



Fan Code of Conduct

It is the policy of Western Carolina University that all Fans at athletic sporting events must maintain the highest degree of credibility and decorum possible. All fans must make every attempt to conduct themselves in a manner as not to embarrass the institutions by their actions. Behavior by fans that does not meet this standard and which has the potential of harming the reputation of the institution or any of its units is prohibited.

Good sportsmanship must be an integral part of every sport sponsored by WCU. The ethical environment of the university must assert and reflect primacy of human dignity, must encourage growth and achievement, and must insist on respect in all interpersonal relations.

WCU students and fans must be held accountable for their use of profane and vulgar language, banners, posters, signs, flags, treatment of opponents, and treatment of officials. In respect to NCAA policies, WCU is held accountable for the actions of their fans.

Ticket Office

The ticket office inside the Ramsey Center is open Monday - Friday from 9:00am - 4:30pm. On game days the ticket windows at the stadium open 2 hours prior to kickoff.

Tickets can also be purchased at any time online at catamountsports.com. During regular office hours tickets can be purchased over the phone at 800-34-GOWCU.

Children ages 3-17 need a ticket for admission.

There are no refunds, no exchanges on ticket sales.

Will Call

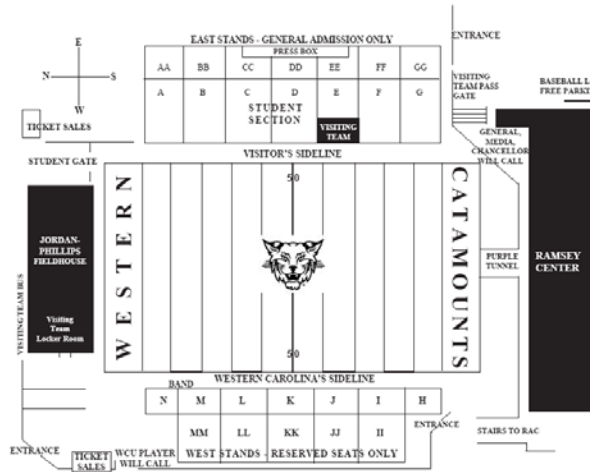
Ticket orders that are placed ten days or more in advance of the game are mailed. Tickets placed within the ten days prior to the game will be left at Will Call to be picked up. Will Call is located at the NW Entrance and opens 2 hours prior to kickoff on game day.

Photo identification is required to pick up tickets left at Will Call. Only the ticket holder may pick up the tickets at Will Call. Second hand Will Call will be accepted on game day, but Western Carolina University is in no way responsible for lost or misplaced second hand Will Call and any such orders will not be replaced or refunded.

Stadium Rules & Policies

All parcels, bags and alike are subject to inspection upon entry into E.J. Whitmire Stadium. All alcoholic beverages and other items not permitted in the stadium must be discarded prior to entering the stadium.

Alcoholic beverages, containers/coolers, and umbrellas are strictly prohibited inside the stadium.

No one is allowed on the playing field without proper credentials. Fans will be ejected for throwing any objects in the stadium.

There is a no re-admittance policy at E.J. Whitmire Stadium.

Concession Stands

Concession stands are located on the main concourse on both sides of the stadium serving Coke products, Papa's Pizza, hotdogs and many other snacks.

Merchandise

Merchandise stands are located on the main concourse on both sides of the stadium. Merchandise is also available anytime online at catamountsports.com.

Emergency Services

Local physicians are in attendance at all WCU football games and can be paged through the public address system in the press box.

An oxygen-equipped ambulance is in the stadium near the Jordan-Phillips Field House scoreboard during the games.

Also, a staffed First-Aid station is located on the east side of the stadium.
