## COLORADO COLLEGE, MINNESOTA STATE SKATE TO WCHA HOME-ICE VICTORIES FEB. 8; TIGERS UP LEAD TO FOUR POINTS; SIX TEAMS SEPARATED BY SIX POINTS

### MAVERICKS CONTINUE SECOND-HALF SURGE, MOVE INTO SHARE OF FOURTH PLACE; UW TIES AT MTU; UM TIES AT DU; WCHA'S NON-CONFERENCE MARK AT 46-17-10 (.699); 2008 RED BARON™ WCHA FINAL FIVE TICKET PACKAGES CONTINUE ON SALE

MADISON, Wisc. – League-leading Colorado College and on-coming Minnesota State both registered Western Collegiate Hockey Association victories on Friday (Feb. 8) night, with the No. 4-ranked Tigers downing visiting St. Cloud State, 5-3, and the host Mavericks upending Alaska Anchorage, 3-1.

As a result, Colorado College (21-7-1, 16-4-1 WCHA), standing 9-1-1 over the last 11 games, expanded their advantage in the race for the regular season conference championship and MacNaughton Cup to four points over second place and idle North Dakota and to eight points over third place Denver. No. 15-ranked Minnesota State (14-10-4, 8-9-4 WCHA), meanwhile, won for the fifth straight time in league play to move into a share of fourth place.

In the two other WCHA series being contested this weekend, both Friday night encounters – No. 11/12-ranked Wisconsin at Michigan Tech and No. 20-ranked Minnesota (12-12-7, 6-10-5 WCHA) at No. 7 ranked Denver (18-8-1, 12-6-1 WCHA) – ended in 1-1 overtime ties. The one point enable the Badgers to remain in a share of fourth place, Michigan Tech and Minnesota to stay in the hunt, and Denver to move within four points of second.

At the Colorado Springs World Arena on Friday night, CC left winger Scott McCulloch notched a three-goal hat trick, including the eventual game-winner on a shorthanded effort at 0:24 of period two, to power the host Tigers over St. Cloud State (11-13-3, 6-11-2 WCHA) before a crowd 6,527. Colorado College, which improved to a perfect 14-0-0 on home this season, also received a pair of assists from defenseman Nate Prosser and 18 saves from goaltender Richard Bachman while the Huskies were led by a two-goal, one-assist effort by right

winger Ryan Lasch and 26 stops from Jase Weslosky.

At Alltel Center in Mankato on Feb. 8, host Minnesota State had a goal and an assist from center Trevor Bruess and the game-winner from left winger Joel Hanson at 15:01 of the second period enroute to a 3-1 triumph over Alaska Anchorage (7-13-7, 3-13-5 WCHA) before a crowd of 4,010. The Mavericks, one of the WCHA's hottest teams of late, connected on 2-of-4 power-play chances and also had 20 saves from Mike Zacharias. For UAA, left winger Josh Lunden opened the game with a goal at 4:22 of the first while Jon Olthuis stopped 18 of 21 shots on goal.

At Magness Arena on Friday evening, a sellout crowd of 6,076 saw the host Denver Pioneers (18-8-1, 12-6-1 WCHA) and Minnesota (12-12-7, 6-10-5 WCHA) play to a 1-1 overtime draw, with the Golden Gophers receiving a third period game-tying tally from defenseman R.J. Anderson at 8:59. For DU, enter Tyler Bozak netted a shorthanded goal at 11:04 period two while between the pipes, Peter Mannino had 34 saves for DU and Alex Kangas had 25 for UM.

And at the John MacInnes Student Ice Arena in Houghton on Friday, a Winter Carnival crowd of 3,883 saw visiting Wisconsin (12-11-6, 8-9-4 WCHA) receive a game-tying third period goal from center Kyle Turris at 9:55 that enabled them to forge a 1-1 WCHA tie with host Michigan Tech (10-12-5, 6-9-4 WCHA). The Huskies took a 1-0 lead midway through the second on left winger Bennett Royer's goal at 9:06. In goal, Michael-Lee Teslak had 22 saves for Tech while Shane Connelly had 19 stops for the UW.

Heading into Saturday night's four league re-matches, Colorado College holds a four-point lead over No. 3-ranked North Dakota (17-8-2, 14-7-1 WCHA) and the Tigers also have one game in hand. Denver is third with 25 points (19 gp), Minnesota State (21 gp) and Wisconsin (21 gp) share fourth with 20 points each, idle and No. 10-ranked Minnesota Duluth (11-9-6, 7-8-5 WCHA) is sixth with 19 points in 20 games, Minnesota (21 gp) is seventh with 17 points, Michigan Tech (19 gp) is eighth with 16 points, St. Cloud State (19 gp) is ninth with 14 points, and Alaska Anchorage (21 gp) is 10th with 11.

Looking ahead to next weekend (Feb. 15-16), there will be four WCHA series contested North Dakota hosts Denver, Minnesota State heads to Wisconsin, Michigan Tech entertains Minnesota Duluth, and St. Cloud State travels to Alaska Anchorage. Colorado College and Minnesota will be idle.
