# THE BATTLE FOR THE OLD MOUNTAIN JUG

The Old Mountain Jug, the trophy in the Western Carolina-Appalachian State football rivalry, will be up for grabs for the 29th time in the 69-game rivalry on November 13 with kickoff is set for 2:00 pm at WCU's Whitmire Stadium.

The idea for the trophy was the brainchild of the rival schools' sports information offices and student government presidents and it was awarded for the first time following the 1976 meeting between the Catamounts and Mountaineers, a 24-17 Appalachian State home victory. Western Carolina returned the favor with a 44-14 home win of its own the following season. App State reclaimed "The Jug" in 1978 and kept it for three consecutive seasons before relinquishing it after the 1981 game. The win was the first of four consecutive victories in the series. "The Jug" was taken back to Boone in 1985 after the Mountaineers' win in Cullowhee and ASU kept it until 1997. The Cats ended a 13-game losing streak to the Mountaineers in 1998 with a 23-6 decision over the fifth-ranked Mountaineers in Cullowhee before a FoxSports Net television broadcast. ASU regained the jug in 1999 and had retained possession to date.

The Western-App rivalry began in 1932 and ASU dominated the series through its first three decades by winning 21 of the first 24 meetings. The Catamounts held their own in the '60s and won six of the games played in the '70s. After winning four of the first five games in the '80s, Western has seen the Apps regain their edge.

"Sports Illustrated" once called the WCU-ASU series "the best football rivalry you've never heard of."

In 1994, one of the meetings with playoff implications, a WCU home record crowd of over 15,000 overflowed E.J. Whitmire Stadium/Bob Waters Field to witness the game between a pair of nationally ranked teams, which ASU won, 12-7. While App State has won five straight in the series, each of the last four meetings have been decided by 10 points or less.
