**Larry Hunter**  
**Catamount Head Basketball Coach (4th Season at Western Carolina)**  
**Ohio, 1971 (29th Year as a Head Coach)**

Larry Hunter, one of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) leaders in coaching victories, was named Western Carolina University's 17th head men's basketball coach all time on April 29, 2005. His impact was felt immediately. Known for his offensive prowess, Hunter brought an up-tempo offense

to Cullowhee and the Catamounts responded by making a school-record 221 3-pointers, while tying or setting the single-game school record for 3-pointers made in a game on six occasions. WCU again surpassed the school benchmark for treys with 226 made 3-pointers last season.

Hunter, whose teams posted winning records in 23 of his 28 seasons as a head coach, boasts an overall record of 543-282 and currently ranks as the 12th winningest active coach in the country. He additionally ranks 58th on the NCAA Division I all-time head coaching victories list and is 97th on the NCAA all-division list for head coaching victories. During his time as a head coach, Hunter has made 11 overall NCAA tournament appearances, while making seven as an assistant coach.

While his first year at Western was just his third losing season as a head coach, posting a 13-17 mark, Hunter's inaugural season with the Catamounts saw many positives. Western nearly doubled its win total from the previous season. Also, its 7-7 record and third place finish in the SoCon North was its best in the league since posting the same record for the 1996-97 season, while placing second that season. Key wins in his first season included: a win over Bowling Green in the season opener — WCU's first season opening win over an NCAA Division I team since defeating Georgia Tech to start the 1980-81 season; a win over Chattanooga — snapping an eight-game losing streak to the Mocs; a win at Davidson — snapping Davidson's 19-game home winning streak which was the third longest in the NCAA at the time; and defeating SoCon North Champion Elon late in the season — setting up a battle for a first-round bye at the league tournament.

Western has rewritten the school record books under Hunter. The Catamounts have set school records for 3-pointers made (237 in 2007-08); attempted (699 in 2006-07) and 3's per game (7.65 in 07-08) in a season, as well as making at least 12, 3-pointers nine times, including a school-record 15 treys on three different occasions.

Hunter came to Western Carolina after four years as an assistant coach at North Carolina State, the final three serving as associate head coach. In his first season at N.C. State (2002), the Wolfpack reached the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) championship game and received their first NCAA Championship bid since 1991. N.C. State would go on to reach at least the ACC Tournament semifinals in each the last three years as well as receiving bids to the NCAA Championship. In 2004, Hunter coached Julius Hodge, who was tabbed ACC Player of the Year and consensus All-America. This past season, the Wolfpack made an impressive run at season's end and defeated defending NCAA Champion Connecticut to reach the Sweet 16. N.C. State was just one of 21 teams in the nation to play in the NCAA Championship in each of the last four years.

Hunter spent 12 years (1989-2001) as head coach at Ohio University prior to his stint in Raleigh. Five years after taking over the Bobcat basketball program (1993-94), he led Ohio to a 25-8 record and was tabbed the Mid-American Conference (MAC) Coach of the Year, winning both the league's regular season and tournament titles. The following year, the Bobcats won the preseason National Invitation Tournament (NIT), went 24-10 and reached the second round of the postseason NIT. At Ohio, he coached 16 All-MAC performers and four first-team Academic All-MAC selections. Among those standout players were Player of the Year honorees Dave Jamerson (1990), Gary Trent (1993, '94 and '95) and Brandon Hunter (2003). Trent additionally earned MAC Freshman of the Year honors in 1993, duplicating the feat of Rush Floyd in 1991 during his freshman campaign with the Bobcats.

Jamerson set a MAC record with 874 points in 1990 while taking home first team Academic All-America honors that season. Later in 1990, Jamerson was an National Basketball Association (NBA) first round selection (15th pick overall) by Miami. Trent, a third team Associated Press All-America in 1995,

would leave Ohio after his junior season to become a NBA first round selection (11th overall pick) of the Milwaukee Bucks. Brandon Hunter also moved on to play professionally, being an NBA second-round pick in 2003 and currently playing for the Orlando Magic. Jamerson (third with 2,336), Trent (seventh with 2,108) and Brandon Hunter (11th with 2,012) all rank among the MAC's top 11 in scoring, while Brandon Hunter and Trent rank fifth (1,103) and ninth (1,050), respectively, on the MAC's career rebounding list.

Thirty of the 38 players he coached at Ohio who completed their eligibility there graduated, including 12 who went on to earn their Master's degrees, posting an overall graduation rate as a head coach of 85 percent. In his last season at Ohio, the Bobcats were 19-11, with a 12-6 mark in MAC competition, and his overall record with the Bobcats was 204-148.

