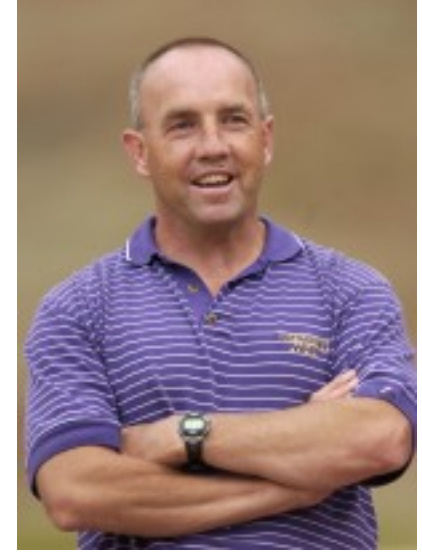

Director/Assistant Coach Brandy Venable

The 2007 Western Carolina Track & Field Camp will be directed by Coach Brandy Venable. Coach Venable begins her fifth year as assistant coach and has been responsible for the field and multi events for the Catamounts. While at Western Carolina she has coached 47 All-Conference performers, 19 Southern Conference champions, ten NCAA East Regional Qualifiers, four school record holders, and two Southern Conference Record holders

Prior to coming to Western, Venable coached 31 NJCAA All-American performances while at Odessa Junior College in Odessa, TX. She enjoyed a successful collegiate career at Purdue University where she was an All Big Ten performer in the Heptathlon and Javelin. She was previously named the Mississippi Track Athlete of the Year and is currently USATF Level II Jumps certified.

"Developing a strong technical base is the goal of our camp. Different athletes are at different skill levels and we factor that in to our sessions. We look forward to having fun while introducing more athletes to Western's new state-of-the-art facility."

Assistant Coach—Jesse Norman

Coach Norman has been responsible for coaching the distance runners, specializing with the 3-10k athletes for the Catamounts. Prior to coming to WCU, Coach Norman was the Head Cross Country Coach at Robbinsville High School where he had the first cross country state qualifier in school history. He has worked with some individual athletes who have run under 9:40 for the two mile. One of those athletes has been an All State runner five times. He enjoyed a successful career at WCU where he was an All-Conference performer in the 10k and the individual cross country champion in 2001.
