

# West Coast Conference Cross Country

## MEN'S HISTORY

The West Coast Conference has sponsored a WCC Men's Cross Country Championship since 1975, and it has been a storied championship for the University of Portland. The Pilots have won the WCC title for 32 consecutive years, the longest active streak for any cross country program in the country. The 2010 WCC Championships proved to be the closest ever as Portland totaled 36 points, narrowly edging out San Francisco's score of 43. Portland senior Craig Hopkins took home the individual title, crossing the finish line in 25:01, just two seconds ahead of San Francisco freshman Jose Madera. In 2009, the Pilots won both the team and individual titles as sophomore All-American Alfred Kipchumba set a course record at Crystal Springs with an 8K time of 24:20, breaking former Pilot Joe Driscoll's record of 24:53. The 2008 WCC Championship saw Portland edge out Loyola Marymount by just 10 points. Portland's David Kinsella took home the WCC individual title, finishing the course in 25:11. That same year, the Pilot men went on to tie a school record with a seventh place finish at the NCAA Championships, with Kinsella finishing fourth individually to set a school record. Since 1979, Portland has secured every individual title with the exception of 2007, when San Francisco senior Cheyne Inman closed out his career with a time of 25:20, just five seconds ahead of runner-up Zuber Ahmed of Portland.

In Championship history, Portland has swept the top five positions nine times, including five straight years from 1995 to 1999. Gonzaga's Joe Miller broke up a Portland sweep of the top five in 2006, taking second behind individual champion Mike Quackenbush. San Diego's Antonio Lopez finished second to Portland's Ryan Craigin 2000, marking the highest finish by a non-Portland runner since 1989. In 2004, Portland was once again impressive as six Pilots finished in the top 10, led by individual winner Nick Schuetze. The win was the second WCC individual championship for Schuetze in his Portland career after claiming the title in 2001. Portland's Brett Carter, the 2003 individual champion, finished in second place, just two seconds behind Schuetze.

In 1999, Pilots Joe Driscoll and Bryan Bothwell each surpassed the men's 8K course record, with Driscoll beating Bothwell by one second to win the overall title in 24:53. The old record of 24:56 had been set by UP's Todd Davis only one year earlier. The 1985 Santa Clara Broncos squad had five runners in the top ten, including Rory O'Flaherty at No. 3, but Brent Felt and John Bursell finished 1-2 for the Pilots to defeat Santa Clara by the second-slimmest margin in WCC history, 11 points (26-37). In 1986, Bronco runners O'Flaherty and Bill Quirk finished in the top five, but Felt and the Pilots again finished first, winning 27-48. Nevada-Reno is the only other squad to win the West Coast Athletic Conference (WCAC) Cross Country Championships--taking four straight from 1975-1978.

## WOMEN'S HISTORY

The WCC Women's Cross Country Championship began in 1985, and the Portland's women's team, like their male counterparts, have also dominated this event. The Pilots have won 19 of the last 24 titles, including 11 of the last 15. The 2009 WCC Championship brought a new champion to the stage, as the San Francisco Dons picked up their first ever title in program history, winning by a margin of seven points over second place Loyola Marymount. Santa Clara also had its first ever WCC Individual Champion in senior All-American Stephanie Wilson, who completed the 6K Crystal Springs course in 20:32 and tied the WCC course record previously set by Portland's Dana Morgan in 2007. The Dons repeated the accomplishment in 2010, defeating second-place Portland 38-71. LMU junior Tara Erdmann set a course record with a time of 20:21.

In 2008, the WCC Championship mirrored the men's event with the race being the closest finish since 1991 with Portland barely edging out Loyola Marymount by five points. The Lions took home the individual title with Tara Erdmann finishing in 21:54. The Pilot women went on to set a school record with a fifth place finish at the West Regionals, just short of a berth to the 2008 NCAA Championships. In 2007, the Pilots reclaimed the top spot with previous year's Freshman of the Year Dana Morgan leading the way finishing first in 20:32, with Mickelson falling to second, and Pilot Sifrah Ademe rounding out the top three. The 2006 Championships saw LMU junior Laura Mickelson steal the top spot from the Pilots, finishing 1:18 ahead of Portland's Sifrah Ademe, the largest margin of victory in WCC history, while Portland captured the team and individual title in 2005.

In 2004, Portland captured its 15th WCC crown, landing six runners in the top 10. Portland's Amie Dahnke claimed the individual title with a time of 17:40, the second fastest time recorded at the WCC Championships. San Francisco posted its second runner-up finish in three years in 2006, thanks to five top 15 individual finishes. San Diego's Tiffanie Marley took home the individual crown in 2003, becoming the first Torero to capture the title. After finishing in second place in 2001 to Santa Clara, Portland reclaimed the women's title in 2002, with four runners finishing in the top 10. Allegra Porter of Saint Mary's won the women's race with a time of 17:42, the then-second fastest time ever recorded at the WCC Women's Cross Country Championships.

Santa Clara earned its first WCC Cross Country Championship in 2001, stunning Portland by a slim 46 points to 63 points and ending the Pilots' streak of five straight titles. Paced by freshman Robin Bell who captured third place, the Broncos claimed five of the top fifteen spots. Though LMU finished in seventh place in 2001, junior Edit Pakay took home the individual title with a time of 17:58, the all-time fastest championship pace set by an LMU runner. In 2000, Pilot Nicole Ricci claimed the individual championship by beating teammate Alyson Barrett to the line by 39 seconds. It was the fourth-largest individual victory margin in the history of the women's race.

The 1987 Pilot squad set a WCC scoring record of 18 points, a feat which has yet to be surpassed. Saint Mary's captured its only championship in 1990, narrowly defeating Portland 55-59 behind individual winner Anne Wedum, who crossed the finish line with a time of 18:33. Portland and Saint Mary's ran neck-and-neck in 1991, with the Pilots capturing the title by two points, 43-45, the slimmest margin in WCC history. The Pilots then reeled off three more championships through 1994, with an average victory margin of 51 points in each of those three years. Nicole Karr surpassed the 8 year-old course record in 17:43 to lead the Pilots in 1994. In 1995, Gonzaga placed 4 of the top 7 runners to win the championship, followed by a rugged Saint Mary's squad which placed 4 of the top 10 runners. Gonzaga sophomore Cheska Fairbanks set a new course and championships record in 1996 at 17:26, but Portland regained the championship title.

Former WCC member US International took the first two championships in 1985 and 1986. In 1986, Nevada-Reno's Patty Young set a Crystal Springs Women's 5K course record at 17:47 that stood until 1994.