After winning his 500th career game as a collegiate head coach (Jan. 23, 2001), Hunter said, "My approach has been simple: Arrive early, work late and chop wood all day long. I've been fortunate to be surrounded by some great people and I've worked at two great institutions, Wittenberg and Ohio. Add all those things together over 20 years and you start to have a small pile of wood."

From 1976-89, Hunter was the head coach at Wittenberg University, playing a key role in the school being the winningest NCAA Division III basketball program in terms of victories and percentage. Hunter made an immediate impact after taking over the helm, winning National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) National Coach of the Year honors in 1977 after becoming the first coach in NCAA history to win a national championship in his first season at a school. During his 13 years in that position, his team turned in a 305-76 record and made four NCAA Division III Final Four appearances (national title in 1977, national runner-up in 1983 and third place in 1980 and 1987).

He coached three national players of the year at Wittenberg, including Tyrone Curtis (1981), Tim Casey (1985) and Brad Baldrige (1991), as well as having 21 all-conference honors bestowed upon his players. In addition to coaching those national players of the year, four of Wittenberg's top five career scorers were coached by Hunter, including the school's all-time leader Steve Iannarino (1,973). Hunter won a total of 12 Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) titles, six regular-season championships and six tournament championships. For his success, Hunter was inducted into the Wittenberg University Hall of Honor in 1996 and received the school's Honorary Alumnus Award in 1997.

Hunter, who got his start in coaching as an assistant coach at Marietta College from 1971-73, graduated from Ohio in 1971 with a B.S. in Education, majoring Social Studies Comprehensive. He earned his Master of Science in Physical Education from Ohio in 1973, then spent three seasons (1973-76) as an assistant coach at Wittenberg. He got his first taste of postseason play while serving on the Wittenberg staff, reaching the NCAA Division III championship game in 1976.

In addition to his coaching resume, Hunter produced a basketball instructional video, "Drills, Skills and Moves: Post Play Moves & Drills."

Hunter is married to the former Mary Kay Friedrich of London, Ohio.

**Brandon Giles**  
**6-6, 200, Junior, Guard**  
**Auburndale, Fla. – Auburndale HS**

**Notes:** Enters the 2008-09 season continuing to boast a career-best 18-game double-digit scoring streak in games he has played ... Has scored 612 points entering his junior year, just 388 shy of 1,000 for his career.

**2007-08 (Sophomore):** Played in 27 games on the season, starting 26 before missing the final four games of the season due to injuries sustained in an automobile crash ... Led the team in scoring with a 15.3 point per game average to **rank fourth in the SoCon** ... His scoring average jumped to 18.1 in league games only, also good enough for fourth-best ... Posted 22 double-digit scoring efforts for WCU, leading the team in scoring 14 times during the year ... Either tied for or led the team in rebounding on five occasions ... Averaged 1.85 3-pointers per game to rank 13th in the league ... Was named **All-Southern Conference by the league's head coaches and second team All-Southern Conference by the SoCon Sports Media Association** ... Led Western with 14 points on 6-of-12 shooting in a loss at Elon ... Posted his first collegiate game with 20+ points by shooting a sizzling 14-of-18 for a career-best 32 points at home against the College of Charleston ... Came off the bench to lead WCU in scoring at Illinois with 13 points, the lone Catamount in double-figures ... Again led WCU in scoring with 25 points at #37 NC State, playing a career-high 33 minutes ... Scored a game-high 21 points including a career-best five 3-pointers in the home win over Furman ... Paced the Catamounts with 23 points in a career-high 36 minutes at home against Davidson ... Finished with 24 points while tying his career-high in minutes played with 36 at Wofford ... Saw his three-game, 20-point scoring string snapped with 17 points against Georgia Southern ... Scored 18 of his 22 points in the first half at Georgia Southern ... Recorded his third-straight 20-point game with 25 in the victory over College of Charleston, also adding a career-high four steals in a career-best-tying 37 minutes ... Was injured in an automobile accident when the car in which he was a passenger was struck on N.C. Hwy 107 in Cullowhee.

