and another seven on Sunday, Oct. 8. Highlighting the next two play dates are a pair of Top 25 matchups Sunday – No. 16/6 Florida State at No. 4/4 Duke and No. 5/3 North Carolina at No. 15/16 Wake Forest. All 14 games this week will be available on the ESPN App.

.740 - ACC teams have combined for a 73-23-8 mark against non-conference/non-ACC competition. The .740 win percentage is second nationally.

.917 – Duke, at 11-1-0, owns the nation's fourth-best win percentage (.917).

1 - Virginia's Veronica Latsko was named the United Soccer Coaches National Player of the Week. She is the first ACC player this season to earn the honor.

2 – Duke and North Carolina, both 4-0-0, are the only two unbeaten teams in league play entering the weekend.

3 – North Carolina's Joanna Boyle earned her first career hat trick in the Tar Heels' 7-0 win over Syracuse. She is one of five ACC players to record a hat trick this season.

4 – Florida State's Deyna Castellanos ranks fourth in NCAA Division I in goals per game (1.00), tied for fourth in total goals (10) and fifth in points per game (2.20).

3 – Florida State's Deyna Castellanos is up for the 2017 Best FIFA Women's Player award. She is one of three finalists, along with Carli Lloyd and Lieke Martens, for FIFA's top individual women's honor. She spent her freshman year splitting time between Florida State and the Venezuelan national team, competing in the FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup. She scored five goals in seven games at the World Cup and set the all-time record for scoring in the FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup with 11 goals.

4 - The ACC has four MAC Hermann Trophy candidates: Florida State's Deyna Castellanos, Natalia Kulkka and Cassie Miller, and North Carolina's Bridgette Andrzejewski.

5 - The ACC has five women's soccer teams ranked in this week's United Soccer Coaches and Soccer America – tied for the most nationally. Duke is ranked No. 4/4 this week, followed by No. 5/3 North Carolina, No. 13/12 Virginia, No. 15/16 Wake Forest, No. 16/6 Florida State. Notre Dame, Clemson and NC State are receiving votes in this week's United Soccer Coaches poll.

7 – The ACC owns seven wins over top 25 non-conference opponents, including four over Top 10 teams. (Clemson 2-1 over No. 20/25 Auburn; Duke 4-0 over No. 3/3 West Virginia; Duke 2-1 over No. 21/23 Utah; Notre Dame 3-1 over RV/22 Santa Clara; Virginia 2-1 over No. 1/2 West Virginia; Virginia 3-2 over No. 5/4 Penn State, and Wake Forest 3-2 over No. 3/6 South Carolina).

8 – The top eight teams in the final regular season conference standings will compete in the 2017 ACC Women's Soccer Championship. The top four seeds will host quarterfinal games on campus sites on Sunday, Oct. 29. The semifinals will be held at MUSC Health Stadium in Charleston, South Carolina, on Friday, Nov. 3, while the title game will be played on Sunday, Nov. 5.

8 – ACC Offensive Player of the Week Veronica Latsko of Virginia tied the single-game record at Virginia for points in a match with eight, matching the mark hit twice previously by Makenzy Doniak in 2014 and 2015, in the Cavaliers' 7-0 win at Pitt. She scored three goals and added two assists for her first hat trick of the season. She is one of five ACC players to record a hat trick this season.

11 – Virginia Tech goalie Mandy McGlynn made a career-high 11 saves and earned her fifth shutout of the season in a 0-0 double-overtime draw with Boston College. Her 11 saves also rank tied for second on this season's ACC's single-game saves lists, and she stands second in the league with 54 saves this season.

2017 @ACCWSoccer Preseason Poll and All-ACC Team

Florida State, the winner of the last four Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Soccer Championships, is preseason favorite to win yet another ACC title in a vote of the league's 14 head coaches.

The Seminoles received eight first-place votes and 186 points, followed by North Carolina (two first-place votes, 172 points), Duke (one first-place vote, 170 points), Virginia (two first-place votes, 160 points) and Notre Dame (one first place vote, 145 points).

Clemson placed sixth in the voting followed by NC State, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest. Boston College placed 10th followed by Miami, Louisville, Syracuse and Pitt.

The Seminoles lead the 2017 Preseason All-ACC Team with four selections among the 11 members, including returning first-team NSCAA All-American Cassie Miller. In addition to Miller, the preseason All-ACC Team features two more returning NSCAA All-Americans in teammate Natalia Kuikka and North Carolina's Bridgette Andrzejewski.

The 2017 season will feature unprecedented digital and television coverage for ACC women's soccer. 111 games will be broadcast, including 104 that will be exclusively carried on ACC Network Extra, a dedicated digital channel for ACC sports. The events covered by ACC Network Extra are available to users who have access to WatchESPN and the ESPN app. The coverage continues the initial phase of the full ACC Network announced in July 2016 by ESPN and the Atlantic Coast Conference. Live streaming of Olympic sports is expected to increase annually. More than 1,500 total events involving at least one ACC school were live-streamed during 2016-17.
