QUICK HITS

★ At 11-0 in the WCC and winners of a dozen straight, Saint Mary's is ranked No. 13 in the ESPN/USA Today coaches poll and 16th in the A.P. Top 25. The Gaels look for their second straight win at Gonzaga on Thursday night (8p PT, ESPN2).

★ In this week's RPI Report from the NCAA, Saint Mary's ranks 23rd nationally among 344 Division I schools. Gonzaga is No. 26, and BYU is ranked 41st. The RPI is an important factor in helping select at-large bids for the 68-team NCAA Tournament in March.

★ Most major prognosticators have the West Coast Conference as a three-bid league to this year's NCAA Tournament, if the field were selected today.

★ Following BYU's win at Virginia Tech, the WCC has a 72-44 (.621) non-conference record this season. In 2010-11, the WCC non-conference winning percentage was .554.

★ Only eight Division I teams have won at least 25 games in each of the last four seasons. Three of those teams (BYU, Gonzaga, Saint Mary's) call the WCC home.

★ The WCC's weekly web video show, "The Road to Las Vegas," airs on WCCsports.com on Wednesday. Also that night an all-new episode of *WCC Live*, the popular Internet talk show airs live. Find "Watch" and "Listen" links on WCCsports.com.

Fulfilling High Expectations

With the addition of BYU, how strong is the West Coast Conference in men's basketball? Only eight Division I programs have compiled 25 or more wins in each of the last four seasons. Three of those programs (BYU, Gonzaga, Saint Mary's) now reside in the WCC.

National Respect

National writers have taken notice of the WCC's hardwood success. Jeff Goodman of CBSports.com ranked the WCC as the seventh-best conference nationally (Oct. 25). In addition, Eamonn Brennan of ESPN.com called the West Coast Conference the second best non-BCS conference in the land (Nov. 9). CBSsports.com's Jeff Borzello expects the WCC to be a three-bid league (Nov. 28).

West Coast Conference, ESPN Announce Eight-Year Extension

The West Coast Conference and ESPN announced an eight-year contract extension in June that will make the ESPN networks the conference's men's basketball national television home through the 2018-19 school year. According to the agreement, the WCC will receive a minimum of 48 annual men's basketball appearances on the ESPN networks from the 2011-12 through the 2018-19 seasons. This year, no fewer than 30 WCC games will be televised on the ESPN Networks.

Nearly 80% of WCC Conference Games to Be Televised

Nearly 80 percent of this year's conference games (57 of 72) will be televised on a national, regional, or local level. Seventeen of those games will be broadcast on the ESPN family networks and an additional 40 games will be aired in the markets of both competing teams through conference and school partnerships with Comcast, FOX, Cox, ROOT Sports and BYUtv. In addition, the 15 non-televised games will be streamed live on the internet via the host institution's official web page.

WCC Announces 2012 Zappos.com WCC Tournament Bracket

The 2012 Zappos.com West Coast Conference Basketball Championships will begin on Wednesday, February 29, 2012 and run through the championship games on Monday, March 5, 2012 at the Orleans Arena in Las Vegas. The tournament will begin with an opening round game between the eighth and ninth seed. The winner will then play on Thursday, March 1, against the tournament's fifth seed. Also on Thursday, the sixth and seventh seeds will square off. Friday's action will see seeds No. 3 and No. 4 play for the first time, while the top two seeds will advance all the way to the semifinals on Saturday, March 3. There will be no games played on Sunday, March 4, with both the men's and women's championship games on Monday.

Brandon Davies, Jr., F, BYU

BYU's Brandon Davies is the West Coast Conference Player of the Week after leading the Cougars to wins over No. 24 Gonzaga and Portland. He averaged 16.5 points, nine rebounds, and 4.5 steals per game, while shooting 56% from the field. Against Gonzaga, Davies posted 15 points on 7-of-12 shooting, adding five rebounds. At Portland, Davies flirted with a triple-double, finishing with 18 points, 13 rebounds, and a career-high eight steals.

★ The Cougars continue to be the top scoring offense in the West Coast Conference, averaging better than 79 points per game. BYU's average tally ranks 15th nationally.

★ Junior forward **Brandon Davies** is the WCC Player of the Week for Feb. 6. During conference play, he tops in the WCC in scoring (18.3 points per game) and second in rebounding (9.3 boards per contest). Davies has also blocked 17 shots during WCC play.

★ In its only game this week, BYU plays host to Pepperdine on Saturday afternoon at the Marriott Center. Game time is scheduled for 4p MT, and the game will be televised live on BYUtv.

★ During conference play, Gonzaga leads the WCC in scoring defense, allowing just 62.5 points per game.

★ Senior center **Rob Sacre**, featured on this week's "Road to Las Vegas" show on WCCsports.com, leads the conference in blocks per game (1.6) during WCC play.

★ Gonzaga has won a share of 11 straight West Coast Conference titles, the longest active conference title winning streak in the nation and the second-longest in NCAA history (UCLA, 1967-79).
