WESTERN CAROLINA VS CHATTANOOGA



THE SERIES

Tonight marks the 52nd all-time meeting between the Catamounts and the Lady Mocs. Chattanooga does own a 44-7 advantage in the series, but are not unbeatable on their home court. Three of the Cats' seven victories over UTC have come on the road, including a 73-69 thriller last season in Chattanooga. Yoneko Allen and Christy Blackwell combined to hit five of six free throws down the stretch to seal the win, while Tiffany Hamm led WCU with 17 points and 10 rebounds.

In the teams' most recent contest, Chattanooga claimed a 76-53 win over Western in Cullowhee on Jan. 10th. The Mocs outrebounded Western Carolina 52-32 and the Cats were never able to recover from a 10 point deficit at the half as Katie Galloway led the field with 18 points and five assists. Christy Blackwell was the only Catamount to score in double figures with 10 points, adding three assists and two steals.

ON THE CATAMOUNTS

Western Carolina is riding its second three-game winning streak of the season after defeating Georgia Southern on the road and then Davidson and College of Charleston at home to complete the season sweep of the two later teams. Coincidentally, the Cats took down Charleston earlier in January to give the team its first three-game win streak of the year.

Western has excelled at the free throw line in the last two games, shooting 96.3 and 83.3 percent, respectively, after struggling in the previous few games.

HEAD COACH BETH DUNKENBERGER

When head coach Beth Dunkenberger began her tenure at Western Carolina University, she had one goal in mind - to win. And win, she has.

The Catamounts came up with huge wins during the 2002-03 season, including a 73-69 victory over Chattanooga on the road, a 58-56 victory over Furman at home, sweeping College of Charleston and clinching second place in the SoCon heading into the league tournament with a 64-54 win over UNC Greensboro. Dunkenberger's efforts earned her Southern Conference Coach of the Year honors last year as the Catamounts finished the season with a 21-7 record, the program's best showing since 1977-78 before WCU even became a Division I program. It was the first time a WCU women's basketball coach had received the recognition.

In just three years at the helm, her teams have produced two consecutive winning seasons and an overall record of 51-33. In Dunkenberger's first season (2000-01), the Cats posted a 13-15 record, marking the program's most wins in 12 seasons. She backed that up with a 17-11 scoresheet the following year. Dunkenberger reached 50 wins faster than any other head coach in the program's history.

Dunkenberger is quick to note that a championship team is made up of championship people. Her perspective regarding recruiting emphasizes not only finding talented student-athletes, but also recruiting quality people as well. She points out that one or two star players will not bring home a championship trophy, rather depth and a team full of unselfish players will have the Catamounts climbing a ladder to cut down the championship net.

Dunkenberger was formally introduced as WCU's head women's basketball coach on Wednesday, April 19, 2000. The former assistant coach at the University of Florida served as recruiting coordinator during her last season with the Lady Gators. Her other responsibilities included scouting, scheduling, camp direc-

tor, and the development of both post and guard players.

During Dunkenberger's three-year tenure as an assistant coach at the University of Florida, she helped the Gators to a 63-36 overall record. The Lady Gators advanced to post-season play all three years with the 1997-98 team making an appearance in the Sweet Sixteen. While in Gainesville, Dunkenberger had the opportunity to help coach five players who are currently, or were previously, on rosters in the WNBA. Murriel Page received Kodak All-America honors and was drafted in the first round by the Washington Mystics where she has been a five-year starter. Tonya Messaline of the Seattle Storm just completed her third year in the league and Tamara Stocks competed with Washington as well during the 2000 season. Guard Tiffany Travis played for the Charlotte Sting for one season and spent the 2001 season on the injured reserve roster. Guard Brandi McCain spent the 2002 season with the Cleveland Rockers.

