Western Carolina women's basketball team will play its 17th season in the Liston B. Ramsey Regional Activity Center this year.

The team had the distinction of playing the first official basketball game in the Ramsey Center when they hosted Mars Hill College on December 4, 1986. The inaugural men's/women's doubleheader in the Ramsey Center followed two days later, December 6, when WCU's women hosted Coastal Carolina before the men's team hosted North Carolina State. The event attracted a standing-room-only crowd of 8,114.

The Ramsey Center was completed in April 1986 and is the largest facility of its type west of Charlotte, N.C. It contains 205,000 square feet of usable space and was built at a cost of \$16.3 million.

In addition to housing the athletics department's administrative offices, coaches' offices, team locker rooms, and meeting facilities, it also contains an auxiliary gymnasium, handball and racquetball courts, a communications cen-

ter, a firing range and weight rooms.

The Ramsey Center was designed to accommodate cultural, entertainment, recreational, and athletic events and can seat up to 8,556 for major concerts. During its first 11 years of operation, nearly 1.5 million people attended activities in the facility. The past several years have demonstrated the facility's flexibility as it has hosted a rodeo, numerous theatrical performances, a Broadway musical, graduation ceremonies, Mountain Heritage Day festivities, and musical concerts from such contemporary acts as Jars of Clay, Blessed Union of Souls, Tracy Byrd, Terri Clark, Aerosmith, Tim McGraw, and the Allman Brothers Band while providing WCU's volleyball and men's and women's basketball teams with practice facilities.

The building was named for Liston B. Ramsey, former Speaker of the North Carolina House of Representatives and longtime representative of the 52nd House District that includes Haywood, Madison, Swain, Graham and Jackson counties.
