THE SERIES: Western Carolina leads the all-time series, 17-11 ... The Catamounts are 9-3 versus the Eagles in Cullowhee, but are 2-3 since moving into the Ramsey Center (one home match since moving to Ramsey in 1999 was played in Reid, a 3-1 victory in 1999) ... Georgia Southern has won the past five meetings with the Catamounts, its longest winning streak in the series history ... WCU rattled off 11-consecutive victories over GSU from 1996-2000 ... In Southern Conference tournament games, Western is 1-2 versus Georgia Southern, with the most recent meeting coming last season in the first round, a 3-2 GSU win ... Western head coach Angell Benson, who played for WCU from 1989-92, held a 3-0 record versus Georgia Southern as a player, winning nine of the 12 games played in those matches ... Benson is currently looking for her first victory over the Eagles as a head coach, winless in four attempts.

CATAMOUNTS IN THE SOCON TOURNEY: Western Carolina has won three Southern Conference volleyball championships (1983, '85, '86) and has finished as the runner-up on five occasions (1984, '88, '89, '97, '98) ... WCU has also claimed at least a share of four SoCon regular season championships (1983, '85, '86, and '89) ... the Catamounts have an 18-18 record in the tournament, but have lost in the first round each of the past three seasons ... WCU is 7-8 all-time in first round, or quarterfinal, match-ups.

EAGLES IN THE SOCON TOURNEY: Georgia Southern is the defending Southern Conference tournament champions, defeating the College of Charleston in Chattanooga, Tenn., last year to win the title after posting three-straight five-game wins ... the Eagles have appeared in each of the past three SoCon title games, winning two crowns ... Since 1992, GSU has a tournament record of 12-7, but has gone 8-1 since 2001.

DROPPING BACK: Western Carolina raced out to a 2-0 lead on the North Division-leading Appalachian State, but the Mountaineers rallied to win three-consecutive games to take the match, 3-2 (30-27, 30-26, 24-30, 20-30, 5-15) on Senior Day last Sunday in Cullowhee. The Catamounts were led by freshman Meredith Harmon, who tallied a career-high 15 kills on 34 attacks, while only committing five errors for a .294 attack percentage. Harmon added one solo block as the Catamounts out-blocked ASU, who entered the match leading the SoCon in blocks, 13-5. Senior Stefanie Peters recorded a double-double with 14 kills and 12 assists in her final regular season collegiate match. Her counterpart, Layna Stoetzel, finished with three kills, five assists, and a solo block.

ANGELL BENSON WCU HEAD COACH

Angell Benson, a Waynesville native and WCU alum, is completing her third year at Western Carolina after serving as the head coach at Gardner-Webb University for the six seasons prior to her return to Cullowhee.

Personal Data: Was born Angell Robeson Kirkpatrick on May 5, 1971 ... Married husband, Sam Benson ... She has one son, Jett Harding, born June 25, 2004.

Education: Graduated from Tuscola High School in Waynesville ... Earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from Western Carolina in 1993 ... Earned a Master of Arts in Education degree from Western Carolina in 1997.

Playing Experience: Was a four-year volleyball player while at Western ... Her freshman year was the last time WCU won a Southern Conference Championship ... While at Tuscola High School in Waynesville, led the Mountaineers to a North Carolina Class 4-A state championship as a senior in 1988.

Coaching Experience: Spent six years at Gardner-Webb, overseeing the transition from a Division II program to Division I ... led the Bulldogs to a 166-69 overall record from 1996-2001, coaching her squad to a South Atlantic Championship in 1997 with a 31-7 record and in 1999 with a 42-4 mark ... was named Coach of the Year both in 1997 and 1999 ... In three seasons with her alma mater, Western has compiled a 50-44 record, which includes a 22-12 mark her inaugural season ... the Catamounts have recorded tournament victories in the Catamount Clash (2002, '03), Union State Bank/Samford tournament, and the Campbell Volleyball Classic (2004) ... Prior to moving to Boiling Springs, Benson was a graduate assistant at Western.

Sophomore Heather Koontz joined Peters in recording a double-double, finishing with 11 kills and 11 digs. Junior Ellie Talbot led the Cats defensively, finishing with 25 digs.

CATAMOUNT GAME NOTES:

TALBOT AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: After having several different Catamounts grace the leader boards among conference foes this season, Western finishes the season with only one on the SoCon's leader lists. Junior libero **Ellie Talbot** continues to rank among the SoCon's best in digs. The Evanston, Ill. native ranks ninth in the category with 391 digs in 101 games, an average of 3.87 digs per game. Talbot has recorded WCU's top five dig performances this season, including 25 in the season finale versus Appalachian State, one dig shy of tying her career-high.

DEJA "TWO": The Southern Conference realigned itself in 2003, forming a north and south division, thus altering the seeding for the season-ending tourney. For the second-time in two years, WCU and GSU will battle as the three-seed from the north and two-seed from the south. The Eagles defeated the Cats last year, 3-2, en route to winning the SoCon tournament title. In the brief history of the two-tiered seeding system, no lower seed has upset a higher seed in the quarterfinal round.