Prior to her appointment at Florida, Dunkenberger was an assistant at Virginia Tech where she helped lead the Hokies to the 1994 and 1995 NCAA Tournament, the first two appearances in school history. She not only helped lead Tech to two NCAA Tournaments, but also to the Metro Conference Tournament Championship in 1994 and the Metro Conference Regular Season Championship in 1995. Dunkenberger was responsible for signing the first Parade All-American in the school's history.

Dunkenberger was valedictorian at Shawsville High School and graduated cum laude from Randolph-Macon College with a Bachelor of Science degree in mathematics in 1988. She was named Academic All-District as well as All-Conference. She continued her education by earning a Master of Science degree in Sport Management at Virginia Tech in 1990. Beth also served as the commencement speaker at both her high school and her undergraduate graduation ceremonies. A native of Shawsville, Va., she is the daughter of Tom and Rebecca Dunkenberger.

The team currently ranks third in the SoCon at the line, shooting 71.7 percent for the season. The Catamounts are led by senior Tiffany Hamm who is averaging 15.8 ppg, good for third in the league, and 8.3 rpg, also third in the conference. She additionally ranks 13th in field goal percentage (.434), 14th in free throw percentage (.763) and second in defensive boards (6.21/gm). Other Catamounts among the SoCon ranks include junior Jennifer Gardner, senior Christy Blackwell and senior Yoneko Allen.

ON THE MOCS

Chattanooga extended its winning streak to 16 games after back-to-back road wins in the last week, which set a school record and ties for the longest running streak in the nation. The Mocs lead the SoCon in seven statistical categories, including scoring margin, averaging 13.8 more points per game than their opponents. The squad is led by Katasha Brown who is ranked second in the league with 15.9 ppg and third in field goal percentage, shooting 53.3 percent from the field. She also leads the SoCon with a 48.9 3-point field goal percentage on the season.

THE WATCH LIST

Senior Yoneko Allen is now WCU's all-time leader in career 3-point field goals made with 151 to date. She is also Western's all-time leader in 3-point attempts after the Charleston game on Jan. 3rd, now with 465. Allen has additionally shot .325 percent from downtown in her career, which would qualify her for fourth place on that career list. At her current pace, the senior would put herself in a tie for third for career free throw percentage, currently shooting .748 percent from the line.

Senior Christy Blackwell is now Western's career steals leader with 249 to date. She

also stands in fourth place with 344 assists. Also on the career assists list is junior Ki-Ki Glass with 229, good for seventh place currently.

Last season's SoCon Player of the Year Tiffany Hamm has moved into WCU's top ten for career scoring, now with 1,249 points (8th-t), and rebounding, now with 637, good for ninth place. She additionally stands in sixth place on Western's list for career field goals, now with 477 makes, as well as ninth in field goal attempts, now with 1,054. At her current pace, she would place herself in second for career free throw percentage, currently shooting .768 from the charity stripe. Hamm could also qualify for a spot on the career 3-point field goal percentage list (.351).

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

Tonight's game between the Western Carolina Catamounts and the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga Lady Mocs can be seen live from Chattanooga on College

Sports Television (CSTV) at 7:00 pm. This game will mark the first ever national television network exposure for Southern Conference Women's Basketball. CSTV is offered through Direct TV as well as through select cable companies such as Adelphia and Insight.

HAMM SETS THE STANDARD

Tiffany Hamm has already tied a career-high 28 points three times this season and continues to put up the points for Western. She has now tallied double figures in scoring in 63 of her 97 career games played and currently leads the SoCon in double-doubles with seven on the season.

DEUCES WILD

On Dec. 22nd, the Catamounts were seeing double. Not only was it WCU's second, much needed win of the season, its second road win of the season, its second conference game of the season, but also the second consecutive year that the Cats

have defeated Davidson on the road. It additionally ended the Wildcats' two-game win streak over the Catamounts. Add to the irony the fact that Western was down by two points at halftime and came back to outscore the Wildcats by double figures (10 points) in the second half, and it was the makings of doubly exciting game.

