Camp Director Head Coach Larry Hunter



The Larry Hunter Basketball Camps are directed by Western Carolina men's basketball head coach, Larry Hunter, whose teams have posted winning records in 27 of his 37 seasons as a head coach with 15 of those seasons having 20-plus wins. Coach Hunter has an overall record of 689-434 which currently ranks him as the 9th winningest active coach in the country.

During his time as a head coach, Hunter has made 11 NCAA tournament appearances, while making seven as an assistant coach. Coach Hunter came to Western Carolina after four years as an assistant coach at North Carolina State, the final three serving as associate head coach guiding the Wolfpack to the Atlantic Coast Conference championship game and multiple NCAA Tournament appearances.

Hunter spent 12 years (1989-2001) as head coach at Ohio University prior to his stint in Raleigh. He led Ohio to a 25-8 record and was tabbed the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year. The Bobcats won the preseason National Invitation Tournament, went 24-10 and reached the second round of the post-season NIT.

From 1976-89, Hunter was the head coach at Wittenberg University, playing a key role in the school being the winningest NCAA Division III basketball program in the country posting a 305-76 record and four NCAA Division III Final four appearances. Coach Hunter was awarded with the National Association of Basketball Coaches National Coach of the Year honors in 1977 after becoming the first coach in NCAA history to win a national championship in his first season at a school.

Hunter is nationally recognized as teacher of the game.

"I look forward to having a great session of camp, filled with skill development and fun competition," noted Coach Hunter.
