PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

Parking is available in lot E-1 for \$2.75 per game and lots E-10, E-11, and E-12 for \$8 per game. You must enter lot E-1 from the north side (near the golf driving range). For public transportation information call Metro at 206-553-3000.

Biking

Consider bicycling to the game and avoid parking and traffic hassles. A five-mile commute takes approximately 25-30 minutes. The Burke-Gilman trail, which extends from Bothell to Ballard, passes directly by Husky Stadium. Extend your commute by bringing your bike on the bus.