GARDNER BREAKS CAREER MARK

Gardner really turned up her game against Wofford (Dec. 30th) when the Norcross, Ga., native posted a career-high 24 points and a career-tying 14 rebounds to lead the field. More recently, she notched 23 points and 10 rebounds versus Davidson on Jan. 27th and followed that up with another 24-point, 14-rebound performance versus C of C on the 31st. She is currently ranked sixth in the league in rebounding, 13th in scoring, seventh in field goal percentage, 11th in free throw percentage, third in offensive rebounds and 10th in defensive boards. Gardner has also recorded six double-doubles this season to tie for second in the SoCon.

SECOND TIME AROUND

The Catamounts' game against Georgia Southern on Jan. 24th marked the beginning of the second half of the Southern Conference season for Western Carolina, with the exception of not having played Appalachian State yet. Due to a schedule change, the Cats and Mountaineers will meet twice in February. WCU is now a perfect 3-0 to start the second round of SoCon action.

BLACKWELL TOPPING THE CHARTS

In Western Carolina's win at Georgia Southern on Jan. 24th, Catamount senior Christy Blackwell grabbed a game-high four steals to put herself in a tie for first on WCU's career steals list. After recording three takeaways versus Davidson on Jan. 27th, Blackwell became WCU's outright all-time leader, now with 249 career steals.

A NEW BEGINNING

WCU's contest versus Davidson Jan. 27th marked the first game in which the Catamounts were able to wear their new white uniforms. The team had been wearing their purple road jerseys for both home and away games, but will now be able to close out the 2003-04 season in their new rags. The team is now 2-0 in their new jerseys.

SEASON SWEEPS

Western's win over Davidson at home

Jan. 27th gave the Catamounts the season sweep of the Wildcats for the first time since doing so during the 2000-01 season. Western also completed the season sweep of College of Charleston Saturday (Jan. 31st), doing so for the second straight year.

BENCH REPORT

Three Catamounts have been sidelined for the remainder of the 2003-04 season due to injury. Junior Shaketia Barnes suffered a torn ACL and lateral meniscus during a practice the week of the Georgia Southern game on Jan. 24th. Surgery has been tentatively set for Feb. 9th in Sylva, N.C. The 5-9 guard appeared in 12 games this season, amassing 35 points and 12 rebounds, adding six steals and one block. In one of her best games of the season, Barnes sparked a 12-0 comeback run by Western to bring the Cats within four points of Clemson in the second half.

Also out for the season is sophomore Teyawna Hardy who sustained a fractured fifth metatarsal (foot bone), which has plagued her since the start of her career. Hardy appeared in her first career game against Wofford on Dec. 30th after just being medically cleared to play. With one minute left in the game, the 5-11 guard sank a jumper in her first career attempt and drew the foul, connecting on the free throw for the three-point play.

The third Catamount is junior Summer Thagard who also fractured her fifth metatarsal. A cast has been set and the need for surgery is yet to be determined. The 6-3 center appeared in five games this season, grabbing two rebounds during that span.

BLACKWELL HEAD OF THE CLASS

Senior Christy Blackwell was named the SoCon's TIAA-CREF Student-Athlete of the Week for Jan. 28th after leading the Catamounts to two conference wins for the week. She started with 11 points, six assists and four steals in a 65-57 win at Georgia Southern and followed that up with nine points, seven rebounds, six assists and three steals in the Catamounts' 75-70 win over Davidson. With the first steal in the victory, she became Western's outright all-time leader in the category. Blackwell currently holds a 3.71 GPA in Business Administration & Law and is an Arthur Ashe, Jr., Sports Scholar.

GARDNER HONORED BY SOCON

Junior forward Jennifer Gardner was selected as the SoCon's Player of the Week for Feb. 3rd, the second such honor in her career. Gardner led the Catamounts to two conference wins last week, averaging 23.5
