

## 2003 UW Softball Summer Camps

UW head coach Teresa Wilson and the Huskies have set an unprecedented standard in 10 short years and would like to help shape the next generation of potential Huskies. You, too, can take your game to the next level by attending one or more of the following summer camps.

\* If attendance is exceedingly high on the first day, a morning session will be added on the second and third days to keep the camper-to-coach ratio low and instruction level high. Please keep the 9 a.m. - noon time slot available as well if possible.

\*\* Must have attended a minimum of six previous UW camps.

Players attending a UW Summer Camp will receive first-rate instruction from not only current and former Huskies, but also other clinicians and college coaches from around the country. As always, we will maintain our high camper-to-coach ratio.

### Pitching Camp

UW head coach **Teresa Wilson**, who has coached Husky pitchers to nine All-America certificates and 20 All-Pac-10 awards, will oversee the Pitching Camp. She will help develop young pitchers by putting them in a more consistent body position at release that will allow for more success at home plate. Coach Wilson will be assisted by current and former Husky pitchers who have gone through the same successful transition themselves and received national recognition because of it. *Each pitcher must provide her own catcher (at no additional charge) and her own ball.*

### Offense/Defense Camp

The offensive portion of this camp reflects UW's never-ending search for the ultimate offense. New UW assistant coach **Steve Dailey**, an accomplished baseball player and leading authority on hitting, is now the driving force behind the Husky offense. His approach takes our current philosophy to the next level and beyond. Instruction will include fundamentals of hitting, slapping and the short game. *Each hitter must provide her own bat.*

The defensive portion of the camp will be addressed by UW assistant coach **Scott Centala**, who annually guides the Husky defense to a national ranking in fielding percentage. Coach Centala, a former professional baseball player, will focus on infield and outfield play, in addition to conducting a session on overhand throwing. Coach Wilson will oversee the catchers during defense sessions. *Catchers must provide their own gear.* Both current and former Husky players, some of whom are current high school and collegiate coaches, will assist at this camp, providing an excellent camper-to-coach ratio.

### Elite Camp

This dynamic camp will be an accelerated and will cater to an intense level of instruction. The pace will be fast, and the information will be in-depth. Only campers who have attended a minimum of six previous camps will be able to attend.

### General Camp Information

- Campers will be grouped according to age and ability, ensure each camper will receive the proper amount and type of instruction. The camps also are progressive, with each day's information building upon the previous day's. For these reasons, each camper must remain in the same groups each day of camp.
- Please bring your own gear and wear appropriate attire for game situations and sliding.
- Camp confirmations will be mailed out by **July 1, 2003**, any following confirmations will be by email.