HOME SWEET HOME: Since 1999, the Western Carolina Catamount volleyball team has compiled a 47-19 (.712) overall record in the friendly confines of the Liston B. Ramsey Regional Activity Center. In the Cullowhee Valley - between both the Ramsey Center and historic Reid Gymnasium - the Catamounts hold an all-time record of 158-71 (.690). On three separate occasions, the Southern

Conference volleyball tournament has been held in Cullowhee. Of those three times, WCU holds a 3-3 record: 1984, lost in finals (1-1); 1990, lost in semifinals (1-1); and in 1999 lost in semifinals in the only other SoCon Championship held in the Ramsey Center (1-1).

MIDSEASON HARMON-Y: Prior to October 19th of this season, freshman Meredith Harmon had only reached double-figures in kills in one match -- 10 versus The Citadel on October 10. However, starting in mid-October, Harmon has been on a tear, reaching double figures in kills in the final eight matches of the regular season. The Villa Hills, Ky. native recorded a career-high 15 in the regular season finale versus arch rival, Appalachian State, and even spent time among the league's leaders in hitting percentage.

"PARANA" ROLL: Freshman Melissa Parana is having a good freshman campaign. She currently holds four of the top-five hitting matches for the Catamounts, including a career-high .595 percentage at Gardner Webb in a match she also tallied a career high 23 kills. She has tallied one error or less on two occasions. The Raleigh, N.C. native also holds the five of the Cats' top 10 blocking performances this season, including seven blocks twice to tie for second on the season-best. Parana leads the team in blocks and ranks third in kills this season.

CLOSE CALLS: Of Western's 27 matches this season, 11 have needed the fifth game to decide the winner ... The Catamounts went 6-5 in five-game matches ... In the four-game loss to Georgia Southern earlier this year, the Cats took the Eagles to the brink in each game -- WCU dropped three of the four games by an average of 2.7 points, including a 33-31 tally in game four.

NOTING THE TOURNAMENT: In the previous 21 Southern Conference championships, the tournament has been won by either the overall number one or number two seeds 18 different times, which includes Georgia Southern's victory last year -- the Eagles entered the championship as the second seed from the south, but their record was the second-best in the league during the regular season ... the lowest seed to ever win the SoCon tourney was fifth-seeded Chattanooga in 1987 ... in Western's three championships, the Catamounts were the top seed twice (1983, '85) and second-seed once (1986) ... coincidentally, the Cats enter this year's tournament tied with Furman for the fifth-best overall regular season record.

POSSIBLE SECOND ROUND MATCH-UPS FOR WCU: If Western Carolina defeats Georgia Southern, it will face either the north division's top seed, Appalachian State, or the south's fourth-seed, Davidson at 2:00 on Saturday afternoon ... this year, Western was swept by Appalachian, 3-0, 3-2 ... the Catamounts and Wildcats only met once during the regular season, a 3-2 WCU road victory.

Cullowhee, N.C. - Western Carolina battled hard, winning game three to force a fourth, but Georgia Southern proved too much as the Eagles continued their dominance at home, beating the Catamounts 3-1 (27-30, 27-30, 30-28, 31-33) Friday night. The victory extended Georgia Southern's home-court winning streak to 28 consecutive matches, while also maintaining the Eagles' hold of first place in the Southern Conference's South Division.

Western (8-13, 4-6 SoCon) had four players register double-digit kills, led by sophomore Kellyn Thaut with 21, while freshman **Meredith Harmon** totaled a career-high 12 kills and a .429 percentage. Georgia Southern (14-5, 9-1 SoCon) earned the victory without the services of leading hitter Lullia Porumbescu, who sat out nursing a sore back, and instead counted on a quintet of players with double-digit kills. Senior Janice Pressley led the way with 13 kills and a .417 attack percentage, while freshman Bailey Coleman added 13 kills and 12 digs.

In the opening game, the two clubs fought hard early on, building a 9-9 tie at one stretch, only to see the Eagles jump out on a 6-1 tear. The Catamounts were able to bring the Eagle lead within two points at various occasions, but could not inch any further, as Georgia Southern won by a 30-27 margin.

The second game saw Western Carolina build their lead to as much as five points, 23-18, only to see the Eagles tie the score at 27-27 and clinch the game 30-27 following three Kristen Kasprak kills. The Catamounts did not sit idle in game three, however, overcoming a .051 attack percentage to put Georgia Southern away 30-28 and continuing the match.

Game four saw the initial edge go to the Eagles, who built a 27-21 lead late in the action. Following a Catamount timeout, the momentum turned the way of Western Carolina, who scored the next six points, tying the score at 27-27. The Eagles and Catamounts continued to trade point for point before Georgia Southern was able to eke out a 33-31 win off a **Melissa Parana** attack error and Kasprak kill.

In addition to Thaut and Harmon, senior **Stefanie Peters** and freshman Parana each totaled 10 kills, with Peters recording Western's only double-double, finishing with 16 digs. **Kate Willard** paced the Catamount setters with 29 assists, adding five digs, while junior **Ellie Talbot** led the Cats' defensively with a match-high 21 digs.