**2006-07 (Freshman):** Started 20 of the 30 games he appeared in as a true freshman ... Was in the starting lineup the first four games for Western – including starting his first-ever collegiate game – before coming off the bench at Wofford and Xavier ... Tallied his first career point by making the second of two free throws at the 8:14 mark in his second career game against Purdue ... His first career field goal was a 3-pointer a minute later ... Scored 12 points on 5-of-6 shooting from the field against Rice ... The point total was only his second in double figures on the season and his most versus an NCAA DI opponent ... Scored a season-high 19 points, making 8-of-11 shots versus Atlanta Christian ... Had a season-high seven rebounds versus Toccoa Falls ... Dished out five assists and had two steals at Wofford ... In his second SoCon game, helped WCU dish out 23 assists with three of his own ... Scored seven and boarded a team-high tying seven rebounds in the road win at UTC ... Dished out a career-best six assists in the road loss at Appalachian State while also scoring seven points ... Scored his Southern Conference high of 10 points on 4-of-8 shooting in the road loss at Furman ... Contributed nine points while grabbing five rebounds in win versus Georgia Southern ... Ended the season averaging 6.6 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 1.4 assists per game.



**Jake Robinson**  
**6-8, 210, Junior, Forward**  
**Canton, N.C. – Pisgah HS**

**Notes:** Was the Catamounts' first signee from Western North Carolina since West Henderson's Joey Bryson, who played at Western in 1996, '98-99 ... Enters his junior season already ranked eighth on both the career 3-pointers made (134) and career 3-pointers attempted (352) charts ... Is just eight made treys shy of moving into seventh place and six 3-point attempts shy of advancing.

**2007-08 (Sophomore):** Played in all 31 games for WCU making 15 starts ... Ranked second on the team – and 24th in the SoCon – with a 10.6 point per game average ... Scored in double figures 18 times, leading the team in scoring six times including four-straight to conclude the season ... Led the team with by shooting 87-percent from the free throw line ... Finished with 70 made 3-pointers, the fifth-best, single-season in school history ... Was a perfect 4-for-4 from 3-point range to score 12 points at Cincinnati ... Hit a game-high six 3-pointers to lead the Catamounts with a season-high 19 points against UNC Asheville ... Tied his seasonal high with 19 points two additional times in back-to-back contests at Appalachian State and UNC Greensboro in the last week of the regular season ... Made his first start of the season at Elon making one 3-pointer for three points in a season-high 30 minutes of court time ... Hit consecutive 3-pointers to close WCU to within nine points early in the second half at Illinois ... Returned to double-digit scoring for the first time in six games with 11 in the home win over Presbyterian ... Recorded his sixth double-digit scoring effort of the season against Davidson, going 5-8 from the field, including 3-5 from three-point range, scoring 13 points ... Finished with 15 points including three 3-pointers and a pair of two-handed slams inside the final minute in the home win over Elon ... Fouled out for the first time in his collegiate career at Wofford ... Pulled down a career-high nine rebounds in the victory over Chattanooga, to go along with his 10 points, including three clutch free throws in the final seconds to clinch the win ... Scored a team-high 16 points against UNC Greensboro on 5-10 shooting ... Led the Catamounts with 17 points including three made 3-pointers in the home win over Wofford.

**2006-07 (Freshman):** Appeared in 31 games as a true freshman, making eight starts ... Ended the year fourth on the team in scoring at 8.9 points per game, while shooting a team-high 40.5 percent from behind the three-point arc ... Also led the team in free-throw shooting with an impressive 91.7 percent clip at the line ... Ranked seventh in the SoCon in 3-point field goal percentage (40.5%) and 10th in 3-point field goals made (64, 2.06 per game) ... His 64 made 3-pointers as a freshman ranked tied for seventh on the single-season charts tied with Casey Rogers (1998-99 season) and David Donerlson (1988-89 season) ... Was named to the Southern Conference All-Freshman team ... In his collegiate debut, sank 4-of-8 from long range in a win at UNC Asheville ... In Western's record-tying effort of making 15 treys versus Atlanta Christian, was 5-of-8 from beyond the arc ... Over a two-game span (versus Toccoa Falls and at Wofford), was 11-of-13 from 3-point range ... First, sank 5-of-6 3-pointers in WCU's win over Toccoa Falls, a game WCU made 10 treys on the night as a team ... Two nights later, drained 6-of-7 from beyond the arc as WCU once again connected on 10 treys as a team ... At Wofford, was 3-of-3 from long range in the first half ... Earned his first career start at #22 Clemson shooting 3-of-10 from the field, including 1-of-6 from 3-point range, scoring nine points and grab five rebounds ... Led Western with 13 points in the loss at South Carolina, hitting on 5-of-7 shots including 3-of-5 from downtown ... Went 5-of-8 from beyond the arc, matching his career-high with 20 points, including two clutch 3's late in the game to give WCU the overtime win against Wofford, boarding a career-high eight rebounds against the Terriers ... Posted career-highs in points scored (24), 3-point fields made, (7) and 3-point attempts (16) in a home loss to Chattanooga.
